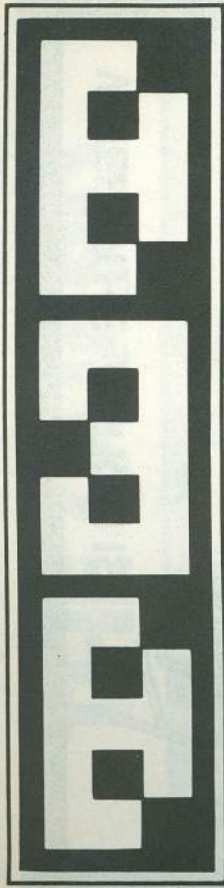

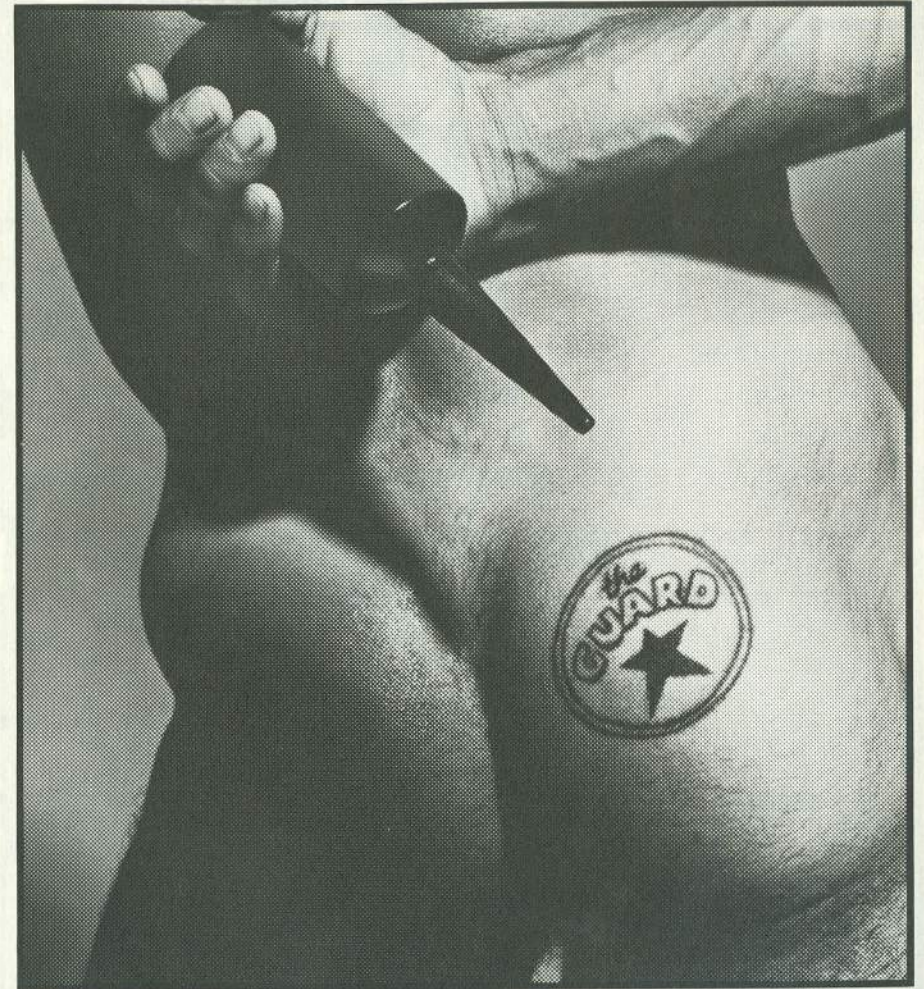



ARSON SUSPECTED IN BULLET BLAZE

Investigators from the Houston Fire Department suspect arson in the fire that damaged a popular bar, The Silver Bullet, early Saturday morning, October 8th. Occurring at 3:30am, while the bar was closed, there were no injuries. The fire erupted on the northeast side of the building, causing heavy damages to the pool table area. Game equipment, the ceiling of the area, and the bathroom suffered heaviest damages. The inside bar, though not damaged, will be temporarily closed until other debris is removed. The patio bar is open and the Acapulco weekend trip remains scheduled.

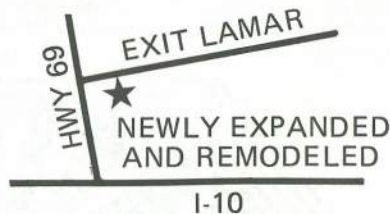

COORS AND COURT

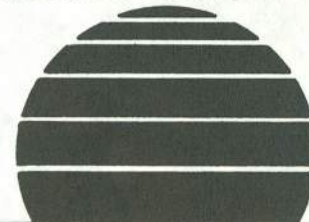
