U.S. SUPREME COURT RULES IN FAVOR OF GAY RIGHTS

The United States Supreme Court has again opened its doors to suits filed on behalf of gay people. The high court announced Monday that a decision by a lower court in Washington State to ban homosexuals from federal employment had been set aside. The new ruling means that gay men and women cannot be fired simply because they are gay.

This decision (John Singer vs the United States) represents a reversal in previous court attitudes on gay issues. For years the court has ruled against gay people. Buchanan vs. Wade, a Dallas case in the late 60's, upheld the Texas Sodomy Laws; a more recent decision upheld the Virginia Sodomy laws—both decisions leading most court watchers to believe that there was little hope that the high court would rule in favor of gay people in test cases.

The Singer ruling does offer promise. It comes at a good time since the Leonard Matlovitch case is to be considered later in this session, testing military discrimination. Houston's own Gary van Ooteghem has a suit

in federal courts for being fired by Harris County Treasurer Hartsel Gray. The outcome of these and other cases will be affected by this week's Supreme Court ruling.

Now may be a good time to apply for that city, county, state, or federal government job you've always wanted.

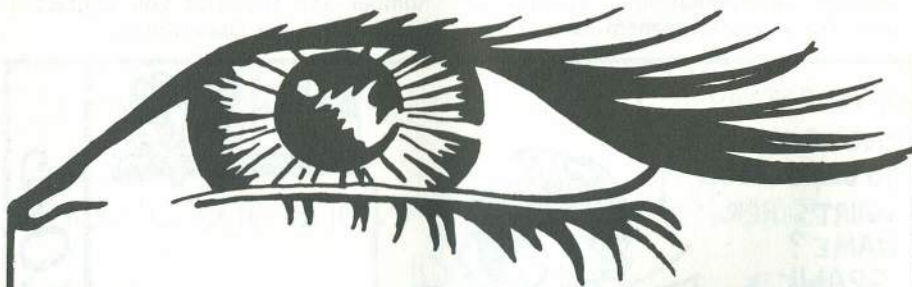

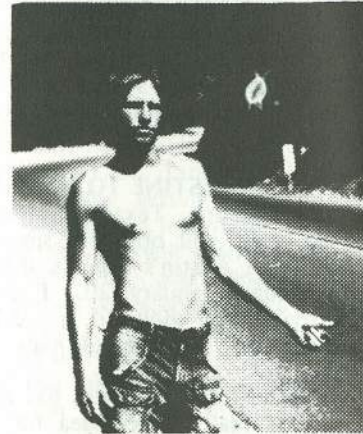
If you're already a member of the Club Baths, use your current membership when you visit Club Austin. If you're not a member, join up now in Austin during the opening weekend.

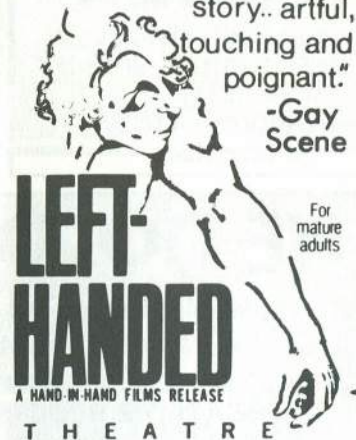

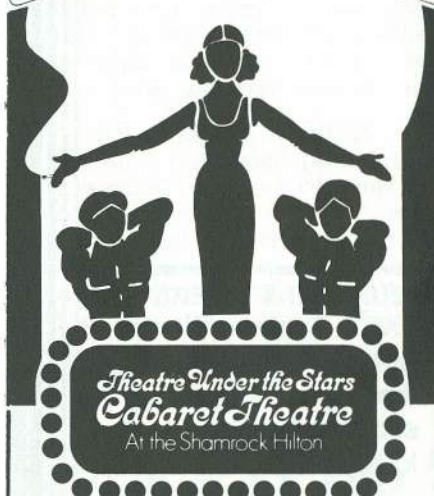

STUD AUCTION

Dallas' Tex's Ranch will host a Stud Auction Sunday, January 16 at 10pm. Fifteen to twenty hunky studs have registered to go on the auction block. Bidders will bid with real money. All proceeds generated by the Stud Auction will benefit DAIR (Dallas Alliance for Individual Rights). Go. Bid. Take home a stud. It's all for a good cause.

GAY EPISCOPAL PRIEST

The Rev. Barrett is an Episcopal Priest serving the pulpits in the Diocese of New York. Rev. Barrett is also a woman, a black person, and a lesbian. Rev. Ms. Barrett and the Episcopal Church have each come a long way in recent months.

TWT called Rev. Gerveis, Rector of Church of the Ascension, Houston, for his reaction. Rev. Gerveis proposed a resolution before the Diocese of Texas Council last year to "protect the heterosexuality of the priesthood". That resolution passed overwhelmingly in Texas, but failed narrowly in the National Council in St. Louis in September, 1976. Now that a gay person has been ordained priest, Rev. Gerveis is more moderate in his views. He told TWT, "I cannot pass judgement on the sincerity of this woman. . . and her Bishop has acted within his rights." But Rev. Gerveis explained, "The ordination of a gay person in New York has little or no effect on church business as usual in Houston, Texas." He adds that he does not expect Bishop Richardson, Diocese of Texas, to ordain any gay people in the near future, but he cannot rule out that possibility after "a few years' adjustment period." TWT wishes "God's Speed to the Rev. Ms. Barrett."

ROBERT ARAYA JOINS TWT



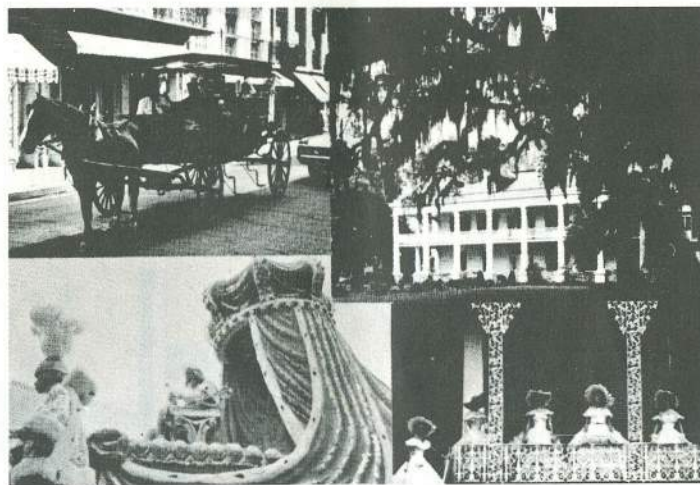

"You do not. You do not have low blood sugar. And you were supposed to have been asleep last night. Not eavesdropping on me and my friends," the young man chided.

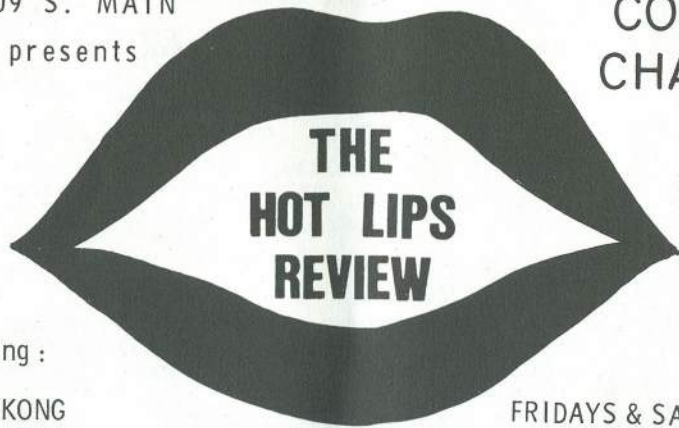


I had low blood sugar. I had suspected though."
