## im from driftwood true stories by gay people from all over

I was doing my usual trolling the 'net, looking for current news, Michelle Obama's latest fashion statement and, okay, naked men, when I stopped by Towleroad – the site with homosexual tendencies – and noticed an update about the creation of a site entitled im from driftwood, which features submitted stories (accompanied by satellite photos of the writer's location) written by people from all over in the hopes that struggling teens won't feel so alone.

Ever the sap when it comes to all things heart-felt, I naturally drifted over to Driftwood to see what my buddy Andy Towle was kvelling about. And, once I got there, I was hooked.

Created by Driftwood, Texas' very own Nathan Manske, im from driftwood is an open forum in which gay men and lesbian women can not only describe and detail their coming out process, but one in which they can share other gay-themed memories for a world-wide audience. Some of these memories are sweet, some sappy and some downright heart-rending, but they all come from individuals that come from areas where "those damn fags" supposedly don't live – individuals that, in some cases, may not even be out to their friends and families.

One of my favorite stories tells the tale of Queens, NY-native Damien Butwick's coming-out process with his family. Despite his understandable fear, it all turned out to be a non-event – partially because he comes "from a family of bleeding heart liberal Democrats." And while not all of the assembled stories are as positive as that one, they all resonate with truth and the basic human goodness that is fundamentally a part of each of us – which is one of the reasons why this blog is so powerful, because it so poignantly highlights just how much alike we all really are.

But what's the point of all these stories by gay people from all over? Well, there's a story for that. According to the Manske, "The morning after I watched the Gus Van Sant-directed, Sean Penn-starring, Dustin Lance Black-written Milk, would you believe I was inspired? But funny enough, what inspired me was Milk more so than Milk. An image I recalled wasn't even in the film. It was a photo of Supervisor Harvey Milk, one of the first openly gay elected officials in the U.S., riding on the hood of a car in a San Francisco Gay Pride march, holding a sign that reads, "I'm From Woodmere, N.Y." The sign was intended to show how far people came to attend the San Francisco rally, but it meant something more to me. It meant that there are gay people in every small town and every big city across America and the world. I was thinking about that photo in between assaults on the snooze button and I responded to Harvey's sign. I'm from Driftwood."



He goes on, "There are gay stories from every corner of the Earth and I think they should be told. But why? What does it mean??"

"To the gay teens struggling to come out and deal with their sexuality, who to this day still attempt suicide 4 times more than straight kids, it says "you are not alone."

Other people have dealt with similar situations, families, communities and churches, and have overcome and are now living happy lives. It can happen for you, too. It gets soooo much better, I promise. Hang in there, kiddo."

***"To the people who don't support equal rights, it says we're not all that different after all. We all have stories and problems and loves and lives just like everyone else. So maybe we should all be treated like everyone else, too."***

To the true story and short story enthusiasts, it says "Yay! True short stories!"

And while we're at it, what the heck. To the U.S. Census, it says "Pssst! We do exist." So how about counting us next time, 'kay? Thanks.

And, to saps like me, it says that there might yet be hope for us all.

I am not even sure Lady Bunny, who has recently been a DJ for our event, was of legal age at that time. Not that it matters...we still love her! It is all about Bunny Love after all.*

*The party became known as the name referenced above and has greatly evolved over the years. It is now known and respected as "Bunnies on the Bayou". The event occurs every year on Easter Sunday in downtown Houston at Fish Plaza. When it comes down to it, we are here to have a great time and raise a lot of money for our beneficiaries. It is all about them.*

**Being as Bunnies on the Bayou is XXX this year.. How do you feel "Bunny Love" is spreading your message?**

*Every year "Bunny Love" gets bigger and bigger, if you know what I mean. Even so, it is amazing how*

many people still do not know about the event. So, we keep spreading the word via publications like yours and other local print media. We also get referenced in various newspapers and of course there is Facebook and MySpace. All these avenues contribute to Bunnies raising more and more funds for our beneficiaries.

#### **What would the Easter Bunny say about your event?**

*Well, he has never said anything directly to us. We do know he loves Bunnies, and who do you think sets up for the event?*



#### **How do you feel about Bunny on Bunny Hate Crimes?**

*Um, were we not just talking about "Bunny Love"? We do not have Bunny on Bunny hate crimes. Things might get a little rough from time to time, but it is all in good fun.*

#### **Please tell us about your event, and it's history.**

*On a sunny Easter Sunday in 1979, a small party among friends gathered at an apartment complex on Clay Street in Houston, Texas. The word spread of the event, and the following year they set up a sound system outdoors and sent out invitations. By the mid-1980's, AIDS was taking a terrible toll and the party hosts decided to help their friends by charging an "admission" - a bag of food. By the early 1990's the party attendance had grown so large that the hosts decided to move to the new outdoor Fish Plaza at the Wortham Center downtown on Buffalo Bayou; Bunnies on the Bayou was born. Rather than food, the Bunnies began to raise money for local charities. Since that time, the event has grown to be Houston's largest annual outdoor cocktail party. Thousands of Houstonians and visitors have celebrated Easter with their friends, made new friends, and donated hundreds of thousands of dollars to area charities.*

*Bunnies on the Bayou brings together various groups within our community for a great time that helps many worthy causes. It is nice to know that people look forward to an event that many work so hard to produce. We are grateful for our many supporters, volunteers and sponsors that have been with us over the years.*

#### **How do you prepare for such an elaborate affair?**

*Bunnies is an all volunteer group that relies heavily on the time donated by our hosts, sponsors and volunteers. Our planning starts fairly quickly following our previous Easter event. We do a lessons learned and what to do differently survey, and this helps us figure out what to change or keep the same. After that we kick off our new year at the end of summer with a membership drive quickly followed by many meetings all of which start off with a "Happy Half Hour".*

#### **What separates you from the other functions in Texas?**

*A couple differences are that we are tied to a specific holiday and rely heavily on good weather. Not to split hares, but our event is very casual and strives to be very inclusive. Like other events across Texas, we have a great time and raise a lot of money for our beneficiaries.*

#### **What does the future hold for Bunnies on the Bayou?**

*We will keep chugging along and doing the best we can as an all volunteer organization. We are always looking for new hosts, sponsors and ideas to keep Bunnies "Bunnies", but we try to add a new twist to things every year.*

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# TWT Files

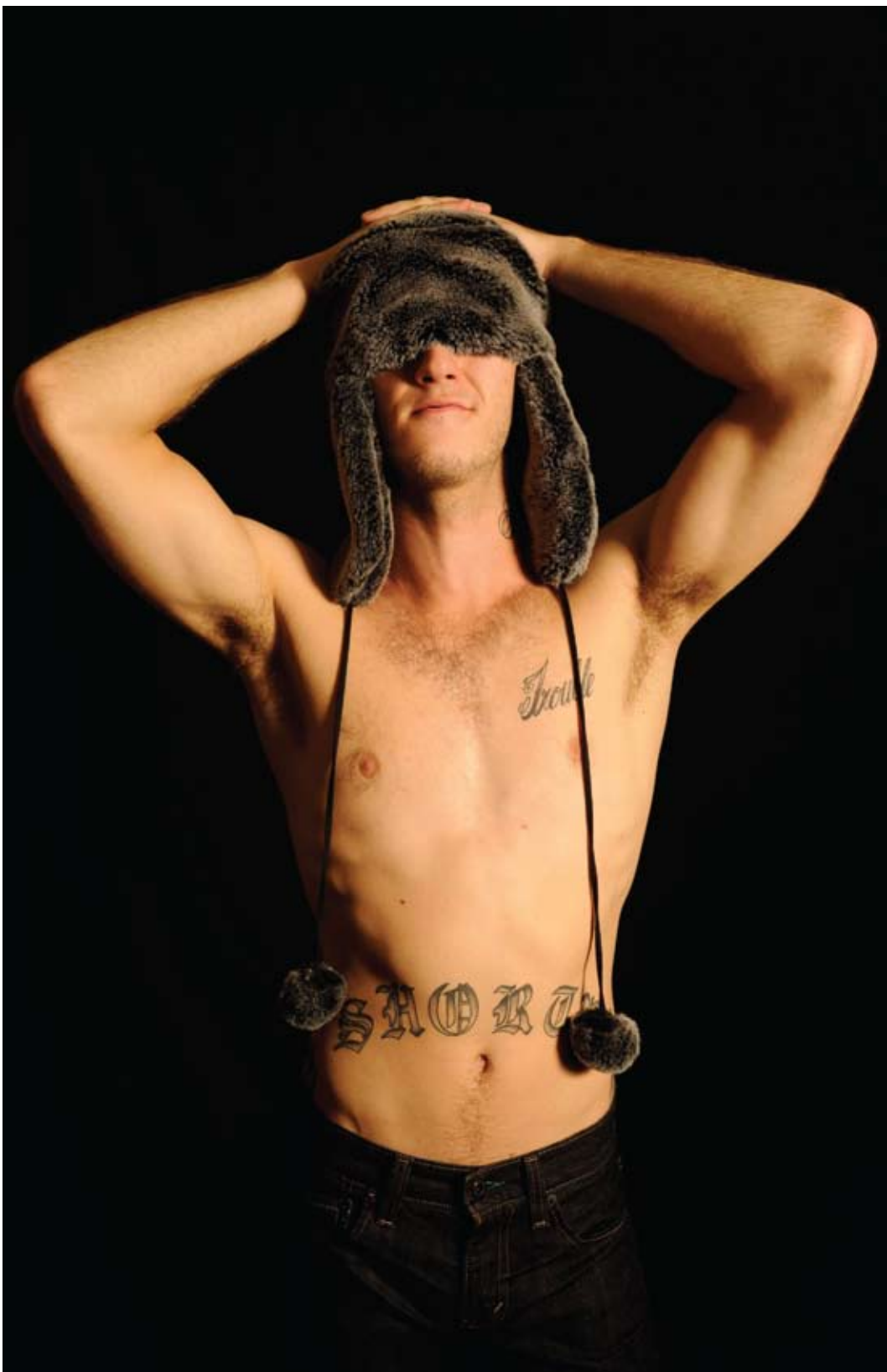
