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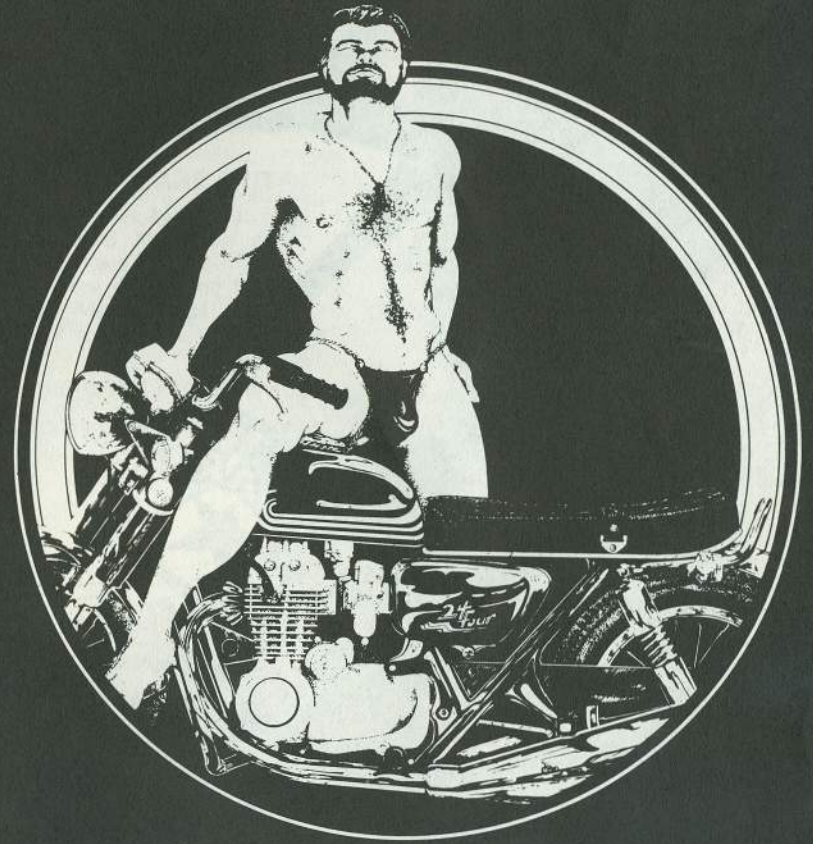

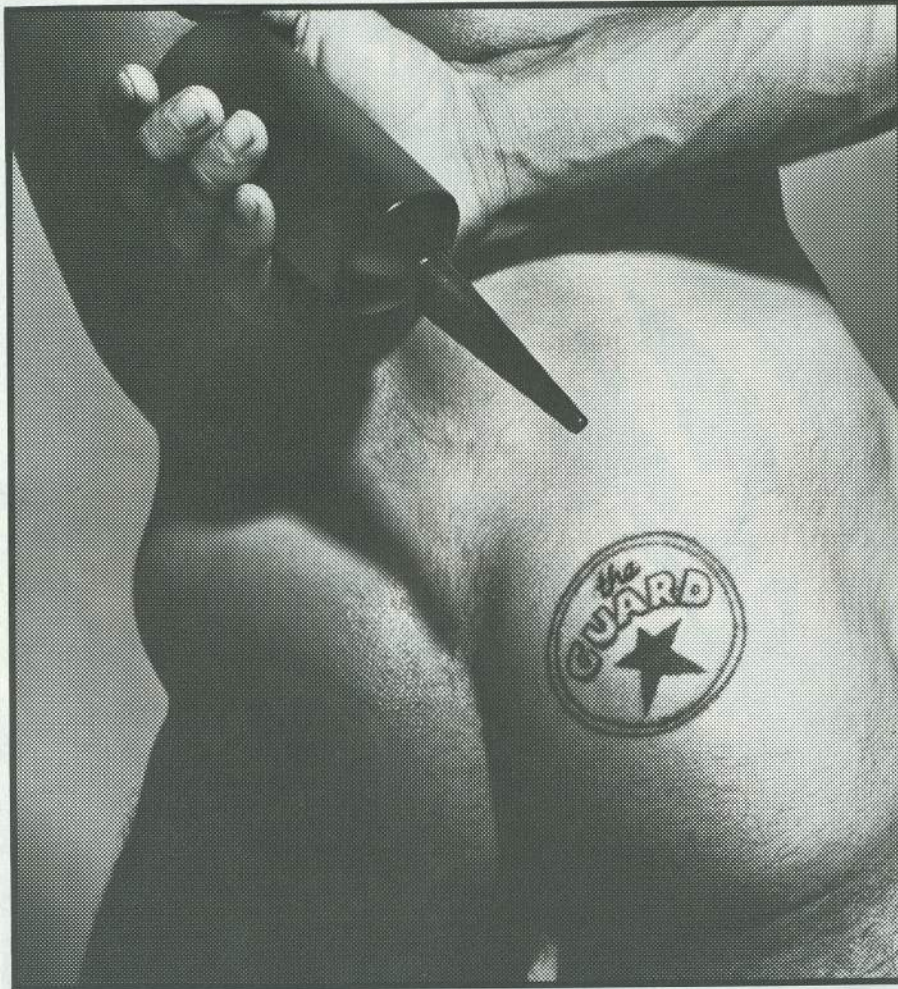

You may have observed the prolifera-

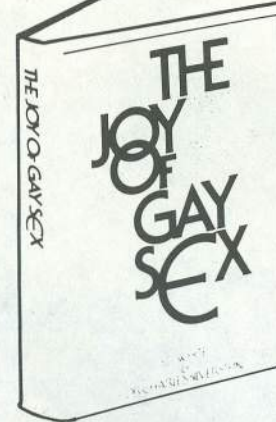

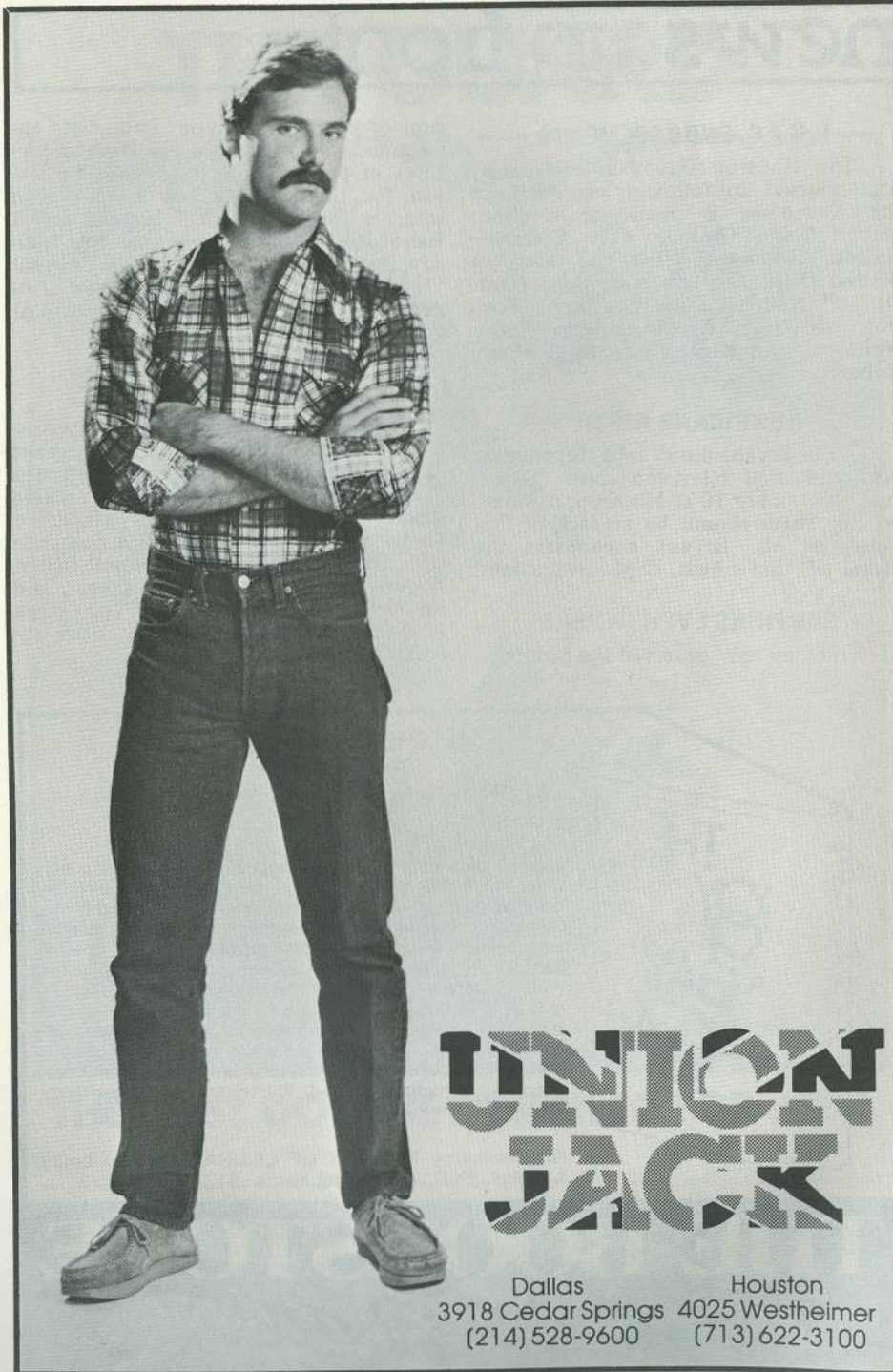

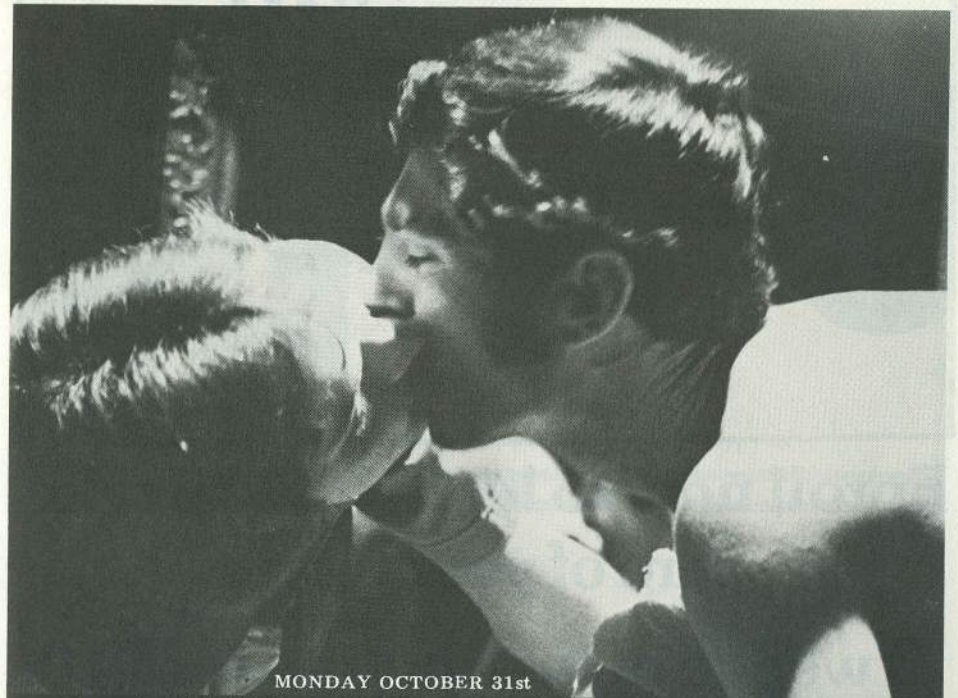
PRIZEWINNING BALLS!

It's been a strange new television season. The highly competitive rating race has led each of the networks to debut their shows when each show has its best shot. As a result, the season, which began way back in the first week of September, has taken a full two months to officially get under way. Already the season has had a few surprises. Before all of the shows had even premiered, some had been canceled. And, with ABC firmly holding on to its number one berth, you can bet that there are many more axings on the way, especially for numbers two and three, NBC and CBS, respectively.

Though ABC is still far ahead in the ratings, each of the networks has had its share of surprises and problems. While NBC hassled with Richard Pryor over the content of his show, which eventually led to the show being canceled, CBS watched almost helplessly as it slid into third place, victim of the *Big Event* stunt of NBC. ABC, meanwhile, watched nearly every one of its new shows

become quick successes, except for the one it pushed the hardest, *Soap*. That show is slowly sliding down the ratings chart.

With the ratings race lending what little excitement there is to the new season, film freaks are eagerly anticipating autumn releases by motion picture makers. Some of the films which are generating excitement and are due to be shown across Texas in the very near future include:

Oh, God, starring George Burns as God and John Denver as his appointed messenger in modern times, directed by Carl Reiner, is already big box office. *Damnation Alley*, starring the new king of the B-movies, Jan-Michael Vincent. *The Turning Point*, the story of two friends, played by Anne Bancroft and Shirley McLaine, who meet after twenty years separation, with ballet as the background. *Julia*, with Vanessa Redgrave and Jane Fonda, the story of Lillian Hellman and her close friend and mentor, Julia.

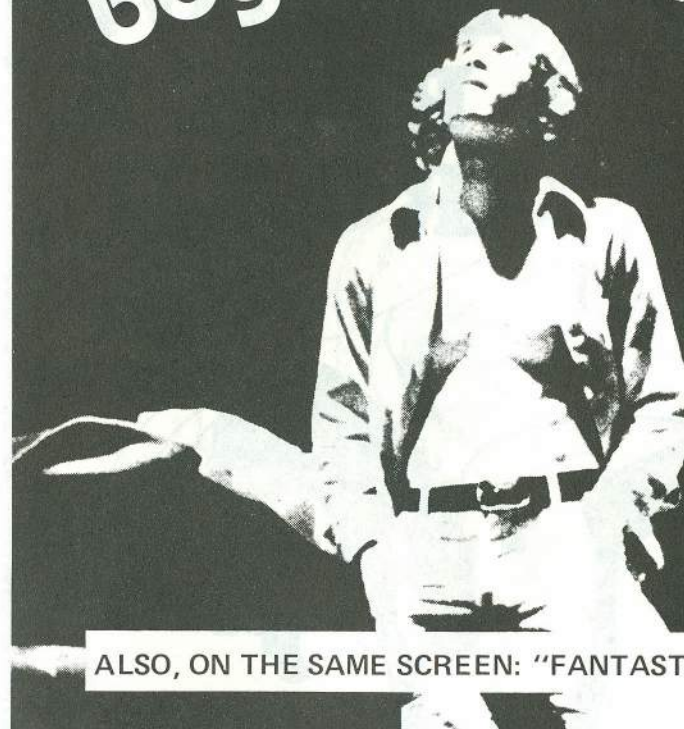

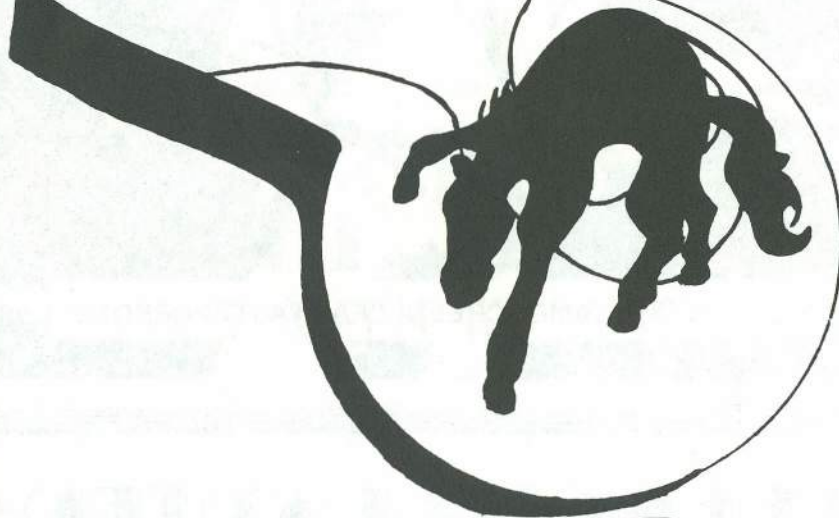

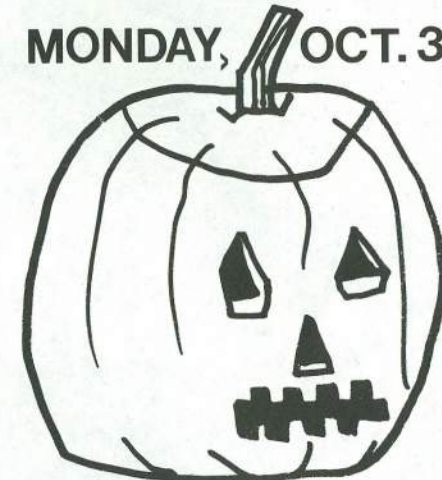

"It'd be so much simpler if we just waited till we got back to your house."

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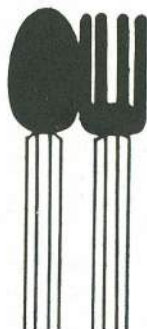
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"I'll buy us some real rolling papers on the way back to town."

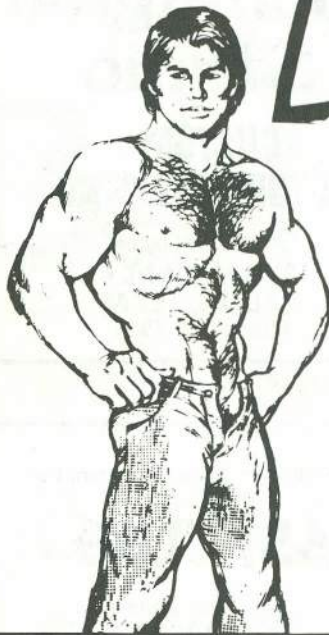
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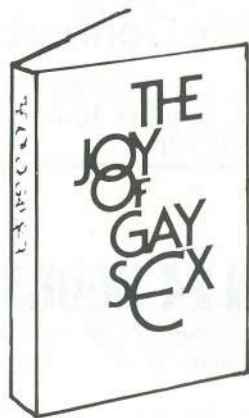
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"Will you stop repeating everything I say! I feel like I'm in echo canyon instead of on the prairie."

And, miracle of miracles, it did work. Ever so slowly, a small blaze began to grow. And, in no time at all, large billows of marijuana smoke began rising into the night air.

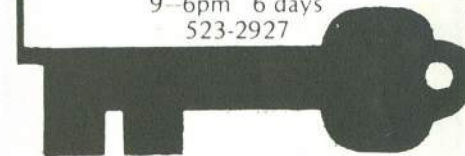
"C'mon, honey. Get down here on your knees. And start sucking. The smoke that is."
