LOOKING FOR MR. GOODBAR

If *Looking for Mr. Goodbar* ever becomes the commercial success its promoters hope, they can thank their lucky stars for Diane Keaton. For Keaton, in the lead role of Theresa Dunn, is the film's sole redeeming feature.

Eager anticipation for a film like *Looking for Mr. Goodbar* usually leads to high expectations. My expectations were many, but mainly two. That the basic story of the novel would remain intact in transition to the screen, and the fearful expectation that Diane Keaton (though I loved her in those Woody Allen comedies) was terribly miscast in a heavy dramatic role, especially this one. As it turned out, both of my expectations proved wrong.

Looking for Mr. Goodbar is the fictionalized version of the real life murder of a New York schoolteacher a few years ago. The teacher; whose name was changed to Theresa Dunn in the novel leads a double life: by day, a dedicated and hard-

working teacher; by night, a singles-bar cruiser, on the make for an easy fuck. On one particular evening, her trick for the night turned out to be a mistake. He murdered her. Judith Rossner, the book's author, investigated the case, turning it into a best selling novel.

To expect a best selling novel to make the transition to the big screen with its story intact in modern times is pretty ridiculous. It's especially ridiculous if the original has exploitable sex or violence, as does this one. And the film's director, Richard Brooks, whose film version of *In Cold Blood* proved startlingly accurate, failed to score with *Goodbar*. Rossner in the novel makes Theresa Dunn someone we not only understand, but someone with whom we can both identify and empathize. She builds her character so that when Theresa meets her untimely death, we may be puzzled about why it happened, but not how Theresa got there. The movie version, on the other hand, is

a patchwork quilt of meetings, comings, goings, and meaningless fucks. We know nothing about Theresa's motivations, so we are powerless to understand her. Because of this, the film's ending not only leaves us perplexed (it should), it leaves us uncaring (it shouldn't).

Keaton's forte, up to now, has been comedy. She has starred in several Woody Allen movies, most notably the recent *Annie Hall*. Her only dramatic role to date was that of Al Pacino's wife in *The Godfather Part II*. It was a risky decision to cast her as Theresa in *Goodbar*, especially considering that the film has Theresa as its sole focus. Yet Keaton gives Theresa total believability. As Theresa's life becomes more meaningless and bewildering, we feel sorry for her, even though we may not understand why. By building so realistic a character, Keaton has accomplished her task admirably.

Then too, there are some nice touches to *Looking for Mr. Goodbar*—some nice music, a few nice montage scenes, and an inspired ending sequence. But they are more than offset by lots of annoying little things. The film is at least thirty minutes too long, for one, and it's full of those loose ends that can drive you crazy. I'm not saying you shouldn't see *Looking for Mr. Goodbar*. With the promotional hype and word of mouth it will be getting in the next few weeks, it will be pretty hard not to see it. I'm just saying that if you do go, you'll be sorry.
