The Dallas/Ft. Worth Metroplex has a hot weekend coming up with grand openings and Easter celebrations setting the pace.

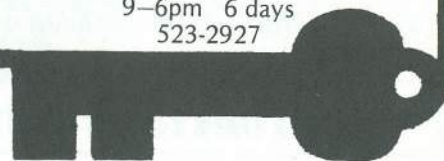

With the Academy Awards gone for another year, it's time to look at the current movie offerings.

A fun movie that's playing all over Texas is that sequel of sequels, *Airport '77*. It's really just one of those disaster movies that are usually done so disastrously except that this time it's done well. The plot centers around an airplane that goes down in the Bermuda Triangle, and there are as many plot twists as there are stereotyped characters. Jack Lemmon is the plane's pilot, showing an incredible amount of derring-do. So does Lee Grant, playing the role of the forgotten wife on the verge of alcoholism, to the hilt. There is a variety of supporting players, each with their own personal tragedies. Taken tongue-in-cheek, *Airport '77* is two of the best hours of good clean fun you'll find for a while.

Nasty Habits is a fun movie of a different sort. It's a parody of the Watergate mess, this time taking place in a convent. The Abbess (head nun) of Philadelphia has died without appointing her successor. That leaves the two candidates, Sister Alexandra (Glenda Jackson) and Sis-

ter Felicity (Susan Penhaligon) to fight it out to the death. The overly ambitious Alexandra takes every precaution necessary to insure her victory, aided by her cohorts Geraldine Page and Anne Jackson. The goings-on that ensue make up the balance of the movie, which has excellent supporting acting in the portrayals of Sandy Dennis, Anne Meara, and Melina Mercouri as nuns; and Jerry Stiller and Eli Wallach as Jesuit priests.

If you're an adventure-movie fan, you'll thrill to the excitement of Stanley Kramer's *The Domino Principle*, featuring Gene Hackman and Candice Bergen, and *Black Sunday*, starring Bruce Dern in a story about an Arab terrorist act set for the Super Bowl.

Meanwhile, casting has been completed for Neil Simon's new movie, *The Cheap Detective*. Peter Falk will lead a cast that includes Marsha Mason (Simon's wife), Stockard Channing, Lily Tomlin, Eileen Brennan, Madeleine Kahn, and Louise Fletcher. With such an impressive array of talent, Simon will hopefully come up with something better than his recent *Murder by Death*.

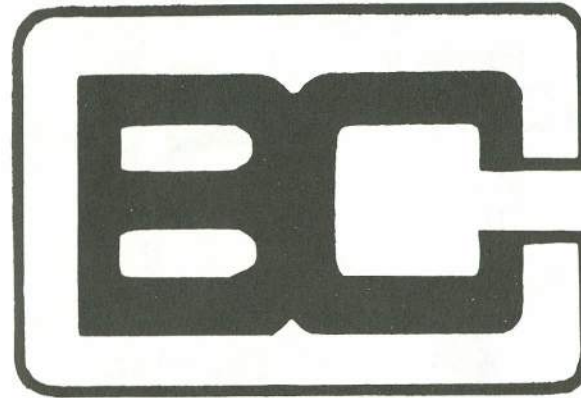
best and hopefully will tour with the show in the near future. If you want more lowdown on her, check recent stories in *Time*, *Newsweek*, and *Rolling Stone*.
