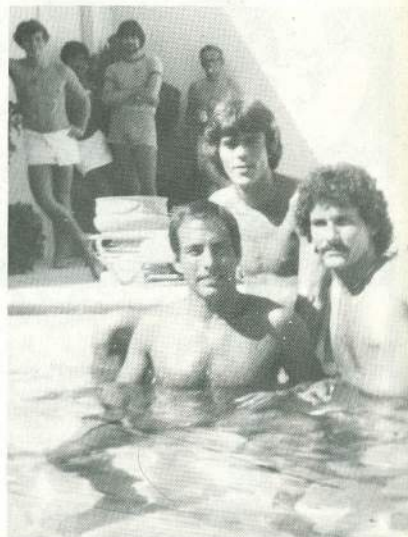

Life With Vera

VERA CASE CLUELESS!

HOUSTON — A spokesman for the Houston Police Department announced Thursday that the search for clues is continuing in the kidnapping case of local underground star "Vera." The Texas cult figure was apparently abducted from his West University home Tuesday night.

A friend of the star's, Burt Dennis, reported the crime to police after discovering the Vera home in a state of disarray. Authorities believe the kidnapers entered through the rear of the house and attacked the victim in his bedroom, or perhaps, his bathroom. Powder puffs, hair curlers, and Valiums were strewn around both rooms, indicating a struggle.

A portable hair dryer was found whirring on a bedside table. "Help Me" had been scrawled on a bedroom mirror in lipstick, while the bathroom mirror bore the lipstick message "I, Vera, being of

sound mind, do hereby bequeath my..." The remainder of that message was not legible.

Police lab technicians have now determined that the lipstick used to write the messages is red. There had been doubts concerning the color earlier. The first officers on the scene had failed to bring their color identification charts and three of the four officers mistakenly listed the color as "blue." The fourth wanted to write "blue," but didn't know how to make a "b."

When questioned by authorities, several neighbors recalled hearing screams from the victim's home at the time the abduction is believed to have occurred. Those neighbors add, however, that the screams did not arouse their suspicions because screams could be heard from the house EVERY night, usually accompan-

ied by a giggled "Oh, Mary!" Police are trying to discover if the kidnap victim was associated with any bizarre religious cults.

Robbery does not appear to be a motive in the incident. The victim's wallet, found in the lining of a Gucci handbag, contained cash. Also in the wallet were a laundry ticket, an autographed picture of Bette Davis, numerous Cash King game markers, and a Cert's labeled "emergency only." Police have expressed special interest in the Davis photograph.

"I think we could wrap this case up," a senior police captain confided, "if we could find out who this Davis dame is. Some of the guys say she looks vaguely familiar. We think she lives in Sharpstown."

A note was found inside the home pinned to the closet door with a dagger. The note said, "Only Anita has the right to sing. There will be no Montrose Choir. Save Our Children. Praise Jesus."

Police assured reporters that the note had no bearing on the case, and was merely a scrap of paper that had blown into the room and wedged itself between the dagger and the closet door.

Many of the victim's close friends pledged to do all possible to assure his safe return. The Dennis youth, along with roommate Zachary Whitney, has offered a reward for information concerning the case. That reward now stands at \$27.18, but Dennis and Whitney said they hope to increase it.

refused to give his name, today chained himself inside the House of Pies in protest. He said he won't come out until Vera is safely returned. So far, he has eaten 19 pies and gone through 4 bibs, each labeled "Phoebe."

When asked who "Phoebe" is, the man blushed for police and began wailing "FREE VERA! FREE VERA!"

Police admit that dusting the victim's home for fingerprints has not proved helpful. Although numerous fingerprints were found, they have all been verified as being only those of the victim, who apparently clutched numerous household objects to thwart the abductors. The indentions of groping fingernails were found on all the walls. And the ceiling.

The search for clues is now centered in the victim's backyard, where it is believed he was dragged from the house to the driveway. Large portions of the lawn appear uprooted along the pathway. As were three tulip beds and a shrub. Flakes of fingernail and dried fingernail polish were everywhere.



Motion picture sequels are big business. Good box-office response for nearly every movie over the past 5 years has qualified it for sequel consideration. The two biggest contemporary hits, *The Exorcist* and *Jaws*, are excellent examples. *The Exorcist, Part II: The Heretic*, opened recently in Texas theaters (albeit to bad reviews) and *Jaws II* is currently being prepared for the summer of '78. Multiple sequels to *Star Wars* and *The Omen* are likewise being readied. Even relative sleepers like *The Other Side of the Mountain* are eligible contenders.

Meanwhile, *Star Wars* has started a whole new trend in producing high-quality science-fiction flicks. Its overnight success and the incredible staying power of shows like *Star Trek* have made science-fiction projects the number one priority on film production lists. There's a possibility of a *Star Trek* feature film. Other projects are almost ready for distribution. The most promising of these is a project

that has been in production for 2 years called *Close Encounters of the Third Kind*. It will debut at Christmas time and its promoters say it will easily outdo *Star Wars* in appeal and success. Meanwhile, re-issues and sequels of science-fiction hits of the 50's and 60's are in the planning stages. Among these are *When Worlds Collide: Part II* and *Return of the Time Machine*.

Opening segments of this fall's TV series are already finished. In some cases, this has been accomplished without the series' stars. 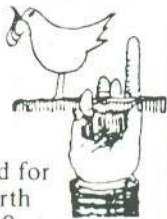

Farrah's case is interesting, not only because it's an unusual move by a yet-unproven success, but because it's representative of many new stars' feeling concerning their power to control their own careers.
