Many network prime time offerings are headed for the chopping block in the next few weeks. The highly competitive ratings race is tightening up with ABC faltering slightly in the lead, and CBS pulling out of the basement to challenge NBC for number two status. A quick look at the three networks' weekly entries shows why. Among the Big Hits for the season thus far are *Donny and Marie*, *Eight is Enough*, *Laverne and Shirley*, *Charlie's Angels*, *Love Boat*, and *What's Happening!* (all ABC), and some of the older CBS situation comedies like *All in the Family*. Probable cancellations in the next few weeks include *Big Hawaii*, *The Oregon Trail*, *Mulligan's Stew*, *Logan's Run* and *The Fitzpatricks*. Also, try not to grow too fond of the following shows because their continuation is extremely tentative: *The Carol Burnett Show*, *Lou Grant*, *Soap*, *Chips*, *Rosetti and Ryan*, *Fish*, and *San Pedro Beach Bums*.

The level of good taste and quality exhibited by some of this season's events,

both Big and small, is debatable, but here's one not to miss this weekend: *The Godfather Saga*, a special multi-parted combination of theatre features *The Godfather* and *The Godfather Part II*, (between them received over a dozen Academy Award nominations), as well as footage from those films never before seen. *The Godfather Saga*, featuring the astounding combination of Pacino, deNiro and Brando, with supporting performances equally as good by the likes of Diane Keaton, Robert Duvall, James Caan, Talia Shire, and many others, will be a treat. Watch for it.

On the big screen, expect Texas premieres of the following feature length motion pictures in the near future: *The Goodbye Girl*, a Neil Simon comedy starring Marsha Mason and Richard Dreyfuss as two single strangers who decide to live together platonically, for the sake of convenience . . . *A Night Full of Rain*, the first American film by brilliant Italian filmmaker Lina Wertmuller, stars Candice Bergen and Giancarlo Gianinni
