## REV. HARRIS RUNS FOR COUNCIL

The Rev. James C. Harris, Pastor of MCC—Dallas, will announce his candidacy for the City Council of Dallas, District 5.

DAIR and DGPC, in addition to many independent business people in Dallas, have pledged their support of Rev. Harris.

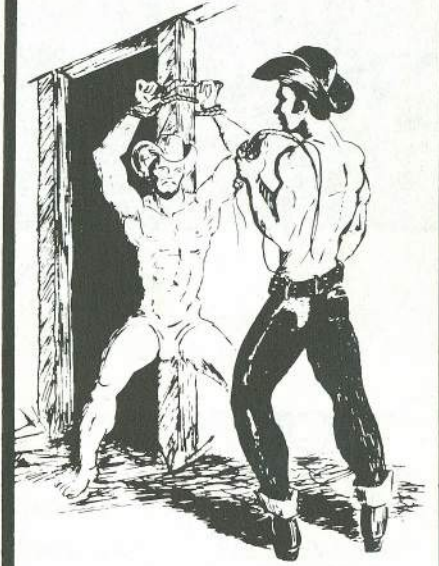

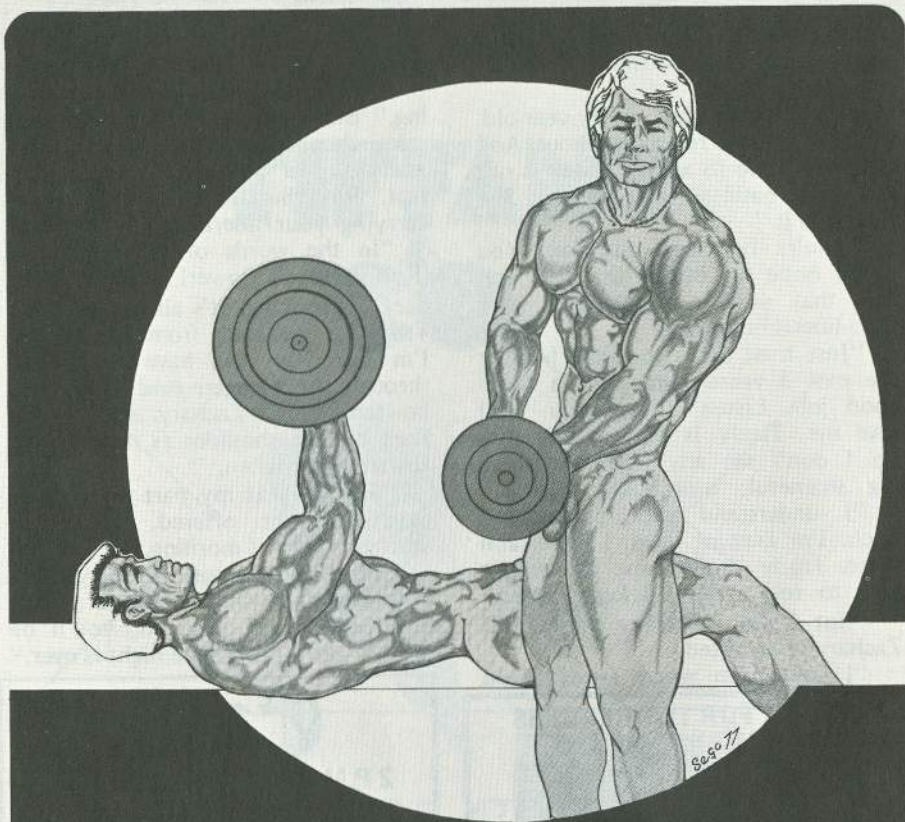

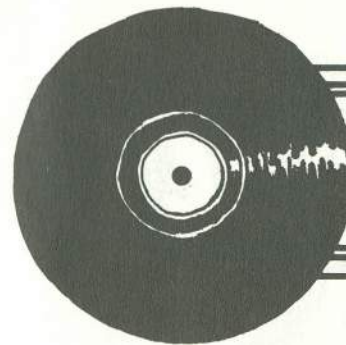

## boogie talk

### DISCO '76

Good news and bad news. In 1976 a big Texas disco could gross more than half a million dollars, but the 3 biggest disco hits of the year ("My Sweet Summer Suite," "You + Me = Love," and "That's Where the Happy People Go") never made it onto the radio, and artists like Donna Summer were denied the Top-40 hits they had in 1975.

All is not lost. The record companies with the most interest in disco products began to release their "disco discs" (earlier available only to clubs and DJ's) for sale to the public. They have realized that a vast new market exists for music not heard on the radio.

Radio is a tremendously restricted medium. Most stations play less than 50 current records at any given time. In 1975 record companies hoped that disco success would lead their records onto tight radio station playlists. The hope still exists, but the companies can now be content with sales generated by disco play alone. An album can usually be bought for under \$4. The 12-inch disco discs sell in Houston for about \$2.50...and you only get 2 songs. You can't blame those folks for grabbing the chance to get more for less.

The disco discs were originally provided to the clubs for superior audio quality and long versions that couldn't be crammed onto a 7-inch 45. Usually the same tune was pressed on both sides, so that if one side wore out, the other was there. (Imagine if

you will how long it took to get used to an album-sized record that plays at 45rpm! To further complicate matters, Columbia released a long version of the O'Jay's "I Love Music" on a 7-inch record with a big hole... that played at 33rpm.)

Some of the disco discs available now are:

"Theme from King Kong"—Love Unlimited Orchestra. Don't be put off by the title; this fine Barry White instrumental is following up his smash "Sweet Summer Suite," and 20th Century's first venture into commercial "giant 45's."

"Dancing Queen"—Carol Douglas. Better than the Abba version heard on the air, and a lot longer, but not up to her "Midnight Love Affair" available on a regular album.

"Love Is the Answer"—Van McCoy and "That Old Black Magic"—Soft-Tones. Longer versions of these good tunes than have been available before.

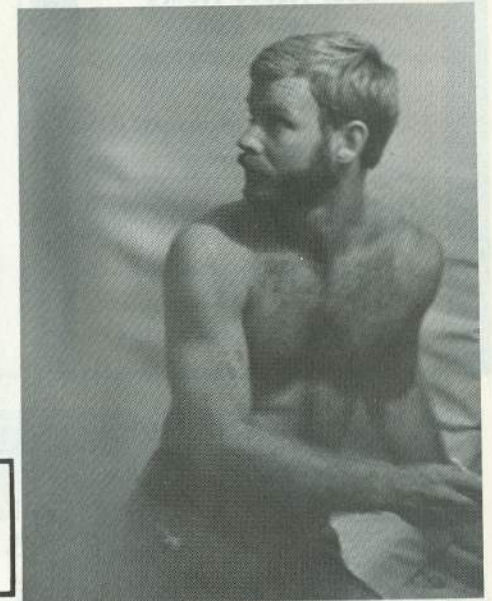
