Howdy disco citizens! It's time for your weekly dose of Groovelines – your source for what's hot and hip in the land of electronic dance music and beyond.



Over at **Masterbeat.com**, and hot for digital download, is the latest edition of *Toolroom Knights* featuring electro house producer and DJ **Benny Benassi**. There are actually 2 versions of this one available. The first is already mixed and ready to go for only \$9.99 whilst the other version is unmixed and contains the full length versions of all 26 tracks but priced

a little higher at \$15.99. Some of the songs are available for individual purchase at \$1.49 a piece, though most are album only. Highlights on this new mix from the UK based **Toolroom Records** include floor fillers from Deadmau5, Iggy Pop, Pete Tong, Tiga, ATFC, Faithless, & Dave Spoon, to name a few. Benassi lets us have it on this disc keeping the beats phat, the bass dirty, and the NRG high. Benassi's edition of *Toolroom Knights* is kinda electro, sort of housey, filthy and cool, yet sexy and smooth. This nonstop party mix, when played loudly, is best for an after-hours pool party amongst friends, a drive around town with the windows down, a fierce workout, or a sweaty romp between the sheets. Previous *Toolroom Knights* compilations have featured Gabriel & Dresden, Mark Knight, Dave Spoon, Wally Lopez & Tom Novy, and Dirty South. Best known for his legendary 2002 dance track *Satisfaction*, Benny Benassi also won a Grammy for his remix of the classic Public Enemy hit *Bring the Noise* in the best remix category in 2008. Benny Benassi's steamin' hot one hour radio show, *The Benny Benassi Show*, airs every Saturday on Area (channel 80 on Sirius XM satellite radio.) Over at **Beatport.com**, just waiting to suck on your bandwidth, is the new one from Texas-based producers **Cortinas & Wade**. Talkin' about *Daybreak* by **Tritonal** featuring **Christina Soto** on vocals. If



there is one thing that Cortinas & Wade know how to do it's lay down some bad

ass beats and produce not just good, but great dance music. No stranger to the underground

electronic dance music scene in Austin, these boys rock the floor right. Although their previous work is a bit more electro and housey in style I found their mix of *Daybreak* to be a refreshing change. It is a lot more trancey than I expected. I was



pleasantly surprised. It is absolutely beautiful. Dane-ja @ OCH would call it gorgeous. Further proof that Texas has got some serious talent rising to the surface. Be



sure to also give a listen to this dynamic duo's super sweet 2008 debut, *You Got It*, as well as their slammin' mix of *Disco Jackin* by L Boogie. To hear the March
