"Why don't we ... why don't we call Troy Perry!"

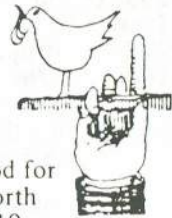

TV kernels: Johnny Carson has been offered \$5 million to make the jump to ABC. ABC made the offer amid speculation that NBC is searching for a replacement for Carson, whose ratings as Tonight Show host have continued to slip in response to late-night programming changes made by the other two networks.

ABC has signed Cloris Leachman to a long-term contract, now that she is free of commitments, due to cancellation of her hit CBS series *Phyllis*. The deal with ABC will include "several appearances" in the upcoming season, as well as the possibility of a series pilot.

ABC has also recruited Sander Vanocur and Cassie MacKin, both former NBC newsmen, in an effort to beef up their News Department.

Jackie Gleason and Art Carney will be reunited in at least one *Honeymooners* special this season. It will be filmed in Gleason's home base of Miami and will be aired around Christmastime.

A controversial TV-movie dealing with the problem of wife abuse is in

production stages. Dennis Weaver and Sally Struthers will co-star in the film to be entitled *Battered*.

Christmas specials on the various networks will include a behind-the-scenes look at the Tony-Award-winning musical *Annie* on NBC, and Mikhail Baryshnikov dancing *The Nutcracker* on CBS.

CBS' hit series *Good Times* has had its share of problems in its 5-year history. Last season, series star John Amos left because of dissatisfaction with the show's production. Now, the show's star, Esther Rolle, has missed two weeks of shooting — the reason being her resentment with "working conditions." The bad vibes are thought to stem mostly from jealousy over Jimmie (J.J.) Walker's popularity.

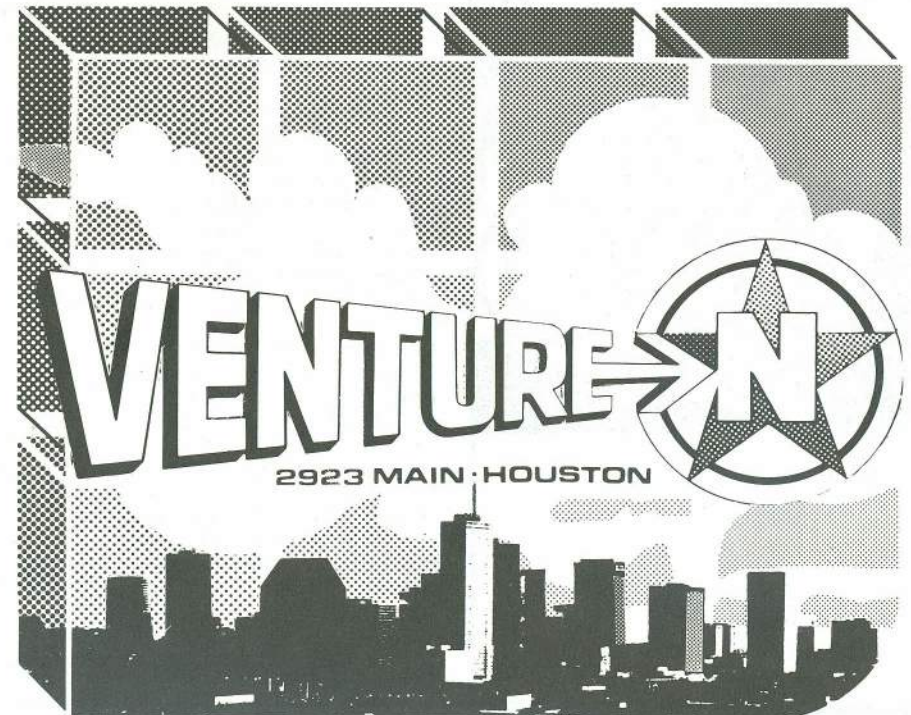
How do heterosexuals make love?



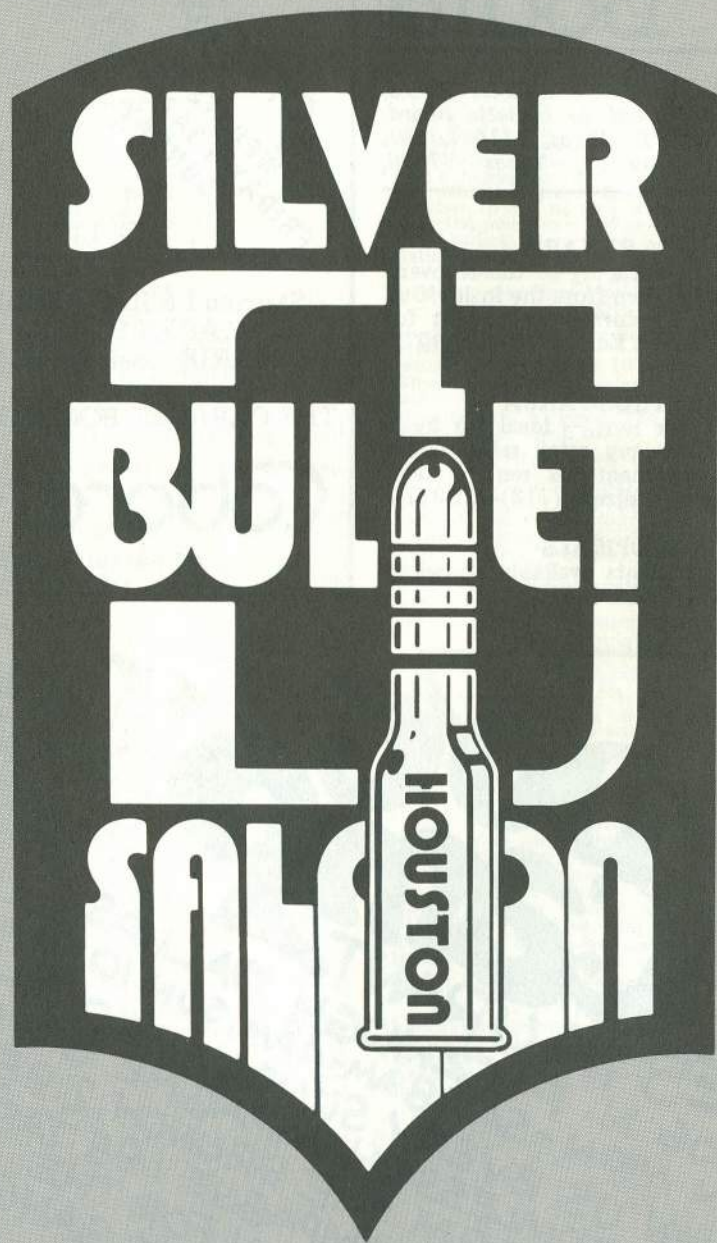

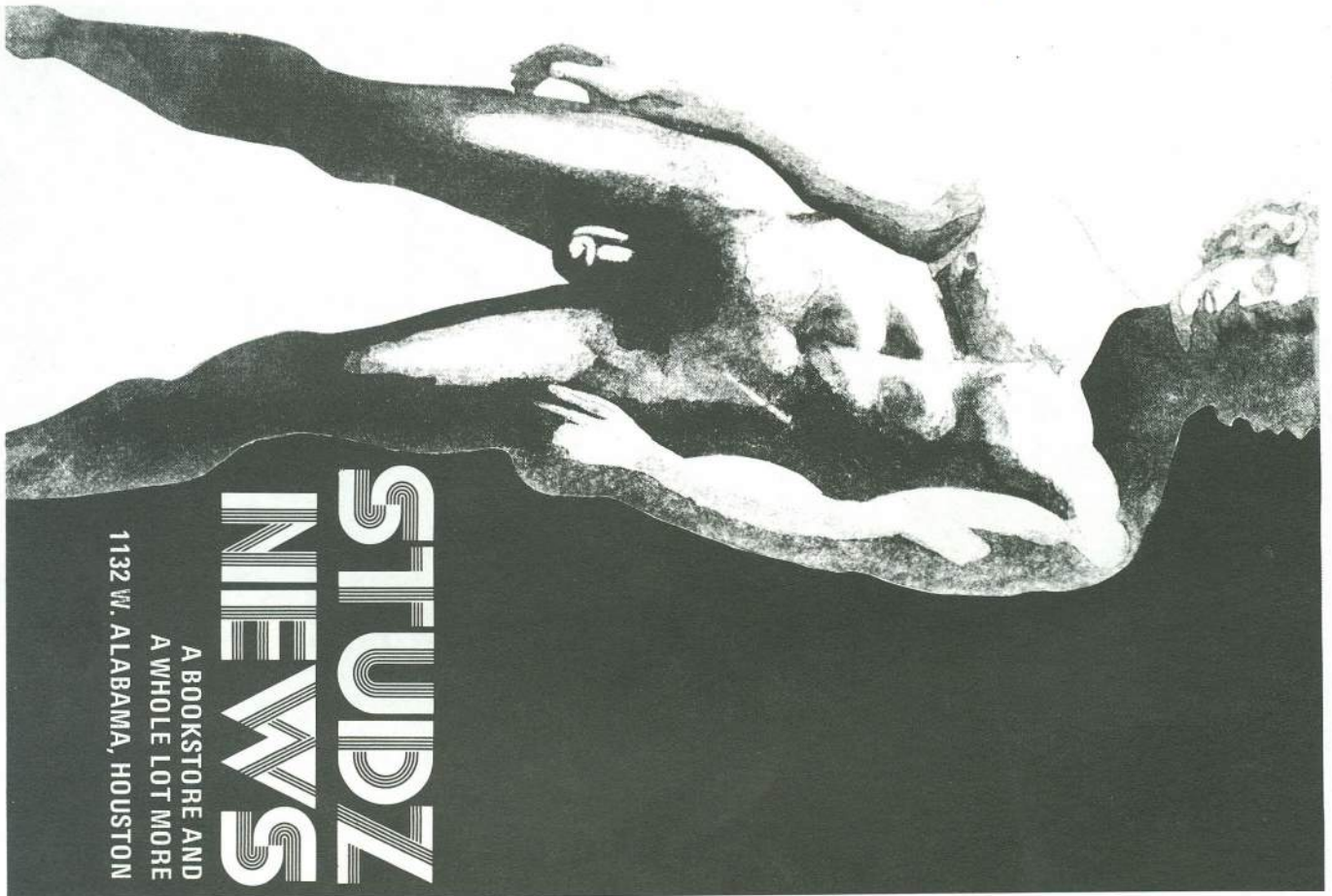
