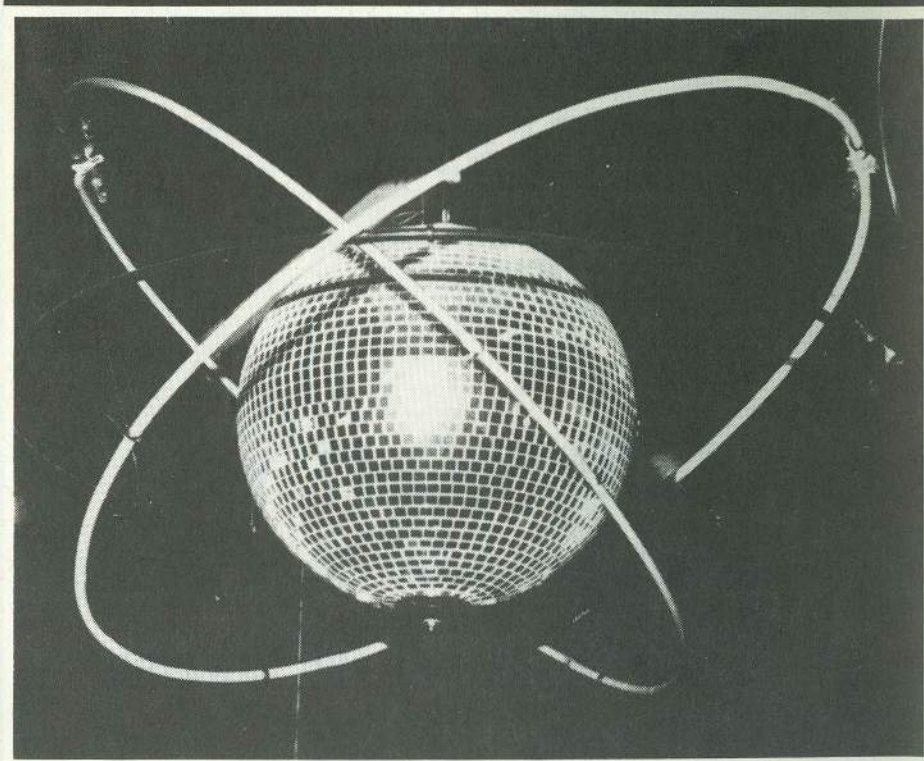
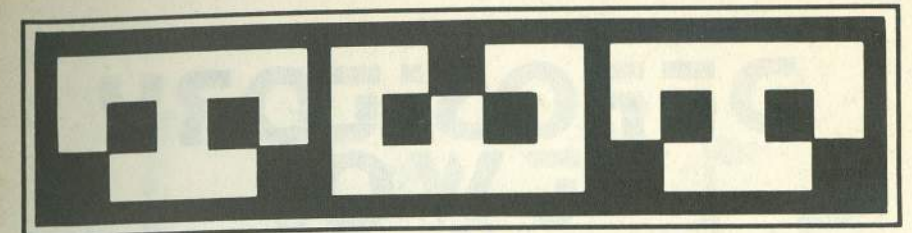

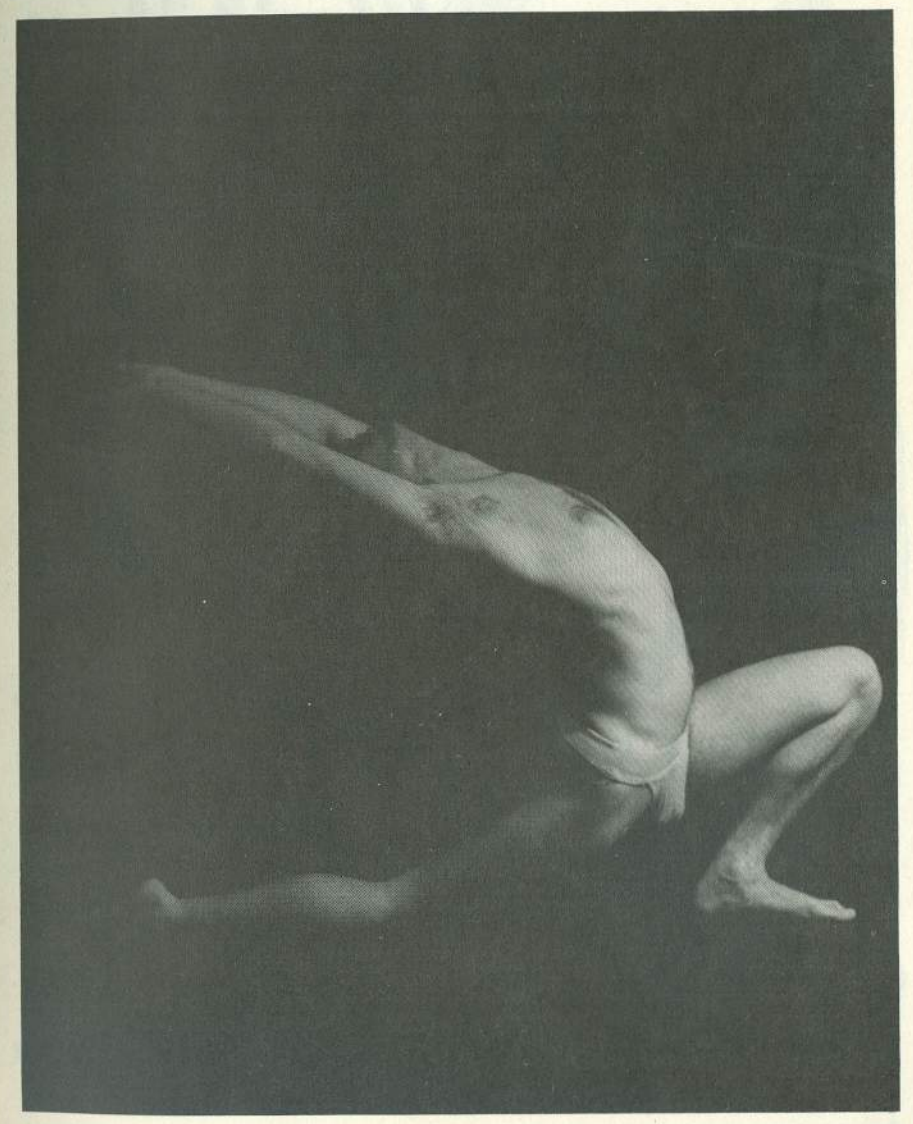

## POKEY TO THE WHITEHOUSE

Houston lesbian activist Pokey Anderson is one of fourteen representatives of the national gay community who will meet at the White House on March 26. The delegation of seven lesbians and seven gay men has been invited to meet with Margaret (Midge) Costanze, Presidential Assistant for Public Liaison, to discuss a wide range of issues involving Federal discrimination against gay people.

The unprecedented official White House discussions will include such areas as the U.S. Civil Rights Commission, H.E.W., H.U.D., and the military. The meeting was arranged by Jean O'Leary and Bruce Voeller, co-executive directors of the National Gay Task Force, in an initial meeting at the White House with Costanza.

Anderson has been active in the Gay Political Caucus, is a staff member of lesbian/feminist publication *Point-blank Times*, and serves on the National Gay Task Force board of directors. She is a past Eastern Regional Co-coordinator of the Texas Gay Task Force. Last Fall she ran a nearly-successful write-in campaign for the office of Community Development Commissioner in Montrose/Fourth Ward. An-

derson states: "We will be trying to document ways the President could end discrimination against gay people within the Executive Branch of the Federal government. I am very hopeful about the doors this could open for us. And, as a HOoustonian, I'm glad that we in the middle of the country are having more input on the national gay rights front."

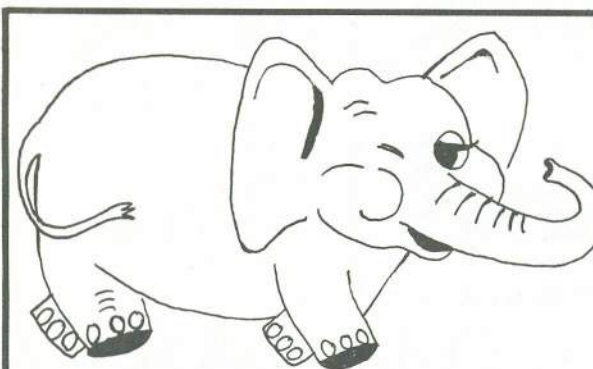
"I'm horny," Zachary pleaded, confirming the exposition.

## profiles

Gary J. Van Ooteghem

JACK LAMPERT, 30, has been living in Houston, Texas, since May, 1972. After having been born and raised in New Orleans, he did some soul searching one day and realized that his professional career wasn't growing anymore. "I felt stagnated. I had been to Houston three years prior doing summer stock. I knew some people here, so I just came. Besides, I was still close to home if I wanted to return."

In New Orleans, Mr. Lampert held a job in a fashion salon where he was both a model and the private secretary to the designer. It was here that Jack met his third and current lover. They have been together for some 4½ years, off and on. At the time of their meeting, his lover was the manager of the salon. Now, they reside in the Montrose area of Houston.

Mr. Lampert has recently had his name before the public in connection with the Montrose Activity Center (MAC). Back in the fall of 1976, he put together and directed the first of a series of plays to be performed by MAC. In this first production, he directed seven actors and actresses, six of whom had never before acted on

stage in any fashion. With a great deal of patience, he prodded, nudged, poked, pushed, shoved and occasionally kicked his cast into shape.

Lampert molded and shaped the play, "P.S., Your Cat Is Dead" from an idea to a funny reality. The play proved successful for MAC. Now, Jack is currently directing a second play for MAC called "El Grande de Coca Cola," a musical farce.

Lampert says he "loves 'El Grande' in spite of being driven crazy." This was in obvious reference to his cast who, he says, must be constantly disciplined to hold down their energies and not be quite so geared up for the show. "El Grande de Coca Cola" will be Jack Lampert's fourth theatrical venture in Houston. Previously, he had acted at the Windmill Dinner Theater and acted and choreographed at Miller Theater.

Jack Lampert has been in show business all of his life. He has performed in sixty to sixty-five plays, directed eight, and choreographed fifteen. His early remembrances from life were of his two sisters and himself tap dancing at a dancing school recital. In high school, Jack was President of

the Drama Club and won awards for his own acting abilities: Best Actor, Best Musical Actor, and Best Student Director. Later, he won the City of New Orleans award for the Best Actor three years in a row (1967-1969).

Jack considers himself an outgoing person in spite of the fact that he doesn't go out very much. "But when I do, I like to boogie." Mostly, he and his lover entertain or visit friends. "Most of my friends will always be my friends, whether I see them a lot or not," he said in reference to a remark made about his heavy rehearsal schedule which does not allow for much free time. As to their form

of home entertainment, well, let me tell you, it sometimes gets bizarre. Take for example, this past New Year's Eve when Lampert decided to have a Fellini type party. The idea was to come dressed in a Fellini styled costume. And everybody did! They were outrageous, funny, and in all cases, enjoyable. In one corner was a human cat purring and hissing intermittently. Elsewhere appeared one of his former actors dressed as Miss America, there was a naked unicorn, there was Wonderwoman's mother, and other Fellini decadents. Jack stated that he loves to have parties. "That's the New Orleans in me!"

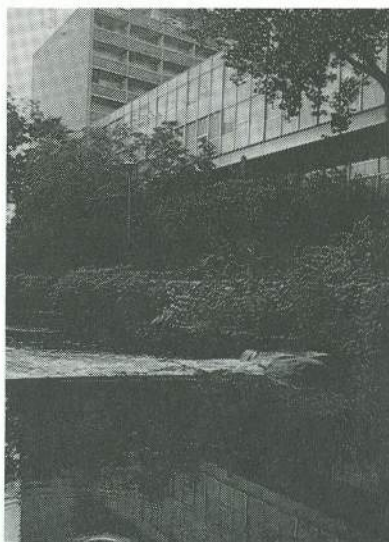

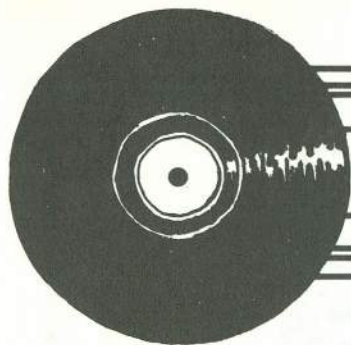

## boogie talk

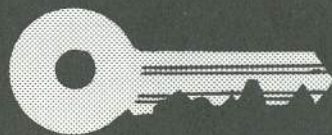

It's number one on the west coast in record sales. Andrea is a star in straight porno films, and her success in the record industry has led one of her peers into disco. Marilyn Chambers (star of "Behind the Green Door") has put out a tune called "Benihana"....not to be confused with the restaurants of the same name. She comes twice in the long version....eat your heart out, Donna Summer.

In Fort Lauderdale, the TK factory continues to turn out most of the hottest tunes in the current wave of good dance records.

Headed up by H.W. Casey, lead singer for KC and The Sunshine Band, they've been releasing tunes like George McCrae's "Love In Motion," T-Connection's "Do What You Wanna Do," The Ritchie Family's "Lady Luck," and a cut called "Gotham City Boogie," by Ultrafunk, that uses a riff from the theme of the old "Batman" TV series.

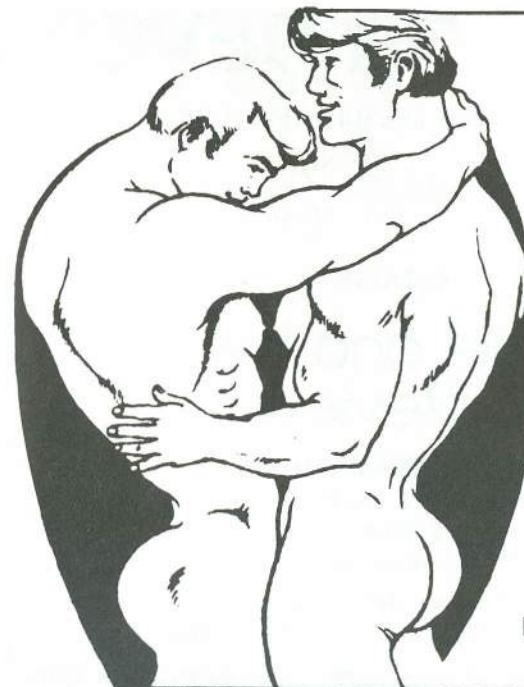

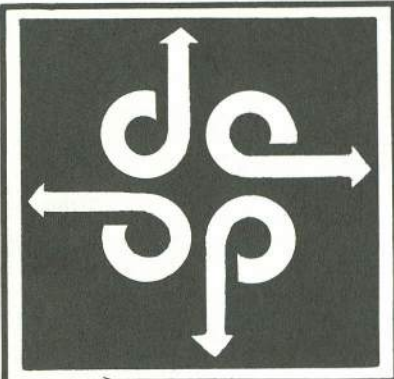

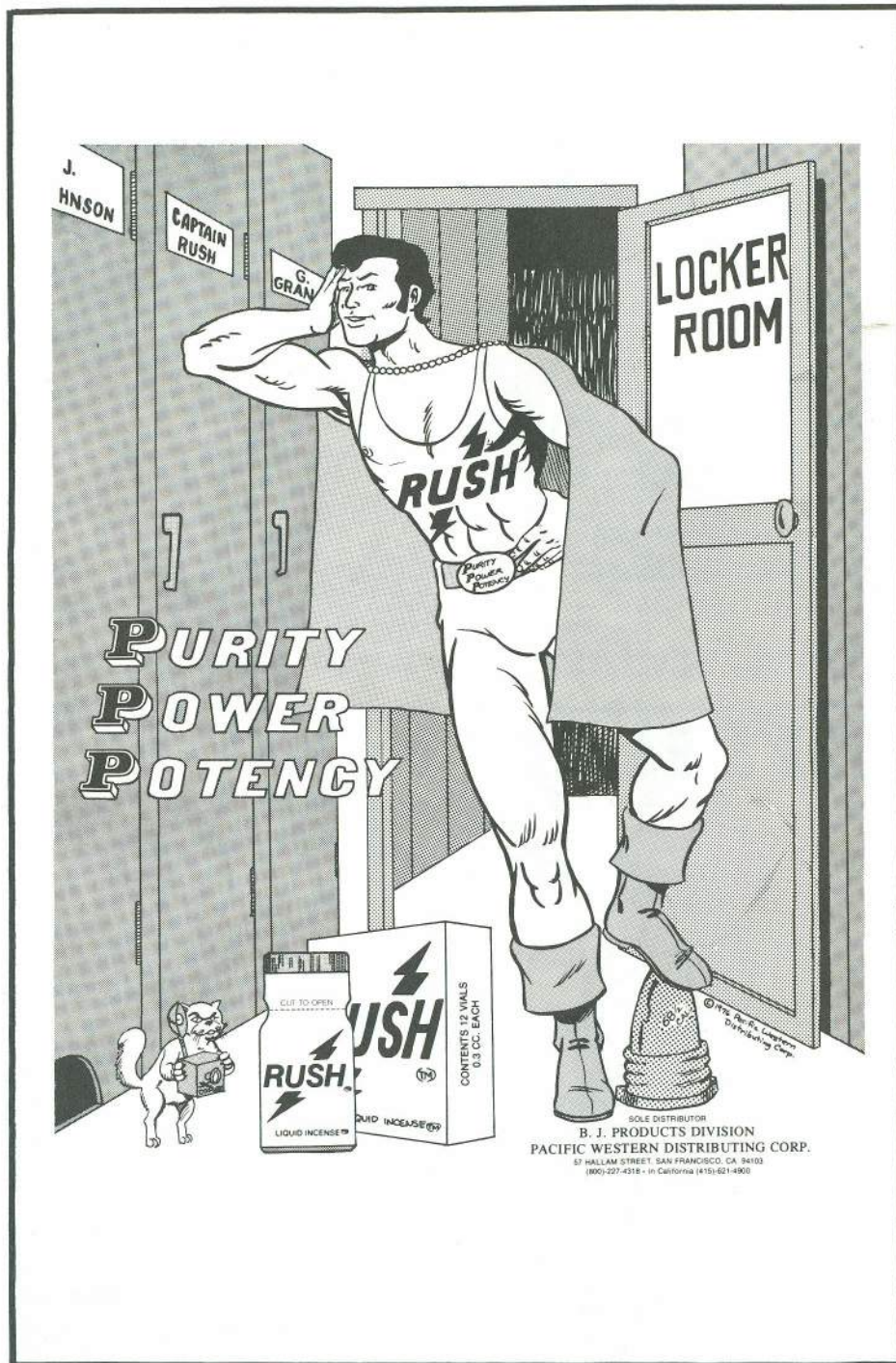
