




Howdy disco citizens! It's time for your weekly dose of Groovelines - your source for what's hot and hip in the land of electronic dance music and beyond.

Remember, life might not always be the party you had hoped for, but while you're here you might as well dance.







Not heavy on the chatter, Sissy Dude is more of a wham bam blog, where the author feels the content of his posts speaks for itself. And that content runs the full spectrum of imagery that includes porn, songs, artists, youTube outtakes, advertisements, classic film clips and even vintage post cards.

According to is i2i Art bio, "John has a quirky eye that, mixed with his penchant for pop culture and his years of painting

for pop culture and his years of painting and design, gives his (work) a unique...feel." And he brings that penchant and quirkiness to his blog, creating a phantasmagorical online world of color bordering on fantasy that truly echoes the gay experience and makes one wonder why we ever let the party end.

During one recent update, for example, we're treated to an assortment of images of the author posing in his tootoo-retro kitchen with expressions ranging from oblivious to comatose for no other apparent reason than that he had some room on his photo disc – this, after a posting of a Polaroid photo from the blog Popular Sizes that should definitely have left more of an impression on him.





John Webster began his online life in the guise of one Johnny Wacker with a site that the folks over at Think Pink Radio dubbed one of their "fave naughty blogs." Through several transmogrifications, we are now left with a big old sissy dude whose thoughts, feelings and ideas so easily translate into the visual art that he is noted for. As with his art, the vibrant colors, edgy sexuality and skewed humor in his blog is a true bright spot in a sometimes dull world.

One fateful 1996 night in Austin, a young man found himself surrounded by pulsing music, flashing strobe lights, and thousands of people under the spell of that night's DJ. That young man instantly fell in love. The event was Meltdown, and the kid was Roland Belmares. He instantly knew he had to figure out a way to channel all of the amazing energy he was experiencing, and that was the night Roland Belmares decided to become a DJ.

So began Belmares' humble origins as a DJ, spinning at pool parties and minor venues in and around Austin, TX. Building a name for himself as a DJ who takes his art seriously, whether there are twenty or two thousand people on the dance floor, it was Belmares' dedicated fine-tuning and attention to style that caught the ear of Ben Parsley, founder of Austin's former biggest circuit events, Perfect Day and Meltdown. The incredible impact Belmares made on audiences at both Meltdown and Perfect Day secured him a position on the discerning partygoer's "Hot List" of circuit DJs.


Since that time, Belmares has been called on to play several events throughout the US, from Los Angeles, San Francisco and New York to Houston and Miami; traveled north of the border to play in Vancouver, Montreal, and Toronto; and, broke into the international scene with dates in Rio de Janeiro for R:evolution, the Original Brazilian Pool Party, as well as the Elektra Disco Party in Sao Paulo and, most recently, a hugely-successful performance at gCircuit in Bangkok, Thailand.


Then, of course, there are major circuit events that Belmares returns to year after year — events such as White Party (Miami), Winter Party (Miami), White Party (Palm Springs), Alegria (New York), ROXY, (New York) Fireball (Chicago), Crobar (New York, Chicago, Miami), Babylon Tour (nationwide), Coliseum (Ft. Lauderdale), Gay Day's One Mighty Party (Orlando, Fl) — at which Belmares consistently delivers to his legion of fans a unique blend of high energy and tribal vocals.

With a growing fan base spanning coast to coast, it was only a matter of time before Belmares was called upon to mix CD's for the industry's leading dance labels, including Dance One, 4Play Records, Centaur (Global & Party Groove) and Harlequin Records.

As for what lies ahead for Belmares, it appears he's dedicated to dance music beyond simply maintaining his status as one of the scene's top rated DJs, and is putting his name in the ring as a remixer/producer. Roland's talent as a remixer includes work on projects for many of today's dance floor divas including Pepper Mashay, Pat Hodges, Kristine W, Abigail, Debby Holiday, Billie Myers and most recently, Amber.

DJ Roland Belmares continues his rise through the ranks of the world's foremost DJs with recent and upcoming events including this weekend's Fiesta Finale tomorrow night, April 25, at Heat in San Antonio. The economy is playing a big part in what I play on my dance floor today. People need a pick-meup. They're going to the dance floors to escape problems. So I'm playing upbeat, happy music. With Pride around the comer, I'm also looking for new tracks that celebrate freedom.

What do you say to those who don't consider DJing an art?

Anyone who doesn't consider DJing an art hasn't experienced a first class DJ. I'll never forget the first time experiencing Manny Lehman and thinking to myself "how did he do that?"

What do you say to those who say the dance floor is dead? Mine is anything but dead.

What special skills do you have behind the booth that today's other young DJs do not? I put a lot of preparation into my sets before my gigs: secret mashups and acapellas. My being almost 100 percent digital also gives me an edge. I combine my laptop with CDs, so I can do a lot of really cool stuff with my sets that people who are strictly digital or strictly CD may not be able

What are today's clubgoers looking for on the dance floor? How is it different from what they were looking for five years ago?

Five years ago it was all about one consistent tribal or house beat. Now you'll hear songs that are 130 BPM and songs that are 102 BPM. And if a DJ is good, he'll keep the dance floor going all night by playing all types of music and BPMs and not just one monotonous set.

It's been said that the last generation of superstar DJs had it easier. The big events – White Party, Black Party, Winter Party, Zoo Party - were created by event committees and all the DJs had to do was fly in and spin. Many of today's young DJs create and organize their own events. When did DJs become event organizers?

Some DJ's just want to play music, and that's fine. But today marketing and imagery is just as important to an event as the music so I make sure to have a hand in those areas as well. I don't want to rely on promoters or venue owners who may not be as in touch with my audience as I am.

Are your tours the reason that you became America's Hottest DJ?

My fours are definitely a big part of what makes me unique and attractive to venues. Without them, I think I'd still be successful, but they give me that something extra.



Is that why you're unveiling new briefs – to give your fans that something extra?

I was approached by a major underwear manufacturer to design my own line. I didn't immediately sign on the dotted line, though. It was my go-go boys that convinced me to jump into the underwear arena. They were my inspiration.

That makes sense. Go-go boys certainly know a thing or two about briefs.

They really do! They gave me really great advice on what worked and what didn't work and why. My briefs aren't only for go-go boys, though. The briefs will make everyone look and feel sexy.

What are the perks of being "Americas Hottest DJ"?

I get to work a lot, and financially I'm in a better place now.

Does being a DJ help your social life?

Not exactly, but it does make it easier for me to get someone to talk to me, at least initially.

What's next for DJ Seth Gold?

I'll be traveling the country on the Spring Break tour all spring and summer. I can't wait to see all my boys in Sacramento!




our favorite mixologist James, and their even website has been revamped, remodeled and reduxed to reflect all the chic chang-es. There's now live music each




