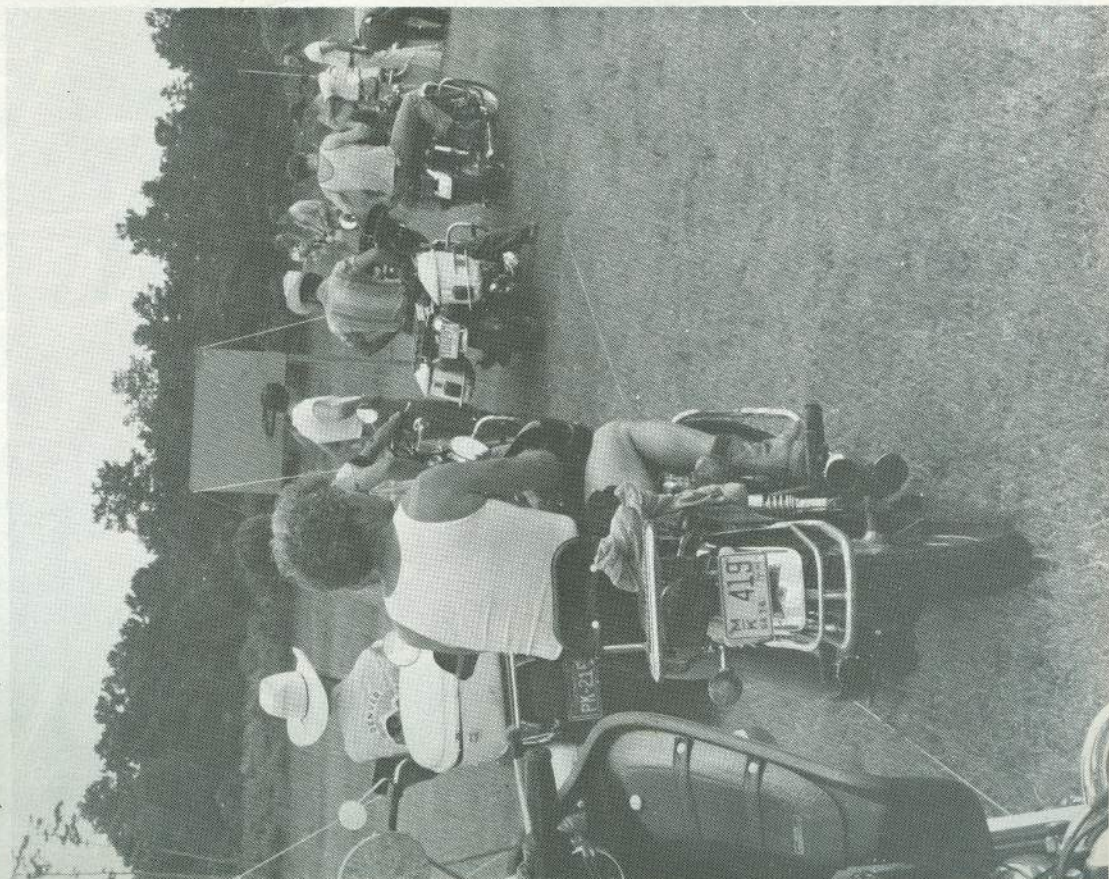

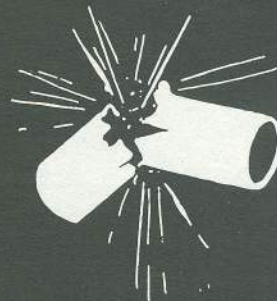

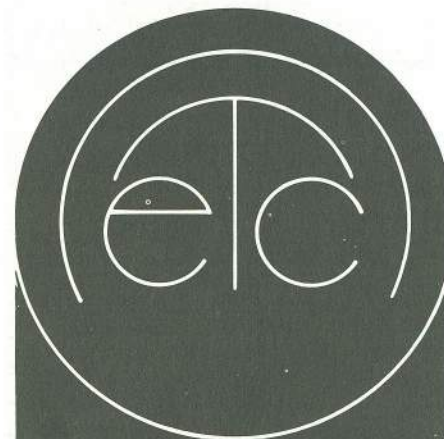

HOUSTON CITY COUNCIL ZONES EVERYTHING "ADULT" OUT OF BUSINESS

On Tuesday, June 28, Houston City Council voted to outlaw any "adult commercial establishment" operating within 2000 feet of a church, school, or other educational or charitable institution. In effect, the ordinance bans the sale or display or performance of any material depicting sexual conduct or "specified anatomical areas." Those last 3 words are the clinkers. They are defined to mean "(1) less than completely and opaquely covered (a) human genitals, pubic region, (b) buttock, and (c) female breast below a point immediately above the top of the areola; and, (2) human male genitals in a discernibly turgid state, even if completely and opaquely covered."

In other words, *God help you if you should walk out of a Montrose bar with a hard-on.*



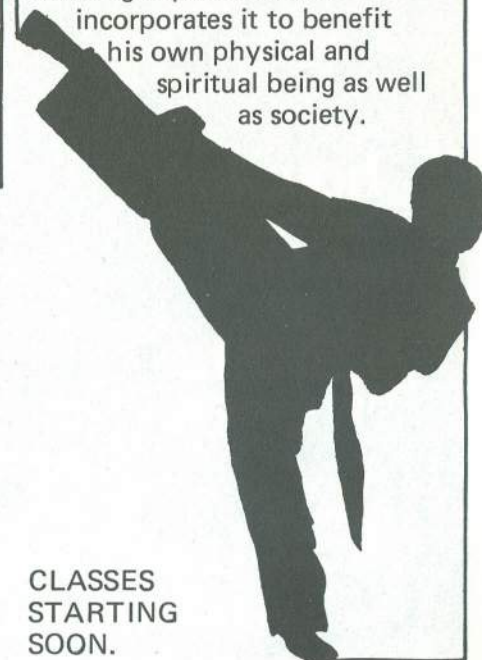

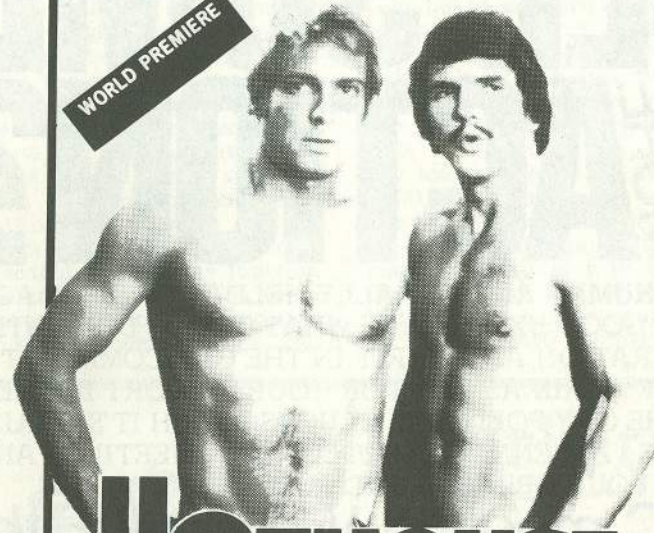

THE ROLE OF GAY BATHS AND BOOKSTORES

Continuing the theme of the second article in this series, I hope to explain the roles of gay baths and bookstores within our community. The baths have parallels back to early history. The Greek and Roman baths, built at public expense, often served the same function as the Club Bath and the Midtowne Spa serve today. The scale was apparently different but the idea and activities within were much the same. Bookstores are, of course, of more recent origin. The basic idea of both is easy access to other willing partners for on-the-site cruising and consummation.

Irrespective of the views of a generally anti-sexual society, the function is both reasonable and valid. The establishments open their doors and provide accessible areas where patrons can

gather with common objectives in mind. The "our turf" notion has probably developed from the same idea that has existed for generations about gay bars and restaurants. Putting quarters into coin boxes and making the film start or checking into a back area of the baths establishes a constitutionally defensible private area similar to renting a hotel room or an apartment. The courts have recognized the principle all the way down to the lowly pay toilets. (Ten-cent privacy may cost \$100,000 in court costs to protect, but it is there if you can afford it.)

One of the rubs that make such places so popular with vice squads is that there are no heterosexual equivalents. The closest equivalent would be the massage parlors with female

prostitutes. But then that is a lot more expensive and one gets the impression that the macho police resent our bargain facilities. If they would stop and consider that the "sex hunt" is predominantly a male phenomena and occurs so rarely among American females that non-gay baths would be hard-pressed for female customers if they were established.

It must be noted that when police do raid and harrass the bookstore arcades and baths, their actions are always in violation of someone's constitutional rights. The charge of indecent exposure is invalid, on the face of it, if the defendant was exposing himself to others similarly exposed. The various sodomy laws are by their nature impossible to enforce if privacy is maintained to a defensible degree. So, the big concern is: How private are places with limited public access? Baths and arcades are certainly more private than available park bushes, yet the underbrush allows

defensible privacy if the only complaining viewer is also the arresting officer.

Our fears preventing an aggressive defense of our constitutional rights may be the main reason they are abused by officials.

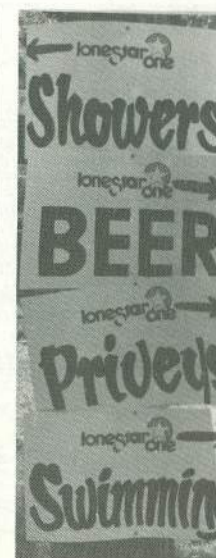
LONE STAR ONE!
