DAIR ENDORSEMENTS

In the hotly contested Dallas City Elections, the Dallas Alliance for Individual Rights endorses the following candidates: Place 1, Bill Nichol; Place 2, Don Hicks; Place 3, Lucy Patterson; Place 4, Dick Smith; Place 5, Rev. Jim Harris; Place 6, Juanita Craft; Place 7, Jim Bradshaw; Place 8, no endorsement; at-large 1, Adlene Harrison; and at-large 2, Bill Blackburn. For Mayor, DAIR supports Emerson Emory. DAIR believes that the above-mentioned candidates are the most likely to be equitable in their treatment of gay rights issues.

Rev. Jim Harris is a hand-picked candidate of DAIR. A minister in the Metropolitan Community Church in Dallas, Rev. Harris has been careful not to run a single-issue campaign. His statements regarding the quality of public services in District 5, the prostitution problem on Cedar Springs, and the rights of minorities have appealed to a broad base of support in his home district.

TWT joins DAIR in urging you to vote for Rev. Jim Harris on April 2.



TEXAS A&M GAY BATTLE

"Regents call gays diabolic and decide to fight suit," says the front page headline in the March 22nd edition of A&M's student newspaper, THE BATTALION. According to reporter Leschper, the Board of Regents said they will proceed in every legal way to fight a suit demanding the school grant official recognition to a gay students organization.

The report says that in an approved statement the Regents claim so-called gay activities run diabolically counter to the traditions and standards of the university and that the board will proceed in every legal way to keep gay groups from organizing or operating on the campus.

TWT reminds you that the Gay Students Service Organization filed a suit February 28th in Federal District Court to force the school to grant them official recognition. Walking the Aggie campus, it's easy to recognize many gays. As one gay student said, "The publicity has brought many gays out of the closet on campus and whether the Regents officially recognize us or not, we are a sizeable growing force."
