POLITICS MAKES STRANGE BEDFELLOWS

Anita Bryant, by virtue of her good looks and flair for publicity, has emerged as the spokesperson for a campaign to deny equal employment opportunities to the gay citizens of the Miami area. Because of her political activities, she has lost an expected job and, with the willing cooperation of segments of the local and national media, has attempted to portray herself as the victim of those whose rights she would curtail. In response to this situation, the National Gay Task Force issued the following statement:

"NGTF believes in civil liberties for all citizens, including those who oppose the civil liberties of others. As people who have lost jobs because of our own beliefs and lifestyles, we are not happy to see that kind of discrimi-

nation, even when the victims are themselves discriminators. We therefore regret and deplore the fact that Anita Bryant has lost a job as a television entertainer because of her views, and we wish to make it clear that NGTF has not requested or recommended such action on the part of the Singer Sewing Machine Company.

"We wish to make clear, however, that we think Ms. Bryant's attempt to spread false and defamatory statements about the gay community and to deny us full equality under the law is just as reprehensible as similar attempts have been to defame and deny equality to other minority groups.

"However much proponents of bigotry would prefer to make Anita Bryant the issue, we believe that the public is prepared to see the real issue: equal protection under the law for a tenth of the American population."

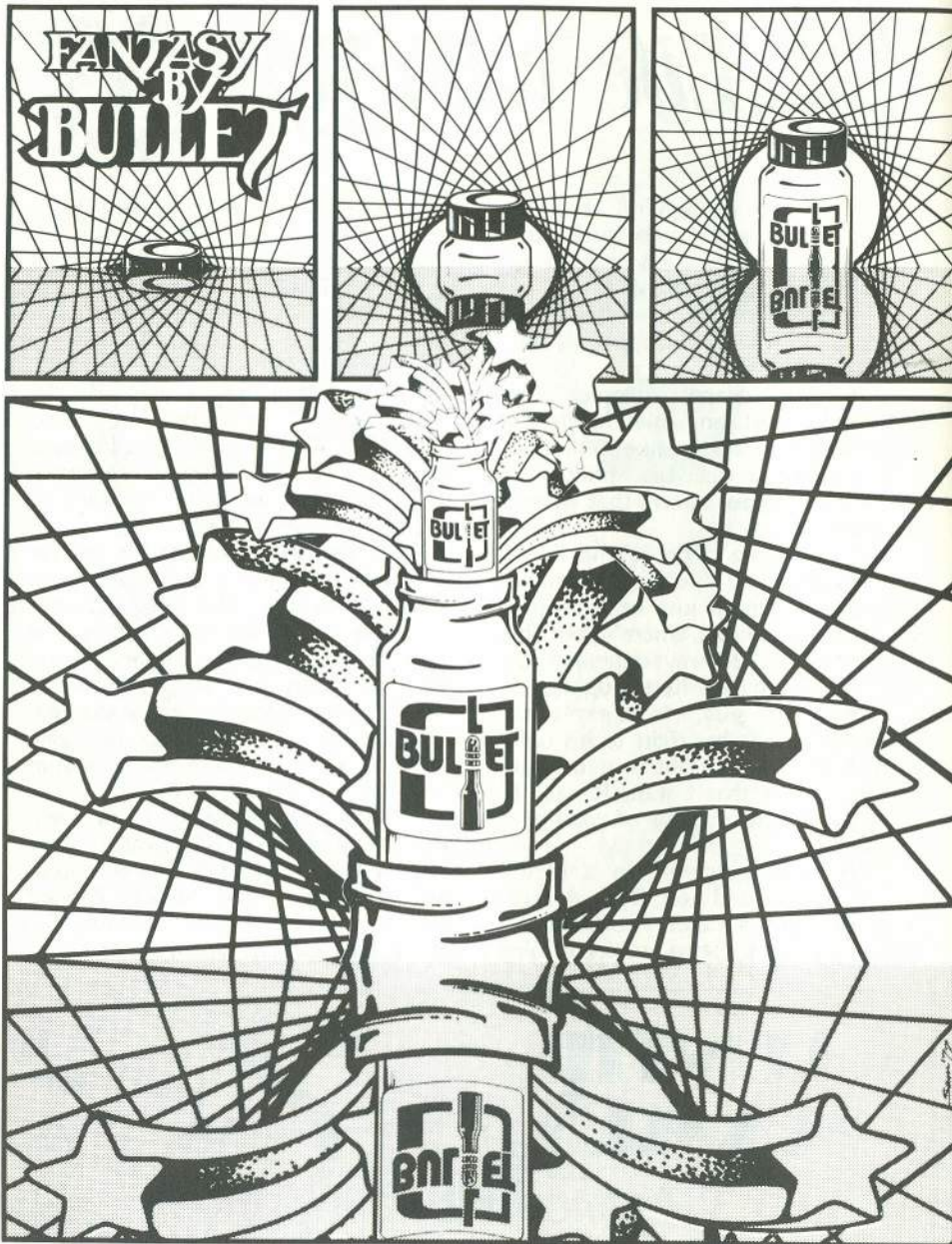
"Canned goods!" Burt muttered. "You're going to have Rexella down here for two years and not feed him anything but canned goods!"



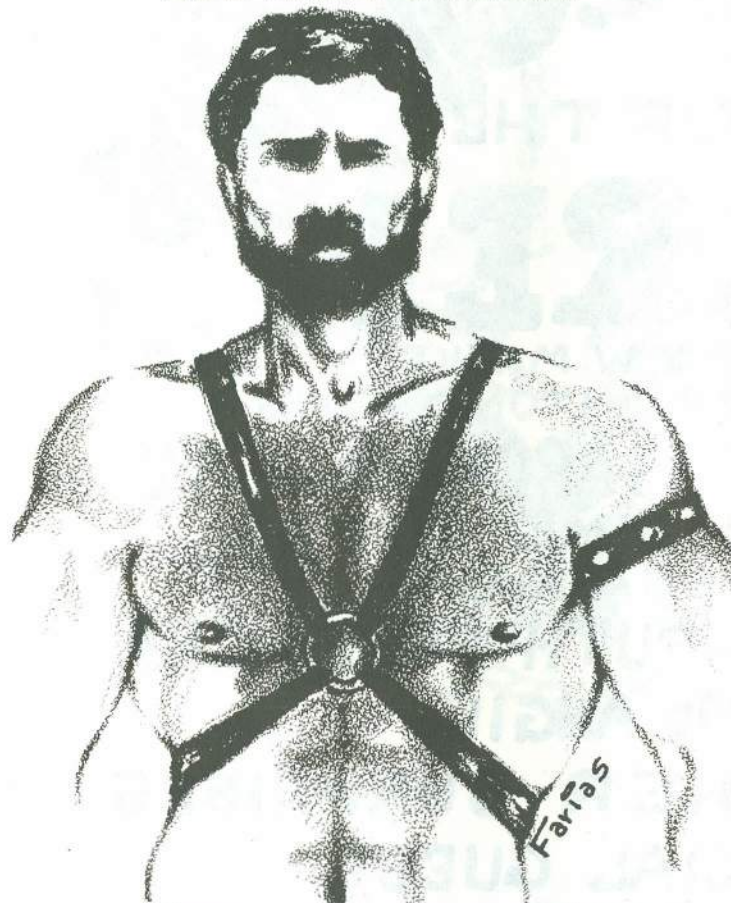

The most popular disco record during the past year has probably been "You + Me = Love," an eleven minute killer by Undisputed Truth. The single version of the tune was released more than six months ago...with three minutes of the song on one side and another four of instrumental on the other side. It wasn't very good that way, so Whitfield Records released a 12-inch 45 to discos, with the long version pressed on both sides. Even so the record got so popular, DJ's were wearing out their copies. After months there were still no albums. This is rare in an industry which is usually quick to capitalize on a song's success. The company finally made a move to appease the clubs, and a few weeks ago released another "giant" 45. This time with a new Undisputed Truth tune on one side "Let's Go Down To The Disco" and a replacement copy of "You + Me = Love." Then last month, the LP, perhaps aptly titled "Method To The Madness" was finally delivered to the stores.

Undisputed Truth appears onstage wearing platinum-colored Afro wigs and whiteface. They has their first hit in 1971 "Smiling Faces Sometimes." Even though the group has gone through some personnel changes, they still have the same producer: Norman (Whitfield Records) Whitfield.

Check the production credit on the labels of records like The Temptations' "Papa Was A Rolling Stone" and Gladys Knight's "I heard It through The Grapevine" and you'll find his name there too. More recently, he put together the "Car Wash" soundtrack album, including the hit title cut by Rose Royce.

Truth is a group of four now, the only original member is Joe Harris. The only female member is Taka Boom. If her wailing vocals remind you a little of Rufus, there's good

reason-- her sister is Chaka Khan. Harris says of their music, "It's not R + B; it kind of leans toward rock and we know it can hold it's own."

Footnotes: The Ricthie Family ("Best Disco In Town," "Brazil") has new music ready. Their next album is called "Life Is Music."
