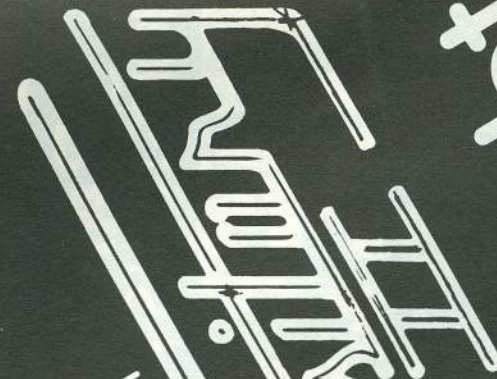

### PRIME CUTS FROM AUSTIN

Applications are available wherever you see a Mr. Gay Metro Austin poster. Contestants will be judged on sportswear, casual wear, swimwear, response to questions, and personal interviews. The winner will represent Austin in the Mr. Gay Texas Pageant later in the summer.

### "STEMS AND SEEDS" AUDITIONS

Producer Phil Osterman has selected Houston as the point of origin for his new contemporary revue show *Stems and Seeds*. As a multi-media extravaganza, *Stems and Seeds* will center around a cast of 16 performers of varied ages, drawn from Houston and New York talent. Written by Houstonians Carl Cochran and David Christian, the show is planned as a "theatrical event for those of high consciousness."

Auditions for Houston talent will be held on Sunday, April 24, at Liberty Hall, 1610 Chenevert. Singers will audition from 4-6pm; dancers from 7-8pm. Singers should be prepared to

perform two selections, one ballad and one song of a rock nature. A pianist will be provided.

The show is currently slated for a 4-week Houston run, followed by a brief West Coast tour, and then to its Broadway opening in late September. *Stems and Seeds* will be Osterman's first Houston-based production since departing Houston to undertake his now-famous hit *Let My People Come*.
