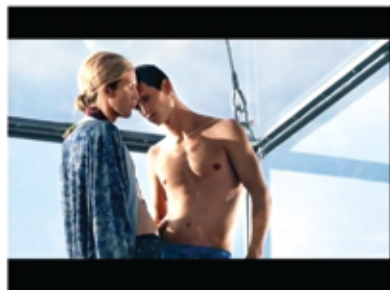

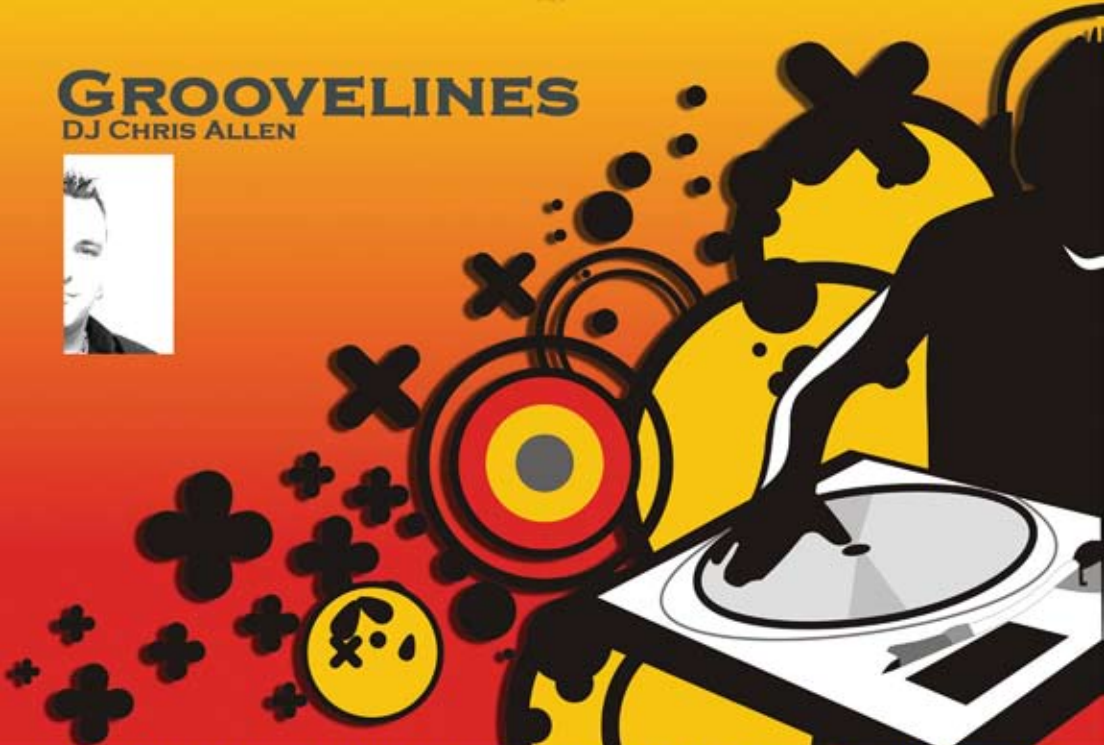

Over at iTunes, and hot for digital download, is the incredibly well planned and brilliantly executed new multi media package/campaign from drag diva and international superstar RuPaul. Our favorite supermodel works it like there's no tomorrow this go around, offering up a crazy new reality TV show, a slammin' new album, and a fun fierce new remix single to top it all off. Break out the plastic and get ready to spend some coins.

Like a true champ, RuPaul hit it out of the park and scored big in 1993 when his dance song and music video (and its now infamous catch phrase) Supermodel (You Better Work) became an international sensation bringing not only RuPaul's beautifully polished drag persona to the mainstream, but lending a hand to the house music movement as well. After nearly two decades, several hit singles, and a handful of very colorful expressive music videos later, RuPaul has become a highly-respected and well-loved fixture in today's gay culture. His fan base now global, RuPaul is a true diva for our modern world. No need for a comeback, RuPaul never left.

RuPaul's Drag Race airs every week on the gay cable network Logo. It is a sharp witty reality show where a group of drag queens (hand picked out of thousands of applicants by RuPaul himself) compete for the mad opp to become the next drag superstar. Surrounded by sponsor logos, each week the competing girls face clever and sometimes dif-



difficult challenges while they fight for the top spot. As the girls that end up in the bottom two for the week face the panel of judges, they are told by our host, "The time has come for you to lip-sync for your life!" Last chance on the stairway. At the end of it all, after the week's losing queen has sashayed away, the remaining contestants strut their stuff on the runway to RuPaul's new single Cover Girl. Don't fuck it up, head over to [rupaulsdragrace.com](http://rupaulsdragrace.com) to learn more and watch the latest episode for free. Individual episodes are available for purchase online at iTunes.

The song Cover Girl comes from RuPaul's fantastic new album of fabulous electronic dance music appropriately titled Champion. iTunes buyers give the album four and a half out of five stars. It really is that good. I give it five. Dance beats for days, folks. What makes Champion stand out from all those other dance CDs out there? It is so catchy and inviting that I never once found myself wanting to press the skip button on my iPod. And when I finally did put it down, the music stayed with me. The melodies and harmonies stuck in my head.

It's not every day that happens to this DJ. The recipe called for a bit of electro, a tiddly tad of hip hop, a taste of house, a touch of the 80's, a dash of the 90's, and a heaping helping of computer generated fierceness. What a delicious dish. And damn if it ain't the gayest thing I've heard so far this year outside of the latest Erasure CD (more on that next week.)

Stand out tracks on RuPaul's Champion include The Main Event,

the ever so sassy Don't Be Jealous Of My Boogie, the Theme From RuPaul's Drag Race, the super housed out Throw Ya Hands Up - featuring RuPaul's long time pal Lady Bunny - and the oh-so-clever closer Tranny Chaser. The remix package for Cover Girl is pretty fab, as well. There are eight RuMixes total available on this one. Each one a hands-in-the-air anthem. Sexy circuit DJ Joe Gauthreaux offers up a super tasty tribal mix. The Twisted Dee mix simply pees puddles. Love the wah wah guitars. Nice touch. Another top notch production from one of my favorite gals in the biz. There are also two bouncin' mixes from RevoLucian as well, a little more on the housey side. Regardless of your favorite flavor, on this one there is surely a mix for you. and Shear Genius to classic movies, life as a gay couple and just plain old celebrity gossip."

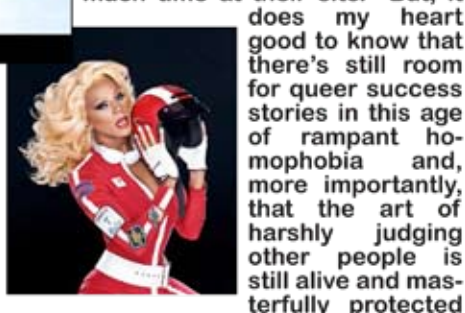
And they just keep getting bigger and more popular. "In addition to our blogging, we've been slinging the occasional celebrity or style interview over at the



# Gary Floyd

**TWT sat down with multi-faceted, multi-talented, Conroe Texas-native Gary Floyd recently to see what's happening in his free-spirit world. Many of you may recognize him from his regular engagements at Bill's Hideaway and Alexandre's or performances at Theater 3. Some of you may think he looks vaguely familiar like someone you saw in LA or Nashville a few years ago. Well, it just might be him.**



**you currently play at Bill's and Alexandre's?**

*If you come out to hear me, you'll hear a lot of my original music. It's pretty straight-forward, piano-based pop music, with a little country/R&B flavor. I grew up singing in church, so there's definitely a gospel element to my music. The covers I play span everything from Broadway to Sting. If I can feel it, and put myself in the song, I'll sing it.*

**You are a singer and a songwriter. What were your musical influences?**

*Well, I was raised on Contemporary Christian music, so artists like Keith Green, Tim Sheppard, and Amy Grant were my early influences. I've also been influenced a lot by James Taylor, Kenny Loggins - a lot of the 70s singer/songwriters.*



**Getting outside your element and growing is often a good thing. Tell us about your LA and Nashville experiences. What brought you out there, how did it impact your music, and what brought you back to the Lone Star state?**

*Ah. When I think of my time in Venice Beach, it's like a dream. I lived right on the ocean, so a lot of the songs I wrote there have water images in them. It was a real time of soul-searching and awakening, and that's definitely reflected in the songs from that time. I sang songwriter demos by the ocean for 5 years, and met lots of wonderful people. Some of them encouraged me to try Nashville, and get my songs heard there. I took the bait, and lived in Nashville, pounding the pavement for a few years. I lived on a porch on Music Row, and my friend, Hardy, calls the songs I wrote there my "Porch Song Trilogy". I love that! Most of my Nashville songs are about letting go and moving on. I think my free spirit was a little too free for Music City, so I moved back to Dallas in 2003.*

**In a nutshell, tell us about yourself and what you do.**

*By profession, I'm a singer/songwriter/actor. And you hit the nail on the Head - I am definitely a free spirit. Haven't always been, but I'm much freer these days. Glad you noticed.*

**As an artist, it's always a blessing to be able to do what you love. What engagements currently fill up your calendar?**

*Anytime I'm behind a piano, I'm pretty much in my element, and I get a chance to do that most every Wednesday night at Bill's Hideaway. I've also been playing other gigs around town, here and there, and always love the chance to sink my teeth into a great theater piece.*

**How would you describe the music**

**What projects are you working on currently? Anything coming down the pipeline you can share?**

*After all these years, I finally just shot my very first music video for Art4Peace&Justice. Shawn Northcutt directed it, and I think he knocked it out of the ballpark. I'm real happy with it. If you want to see it, go to YouTube and type in Gary Floyd Look No*



**Do you have any particular cause close to your heart that you support?**

*My friend, Denise Lee, and I have an organization called Together We Can. It was born out of a desire to take the gifts we have been given, and give back by choosing an organization each year to raise awareness and funds for. We wanted to help folks who are already out there on the front lines. In our five years, we have helped AIDS Arms, Genesis Women's Shelter, GINA For Missing Persons and SoupMobile. We're all in this together, and if we band together, we can make a difference in our part of the world.*

**For your fans not able to see you in Dallas, do you have any recommendations for them? Any plans to perform outside Dallas in the near future?**

*I always have my feelers out. If you have*

*any ideas, let me know. I always love to play music for people. 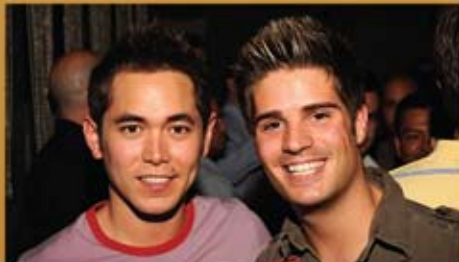
# HOUSTON
