No doubt about it, the two big films for the month of December, across Texas and everywhere else, will be *The Turning Point* and *Close Encounters of the Third Kind*. *Turning Point* (starring Shirley McLaine, Anne Bancroft and Mikhail Baryshnikov concerns ballet and the choices to be made in life) and *Close Encounters*, (a story of contact with extraterrestrial beings) will be but two in the deluge of holiday releases, but they will be the duo people will be seeing and talking about. Advance notice from previews of both have been filled with superlatives, with *Encounters* expected to be the bigger box office smash. *Encounters* will not officially open nationwide until December 15, but tickets to advance showings in the Big Apple are reportedly being scalped at prices up to \$75.00.

*Encounters* will top off a good year for American film, in number of creative successes, and financial winners. Needless to say, *Star Wars* was the year's

top grosser; in fact, it recently surpassed *Jaws* in box office receipts to become the official top grossing film of all time. What was much more unexpected was to have a "little" movie like *Smokey and the Bandit* be the year's second biggest hit. That flick, which starred Burt Reynolds and Sally Field in a film that was one endless car chase, was re-released several times, each time doing astoundingly well. Number three for the year was *The Deep*.

Once the Christmas deluge is over, there will be some interesting movie choices in 1978. A feature length version of *Lord of the Rings* is the single most promising attraction for the first part of 1978. Spring will bring with it the premiere of *Coming Home* with Jane Fonda, and the film version of *Equus* with Richard Burton. Films that will be released for summer will include *Black Stallion*, the latest effort by Francis Ford Coppola, who directed the *Godfather* films; *Stallion* is a family-

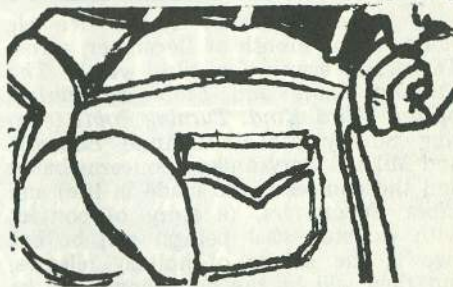

type story about, you-guessed-it, a horse; as well as the new Stallone flick, *F.I.S.T.*, which deals with growing up in New York's Hell's Kitchen district. *Dog Soldiers*, a Vietnam era story with Tuesday Weld and Nick Nolte, and *Comes a Horseman Wild and Free*, which will team Jane Fonda and James Caan, will be ready for release next fall. The end of the year will see release of *The End*, a Burt Reynolds production that will include Joanne Woodward, Sally Field, and Myrna Loy, and the film version of *Hair*, directed by Milos Forman (*Cuckoo's Nest*). Even more distant in the future are these projects currently under discussion; a sequel to *Butch Cassidy and the Sundance Kid*, tentatively starring William Katt, who scored recently with *Carrie* and *First Love*; an MGM remake of the *Jazz Singer*, very tentatively with Neil Diamond making his screen debut; and a sequel to *The Sting*, tentatively titled *Sting II*, which will team Lily Tomlin, Richard Pryor, and Jackie Gleason.

TV time: Several more prime time entries have been sacked, among them, sadly, NBC's *Man from Atlantis*, which will be slowly phased out. While that and other shows were receiving pink slips, others were getting the green light to go ahead for the "second season"; these included NBC's *Bionic Woman* and *Chips*; over at ABC, nearly all of the new shows have fared well and will be around for a while. At CBS things are considerably more chaotic: they've been number three in the ratings all season.

Popcorn potpourri: . . . CBS' *60 Minutes* is scoring such high ratings, (usually top ten) both NBC and ABC are frantically putting together their own prime time magazine-format shows . . . Dick Van Dyke has officially left *The Carol Burnett Show* for the remainder of the season, though he will appear as a guest on future shows, if there are future shows. No great loss, anyway . . . CBS has high hopes for its new sitcom, *Baby, I'm Back*, which had a trial rerun a few weeks ago. The all black comedy stars Denise Nicholas (*Room 222*) and Demond Wilson, (*Sanford and Son*) . . .
