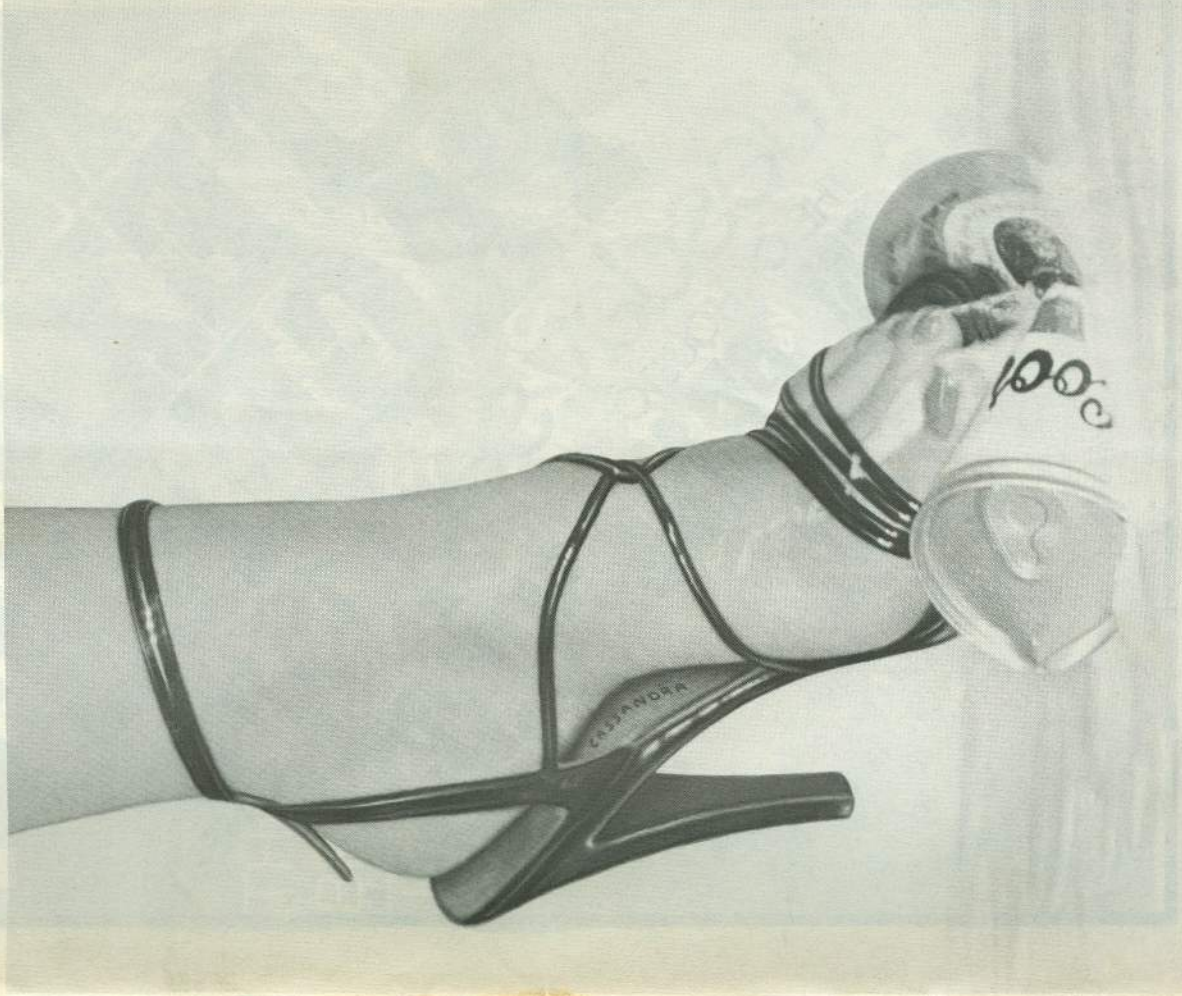
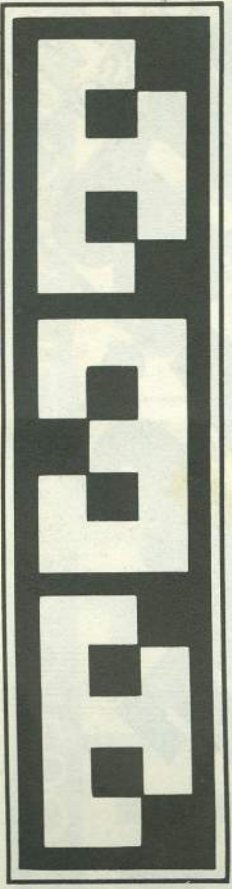

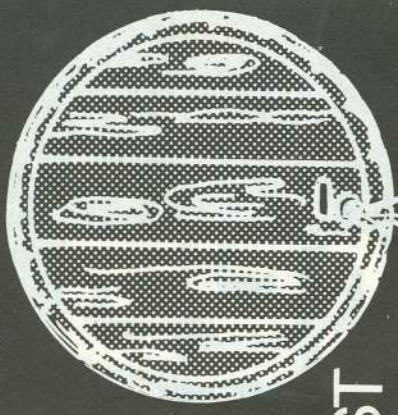

DAIR AND THE COORS BOYCOTT

The Dallas Alliance for Individual Rights (DAIR) is the first gay rights organization in the nation to organize a boycott against Coors beer for its anti-gay position.

Numerous anti-gay remarks by Mrs. Joseph Coors plus her financial support of several anti-gay organizations led the National Gay Leadership Conference to pass a unanimous resolution calling for a national boycott of Coors beer.

According to DAIR the Coors company routinely uses lie detector tests on its employees to find out the truth about their sex lives, life styles and political affiliations. DAIR says that the Coors private police force also uses no-warrant searches and seizures of employees private belongings including their lockers, clothing, lunch boxes and automobiles. Coors reportedly fires any employee who refuses to submit to such searches.

OP/GPC POLICY STATEMENT

At the recent monthly GPC meeting at Houston's Depository II, the manager of

the OP/Houston, Howard Neese, read a policy statement from himself, Frank Cavin and Charly Hott of the OP group. It was requested that portions of the statement be made public:

Howard said, "No one with proper identification will be refused for any reason of discrimination. We have signed the non-discrimination resolution of the GPC. My staff and I are committed to the dual goals of non-violence and non-discrimination. Our dress code sign will remain down."

"The OP is unswervingly committed to the long-term objectives of the GPC and the entire human rights movement. We have too much to do and too far to go to be less than united in the months ahead."

Howard then announced that all proceeds from the Mr. Texas Pageant to be held at the OP/Houston will be donated to human rights (GPC & HHRL).

"Well, who was it!"

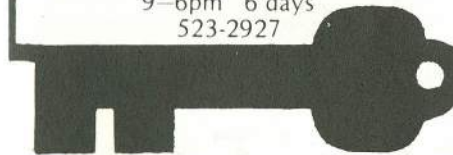
