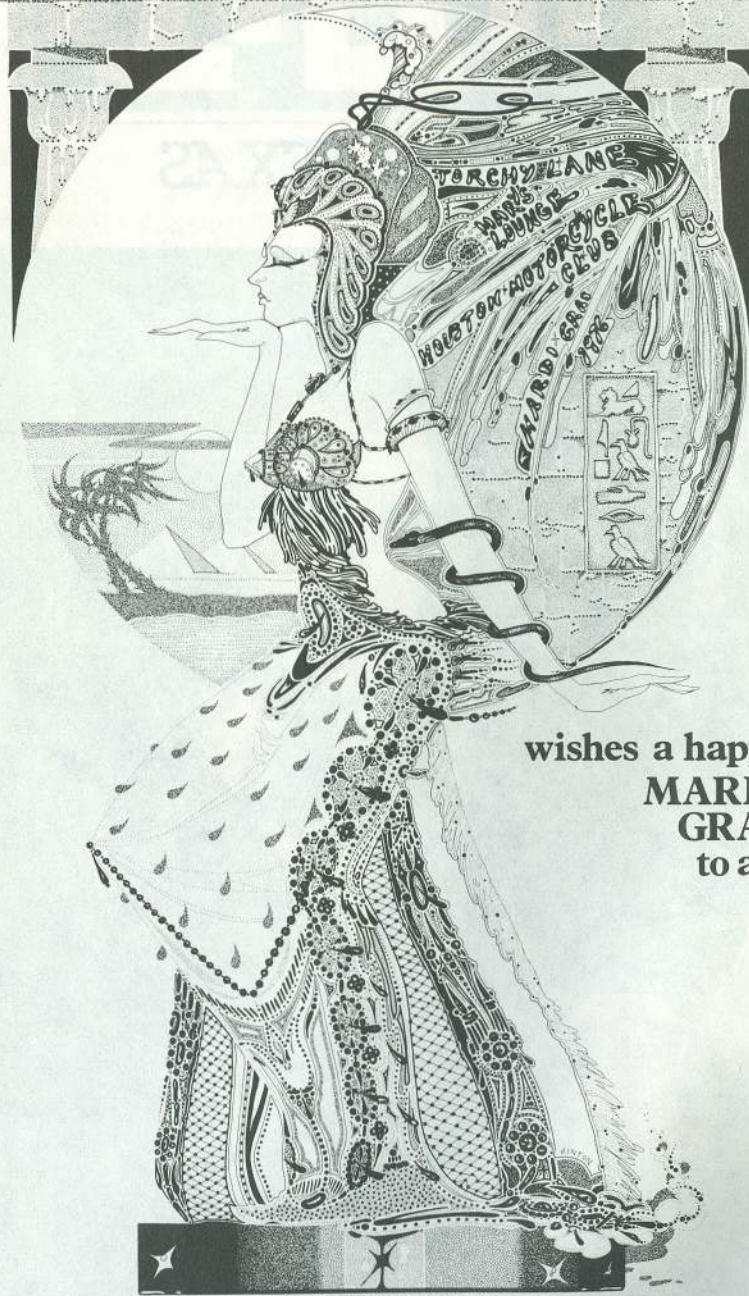

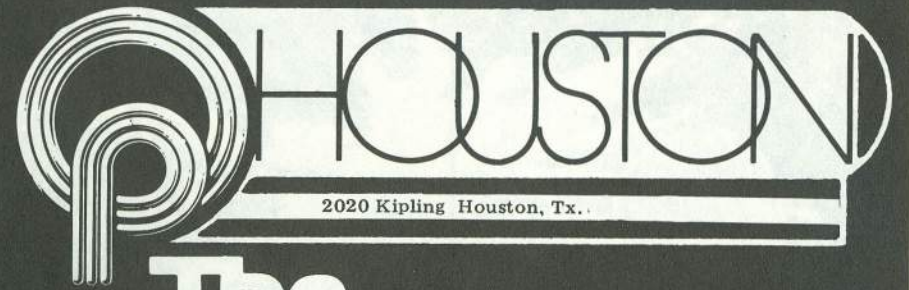

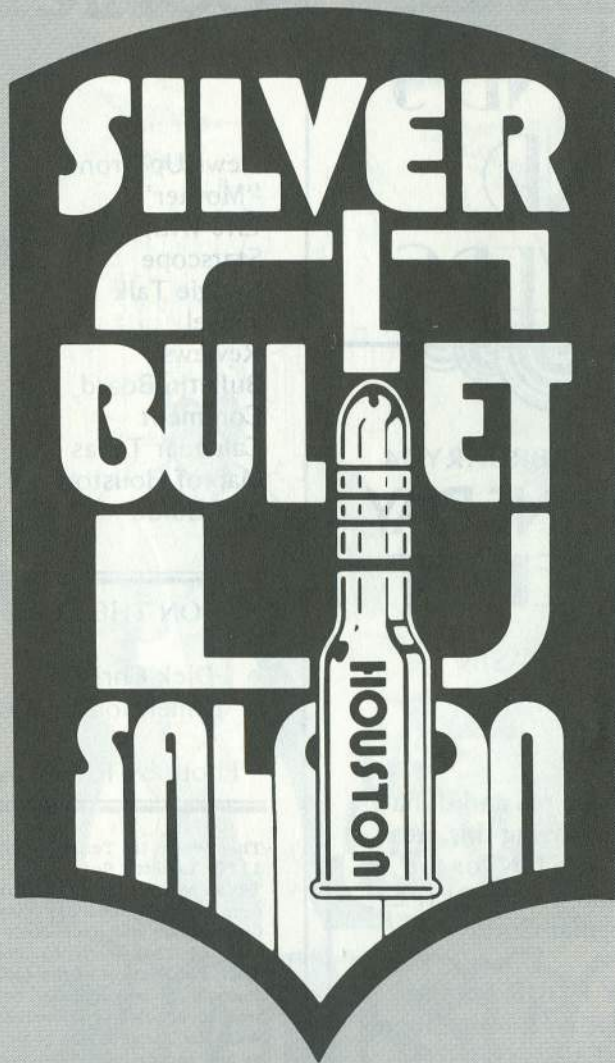

Marci at Friends and Lovers in Austin informs TWT that Monday

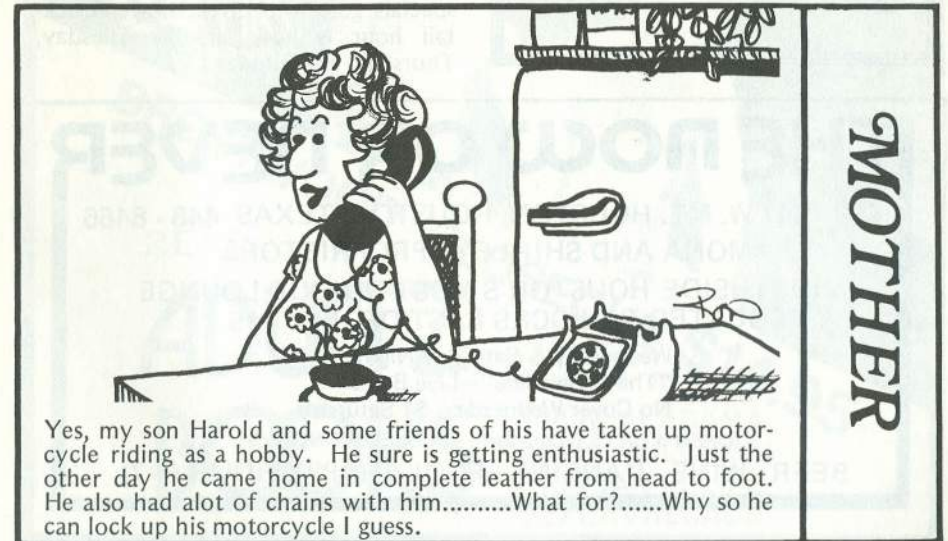

THE SHIRLEY McLAINE SHOW

When it comes to delivering "the goods", Shirley McLaine is generally more dependable than a woman ten-months pregnant. Her performances are always filled with promise, and those vows are always exceeded. In entertainment, she's a one-woman supply house of apparently inexhaustible proportions. Her two concert dates in Houston proved no exception. In fact, it was more than just entertainment, it was an education. The search for a perfect show has been ended. For those fortunates who witnessed it, we now have a standard of excellence against which to weigh all such similar endeavors in the future. McLaine offers the reality that creates the visions. Visions which allow drag queens to endure the critical slings and arrows which accompany a per-

fectly good male's getting into gaudy female attire. And dip and grind their jaws, as best they can, to the musical accompaniment of a scratched record. But Shirley is *real*. A perfection that's hard to believe, but there nevertheless.

Shirley's current stint is basically a much-tightened and slightly abridged version of the spectacle Ms. McLaine showcased in London and on Broadway plus material adapted from two television specials and one appearance at the Inaugural Gala. But what the hell. Perfection is not accomplished on the first outing. As McLaine admonishes during the act, "those things which are built too hastily never last!" Shirley lasts.

The 80-minute program runs without intermission. Yet the quick pacing and deft movements blend into an

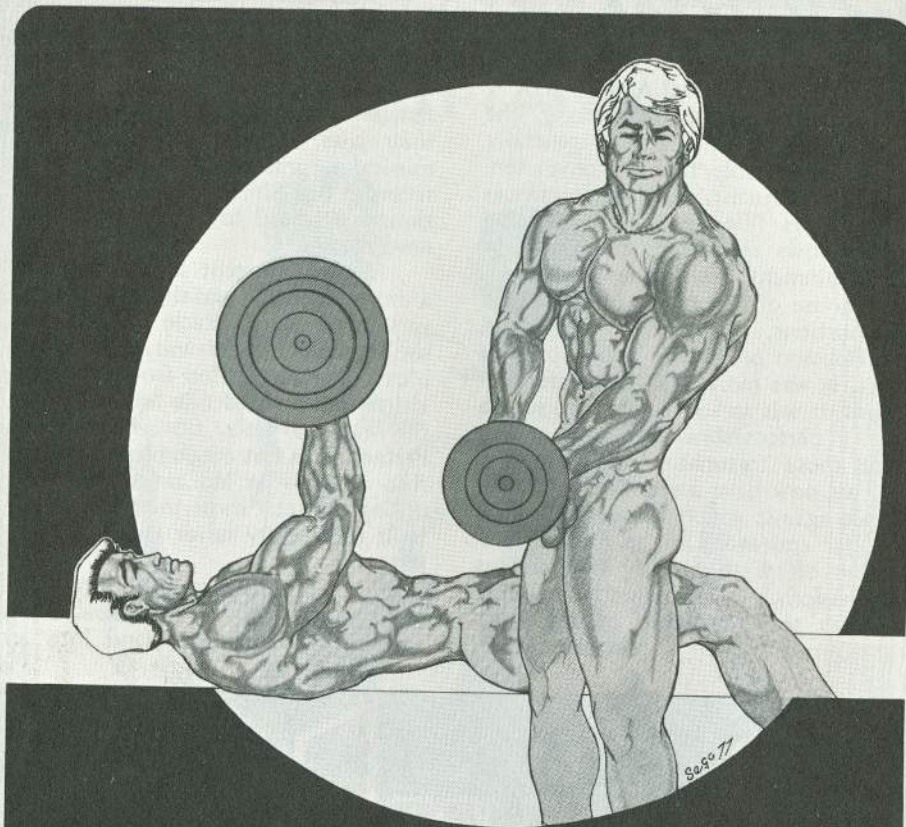

energetic explosion which seems much shorter than the clock indicates. Unlike many performers, and *all* the previously mentioned drag queens, Shirley *does* know how to leave the audience begging for more. In spasms of desire, to be exact.

The musical material is familiar. The McLaine "basics", highlighting a multi-faceted show business career. But delightfully, McLaine's "basics" should not be translated to mean "tired". For even if the musical material lacks that aura of fresh creation, it hits home with a vitality that belies its lengthy historical presence. In other words, the gal really knows how to *Sell It!* Dripping in perspiration that comes after the first 10 minutes, she absolutely wallows in the physical agony of performance. A tight-muscled tension that you fear will break the

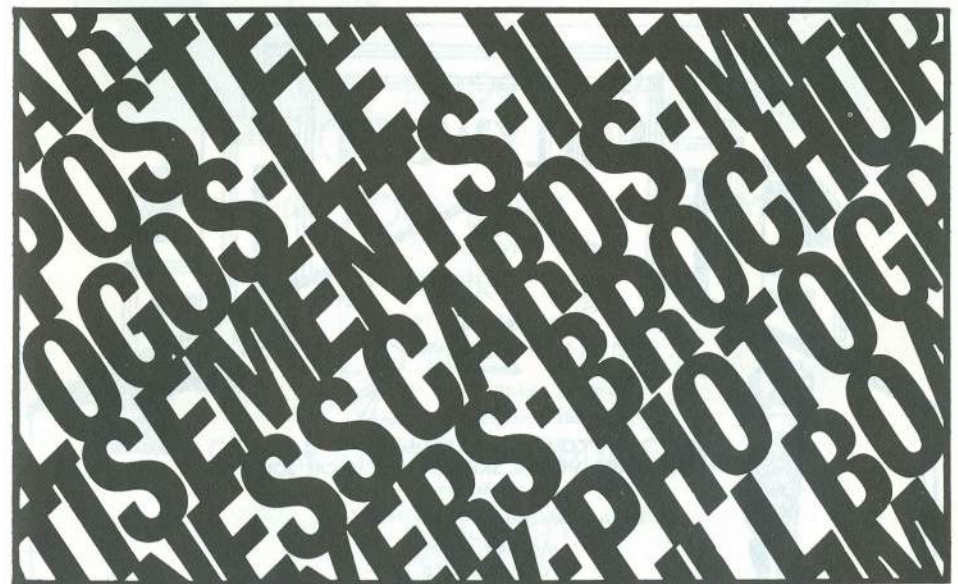

momentum of the show as it builds from peak to frenzy. But our fears are unfounded. The risks are there. But so is the steel-wire McLaine perfection.

Backed by four dancers, two male and two female, the McLaine effort is provided a velvet cushion on which the sparkle glistens. McLaine and her fabulous foursome tore the place apart dancing to a disco version of "Donkey Serenade". Likewise, mark the performance plaudits ala dance on "If They Could See Me Now," "Big Spender," and "It's Not Where You Start, But Where You Finish". Balancing all that pizzazz for Shirl, note the stunning, Music-Hall-shattering emotionalism of "She's a Star."

And for all you laugh buffs, the levity was priceless. Not the least of which were Shirley's "If you haven't tried it, don't knock it," elaborative

philosophy on gays. I think she put a lot of it in just to shock the "good ol' boys" in Texas, but it was priceless nevertheless. Not only did Shirley tell us that Marlon Brando was doing it with Jack Nicholson, Walter Matthau was doing it with George Burns, and Dustin Hoffman got it on with Robert Redford, but also, "My brother (Warren Beatty) can give you a 'wash and set' you won't forget, honey."

To all this, add a 28-piece orchestra and the best revue show lighting I've ever seen, and that pretty much sums up the evening. Final words on which to peg the evening?

Wildly energetic, technically flawless, boisterous and beautiful, sexy. And McLaine's main commodity which energizes it all: extreme intelligence.
