Dear Diary,

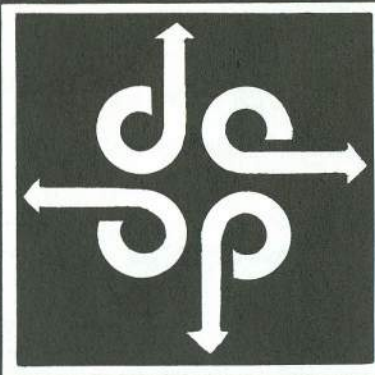

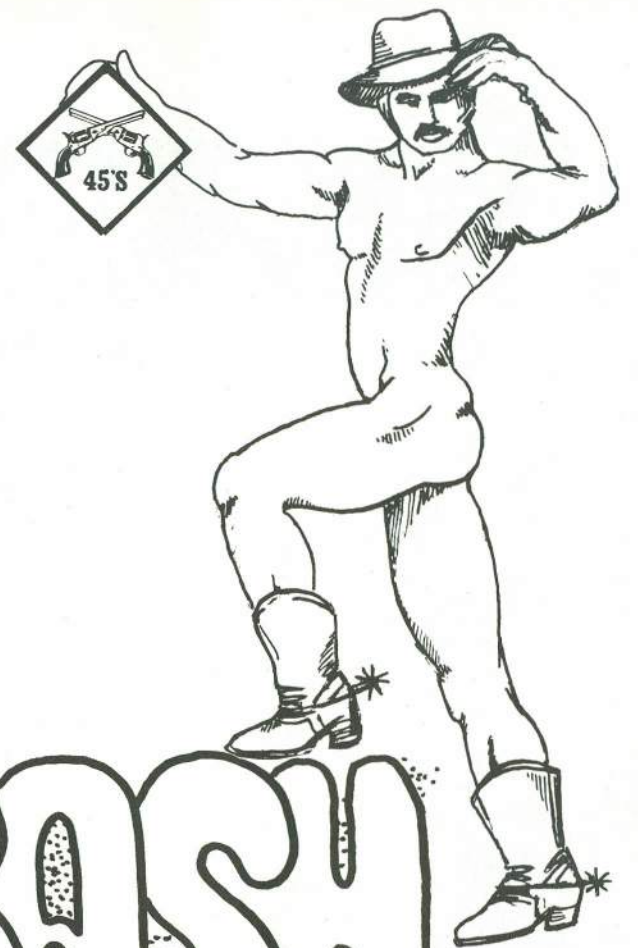

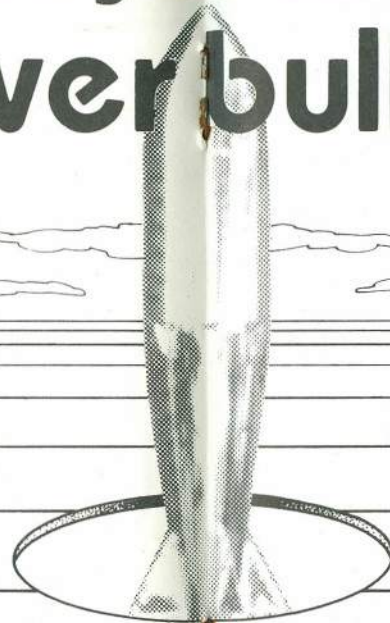

**EDITOR'S NOTE:** In recent weeks TWT has noticed that certain elements of the gay media have been discussing gay sex almost exclusively in the terms of relationships. In this first of a series of articles on gay sex as a purely erotic experience, Ray Hill discusses the moral and ethical implications of the "quick trick" as well as the cultural influences affecting attitudes toward purely erotic sex.

Like most of you, I read what is written in the gay media. I'm encouraged to see increasing interest in serious discussion of politics, social change, and the like. There has recently been some written expression toward the end of defining a sexual moral/ethical code for gays. It is about time we aired such topics. Hopefully we will not institutionalize one universal system of morals and ethics, but rather offer a range of options from which each of us can custom tailor our own values.

While teaching "The Homosexual Experience" at the University of Houston or conducting retreats and seminars for gay people, I spend considerable time talking about sexual ethics and/or relationship responsibilities. The inter-

est in these topics is high. Without cloaking intimacy in the romantic rhetoric that defies rational examination, I try to elevate intimacy to an appropriate level to be a desirable goal in the lives of those who express an interest in serious relationships. A meaningful intimate relationship is a reasonable goal most serious people can attain.

As I elevate intimacy, I do not denigrate erotic experiences outside of intimate relationships. The purely erotic experience has value too. The value may be of a different sort when compared with the value of intimacy, but in ethical terms may be just as positive and meaningful to the parties involved.

Some recent writers seem to have dif-

ficulty finding value in the purely erotic. I think I know where their confusion comes from. In our society (Judeo/Christian Western Culture) we have only three reasons to fuck:

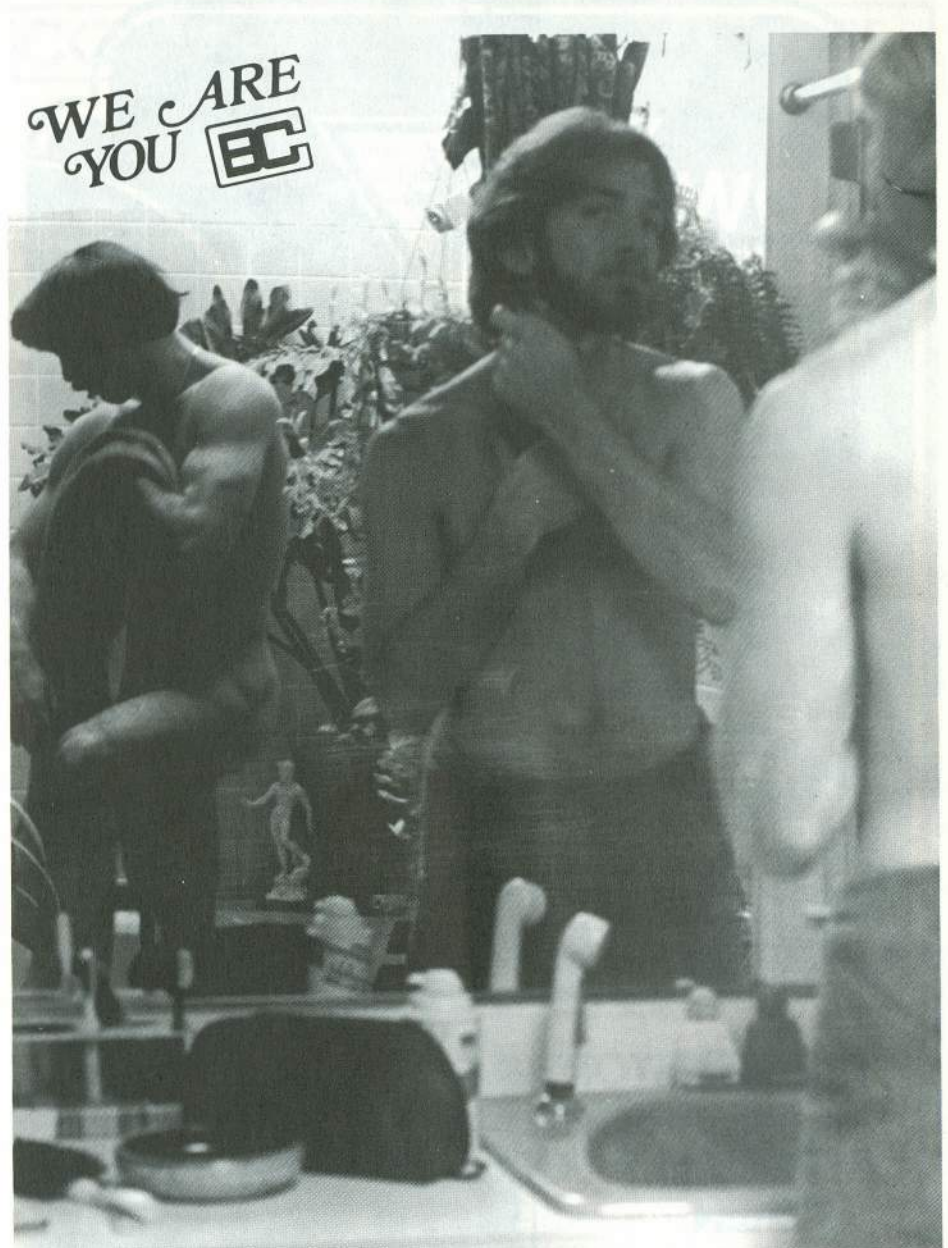
(1) *Reproduction.* This is "good" sex by Biblical commandment. In fact it is the one commandment we have obeyed to excess. We have populated and populated, and populated, until we run the risk of smothering our civilization in one another's excrement.

(2) *Expression of love.* This too is "good" sex, but uncommanded. The usual religious rhetoric implies that it isn't real love unless it has been licensed by the state and blessed by the church. By the time one has gone through all the paper work and rituals he or she has lost the emotional basis for the act.

(3) *Lust.* Any sexual activity not included in the above categories is lust and is "bad" sex. Lust is supposed to be condemned in our society irrespective of how much of it is going on. The principle applied to the condemnation of lust is the counter-religious notion that it is selfish abuse of self and others for sexual gratification.

Masturbation must be lustful because hands do not get "great with child" and self-love does not meet the criteria for (2) above. Gay chance encounters with strangers cannot be included in (1) and (2), so these are also "bad" (3). Prosti-

tution is allowing oneself to be used (lustfully, we assume) for a fee which the entrepreneur selfishly requires. So, prostitution violates the selfish taboo twice and gets double the condemnation.

All the above are too simplistic, too negative, and too far removed from my own experience to be accepted in whole cloth. One needs only look into a few other cultures to find a broader rationale for sexual expressions: Many Eastern cultures offer respect as a sexually expressive notion. Some cultures use sexual experiences therapeutically to treat depression, low self-esteem, or loneliness. Gratitude, congratulations, joy, or a variety of celebrations have sexually expressive potential, but not as our culture understands and uses sex.

If these ideas seem strange to you, please be advised that our notions about sex seem strange to other cultures. Over the millenia we have negated the value of sex below other forms of communication. Sex in this society is more frequently a source of guilt, shame, and

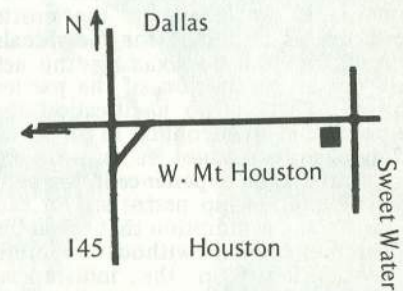

embarrassment than a source of joy and fulfillment. We have repressed our sexuality to the point that all adolescents and most adults are at least anxious about their sexual urges if not indeed frustrated. Sexual objects and symbols may be used in our society to economically rape our minds and alter our buying habits. Anita Bryant's tits are more responsible for our morning choice of juices than health values of the product.

It is that repression that creates our negative view of the purely erotic experience. If we condemn the erotic experience as degrading the individuals involved, we fail to examine the act itself or the motivation of the parties involved. There is no justification for the belief that an encounter in the baths and bookstores cannot be as meaningfully shared as an experience in the bedroom of relationship partners. Nor can we justify the assumption that the act is selfishly motivated without enduring positive effects on the individuals.

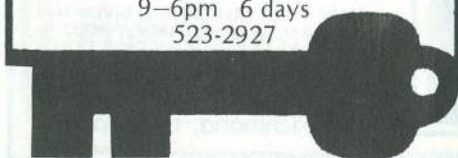
I have had significant sexual experiences with people I did not know before and have not seen since. 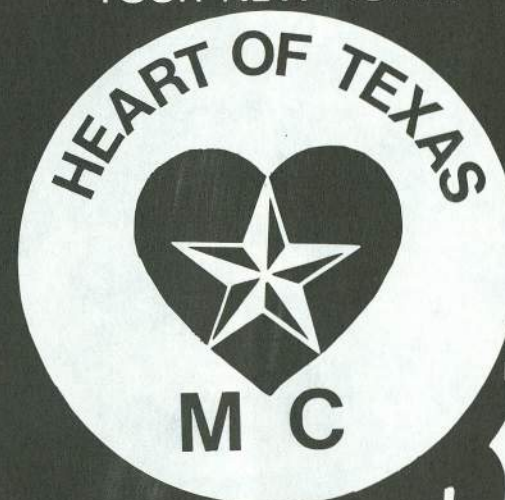

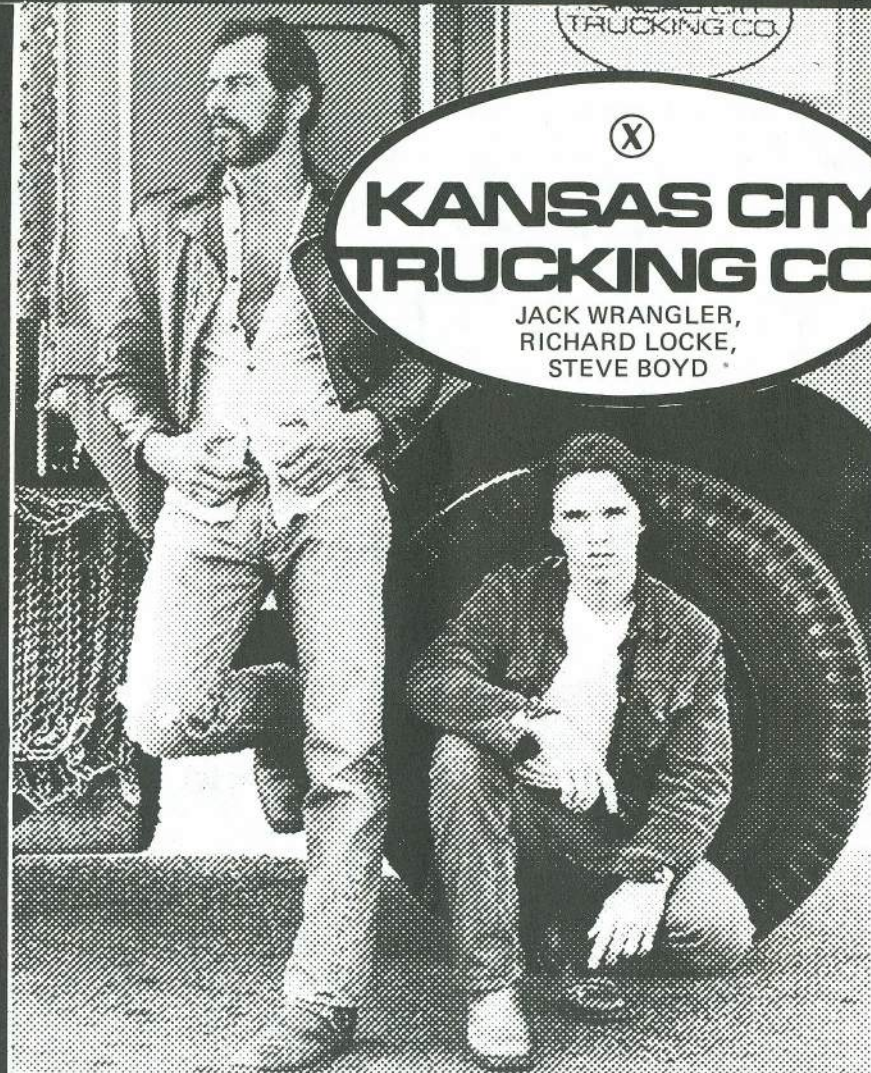

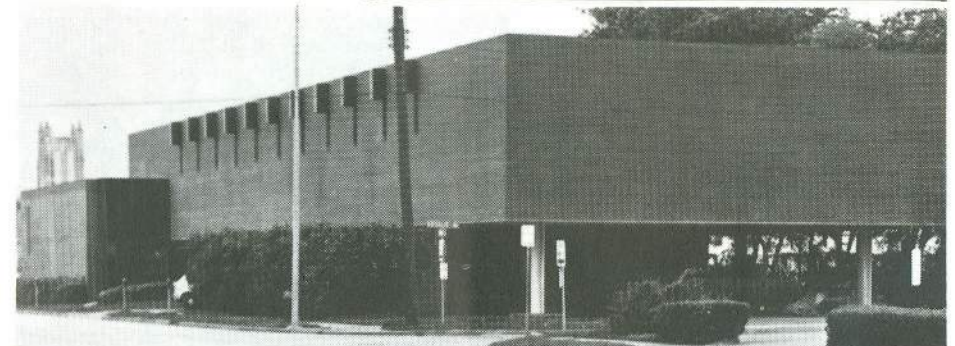
