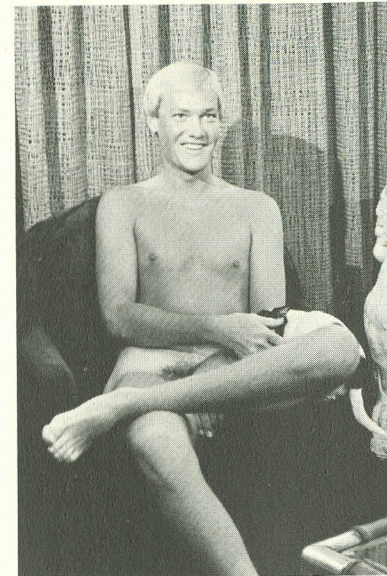

In Houston, the "biggee" is the upcoming conference of the Texas Gay Task Force. Gays and those persons interested in the civil rights of gays will be assembling in Houston on June 18, 19 and 20. The big conference will be held on the campus of the University of Houston, in association with the U. of H. Gay Activist Alliance, under the leadership of Hugh Crell. Featured speakers for the conference will be lesbian feminist Jean O'Leary, writer Vito Russo of the Advocate and Texas legislator Craig Washington, who last year introduced a bill to repeal Texas' sodomy laws. The conference comes right before the Gay Pride Week Celebration of June 20 to June 27. Gay Pride Week will include parades, street dances, an arts and crafts festival and a beer garden. Everybody gear up!

In Dallas, all the talk is about the big cycle run, Stampede IV, sponsored by the Wranglers M.C.

The run will be held on June 18-20, on a private dude ranch. The entire ranch has been leased by the Wranglers, and events planned include horseback riding, swimming and "audience participation" events (hubba-hubba). Also, for those who hunger easily, the Wranglers are going to bar-beque an entire side of beef! To get in on all these hot events and good eats, ya have to register before June 17th at the Sundance Kids bar in Dallas.

But as big as they are, there's still lots of other stuff going on in Houston and Dallas this week. In Dallas, for example, plans are being made for the Mr. Gay Texas contest on June 24th, at the Old Plantation. If you want to enter, you can get entry blanks and registration forms at the Old Plantation in Dallas or Houston. The Nuntius sponsors the event.

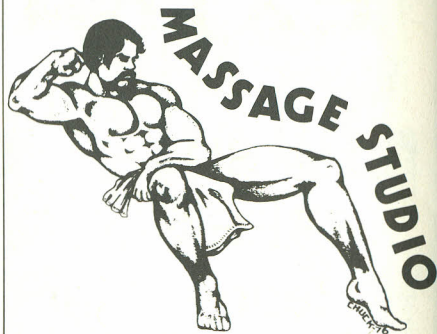
And finally in Fort Worth, Alice Fallas and April Love have joined Jackie George at Aub's. Just how much hotter can things get over there?

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# DISCO TEXAS

Summer seems to have settled in but fortunately there is something really hot besides the weather. It's the new Roberta Kelly LP, "Trouble Maker," on Oasis. Recorded in Munich, it is right on target from start to finish. The title cut running nine minutes is so fine, you can't wait to flip it and melt into the three remaining cuts on side two. This disc should shape up as a surprise beach-time blockbuster for all.

Please let me recommend the "Super Disco" cut from Rimshots' "Down to Earth" LP on Stang. It will make you want to get up and shake a leg, among other things.

Marlena Shaws' new album is very appropriately titled, "Just a Matter of Time," and is out on Blue Note. It includes her current single, "It's Better Than Walking Out," plus two other similar exhilarating cuts, "Love Has Gone Away" and "Take My Body."

The very versatile group, Barrabas, has a new album called, "Watch Out," on Atco. Strongest cut is simply titled, "It."

For all of you jazz disco fans, Ronnie Laws has a mighty-sounding disc with a very up-tempo cut, "All the Time." Ronnie is Hubert Laws' brother of Chicago Theme fame.

If you want to be on top of it, don't miss the newest LP's from Tavares, Stylistics, John Davis Orchestra, Peoples

Choice, Andrea True Connection and Impact.

A single that I overlooked last month seems to be catching on. It's "Love Chant Part 1 & 2" by Eli's Second Coming on Silver Blue. This bouncy single was produced by one of the masters of the Philly Sound, Bobby Eli.

Curiosity got to me concerning the happenings of our disco mistress Gloria Gaynor, so I called MGM to inquire. Word now is that her new LP, "Talk, Talk, Talk," is due for release July 15th. Rumors are still circulating she is facing court battles with her manager but not with her contract.

The disco version of "Dancing Free" by Hot Ice is just starting to happen in the area.

"Big Dance Records in the Big Apple" is the LP from Ariola-America. This monster disc includes such hits as, "Up in a Puff of Smoke," "Dance, Dance, Dance," "Sexy Lady" and "Pretty Maid," among others.


That 7:03 version of "Depend on Yourself" by B.T. Express seems to be causing some sensation everywhere I go.

"Henry who?"

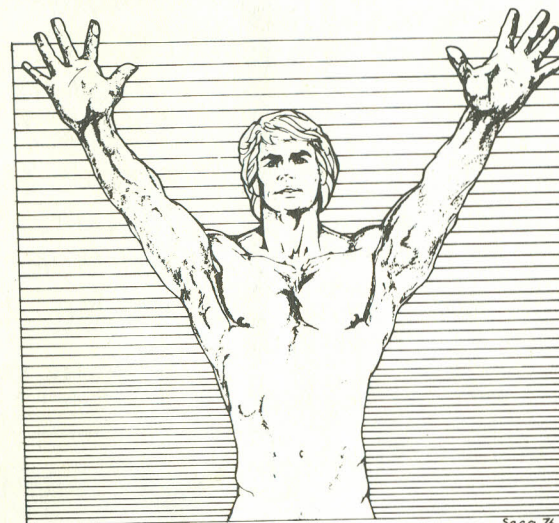
"I can't remember the last name. He's on some TV show. Some show for kids. I've never seen it."
