



POLITICS MAKES STRANGE BEDFELLOWS

Anita Bryant, by virtue of her good looks and flair for publicity, has emerged as the spokesperson for a campaign to deny equal employment opportunities to the gay citizens of the Miami area. Because of her political activities, she has lost an expected job and, with the willing cooperation of segments of the local and national media, has attempted to portray herself as the victim of those whose rights she would curtail. In response to this situation, the National Gay Task Force issued the following statement:

"NGTF believes in civil liberties for all citizens, including those who oppose the civil liberties of others. As people who have lost jobs because of our own beliefs and lifestyles, we are not happy to see that kind of discrimi-

nation, even when the victims are themselves discriminators. We therefore regret and deplore the fact that Anita Bryant has lost a job as a television entertainer because of her views, and we wish to make it clear that NGTF has not requested or recommended such action on the part of the Singer Sewing Machine Company.

"We wish to make clear, however, that we think Ms. Bryant's attempt to spread false and defamatory statements about the gay community and to deny us full equality under the law is just as reprehensible as similar attempts have been to defame and deny equality to other minority groups.

"However much proponents of bigotry would prefer to make Anita Bryant the issue, we believe that the public is prepared to see the real issue: equal protection under the law for a tenth of the American population."

RED CARPET IN OPENS



spend two years in here!"




"You're impossible! Don't you think people are going to miss Rexella? He is a semi-famous person."

Truth is a group of four now, the only original member is Joe Harris. The only female member is Taka Boom. If her wailing vocals remind you a little of Rufus, there's good


reason-- her sister is Chaka Khan. Harris says of their music, "It's not R + B; it kind of leans toward rockand we know it can hold it's own."
