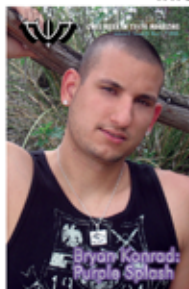

"After about three years of spinning in Austin, I was asked to spin at a new club in Ft. Worth, TX. The owners wanted to create a true dance club experience in Ft. Worth that would keep the young crowd rather than have them all driving to Station 4 in Dallas. The challenge of this gig was what attracted me the most and I saw it as an opportunity to build a

it as an opportunity to build a following in other parts of Texas. It didn't take long and our goal of keeping the young dance crowd was a reality."

"While spinning at a club in Ft. Worth is not a huge accomplishment, I am proud of the success we had and it also proved to be a good stepping stone for my career. Word spread quickly throughout the state about the fun new club, and it earned me a trip to Houston to spin at a Spoiled Boyz event."

Soon after, Bryan played his first major event - the quintessential circuit party itself "SPLASH", hosted in Austin over Memorial Day Weekend. Since then, his music has helped him travel the state of Texas and Bryan has DJ'd in every major city in some of the most popular venues for some of their biggest events: South Beach and Meteor in Houston, Alameda Theater in San Antonio, Texas (T-Dance benefiting AIDS Services of San Antonio) and, of course the ever popular Purple Party in Dallas, Texas.

Bryan Konrad's love for music doesn't stop at the DJ booth. In addition to spinning he is continuing work on his next step in furthering his career - learning how to produce his own music. He is always looking to meet and network with other DJs, and collaborated on some tracks with LTD (Licious The Diva) and Remixer/Producer Scotty K in 2007. He hopes to take all that he has learned from these great DJs and produce his own sound. So keep your ears open, you never know when you might be dancing to one of his tracks.

Bryan really loves meeting and talking to his fans, so don't be shy if you go see him spin. One of the things that he has always loved about the DJ profession is that DJs pride themselves on being sociable and easy to approach.

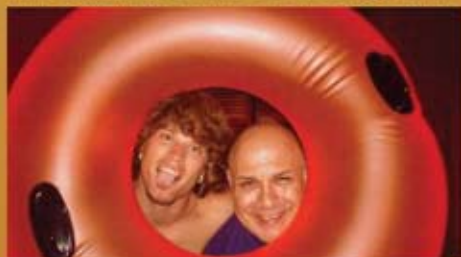
We received so many IM's and e-mails over last week's revelation

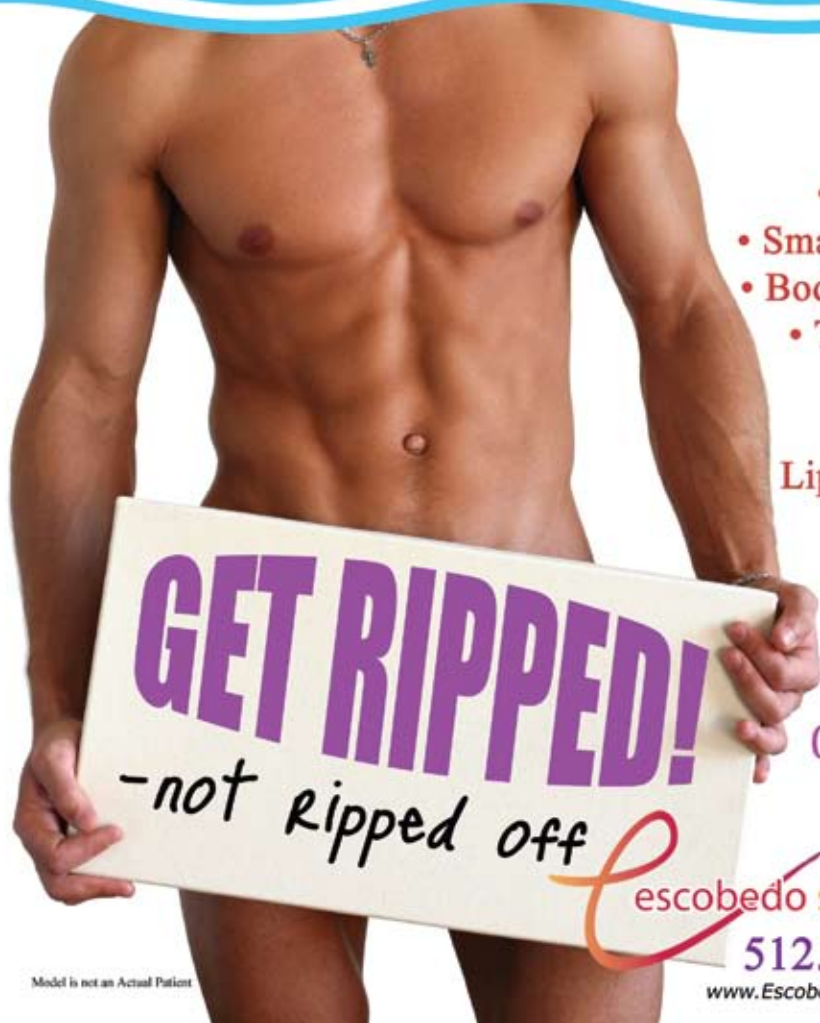

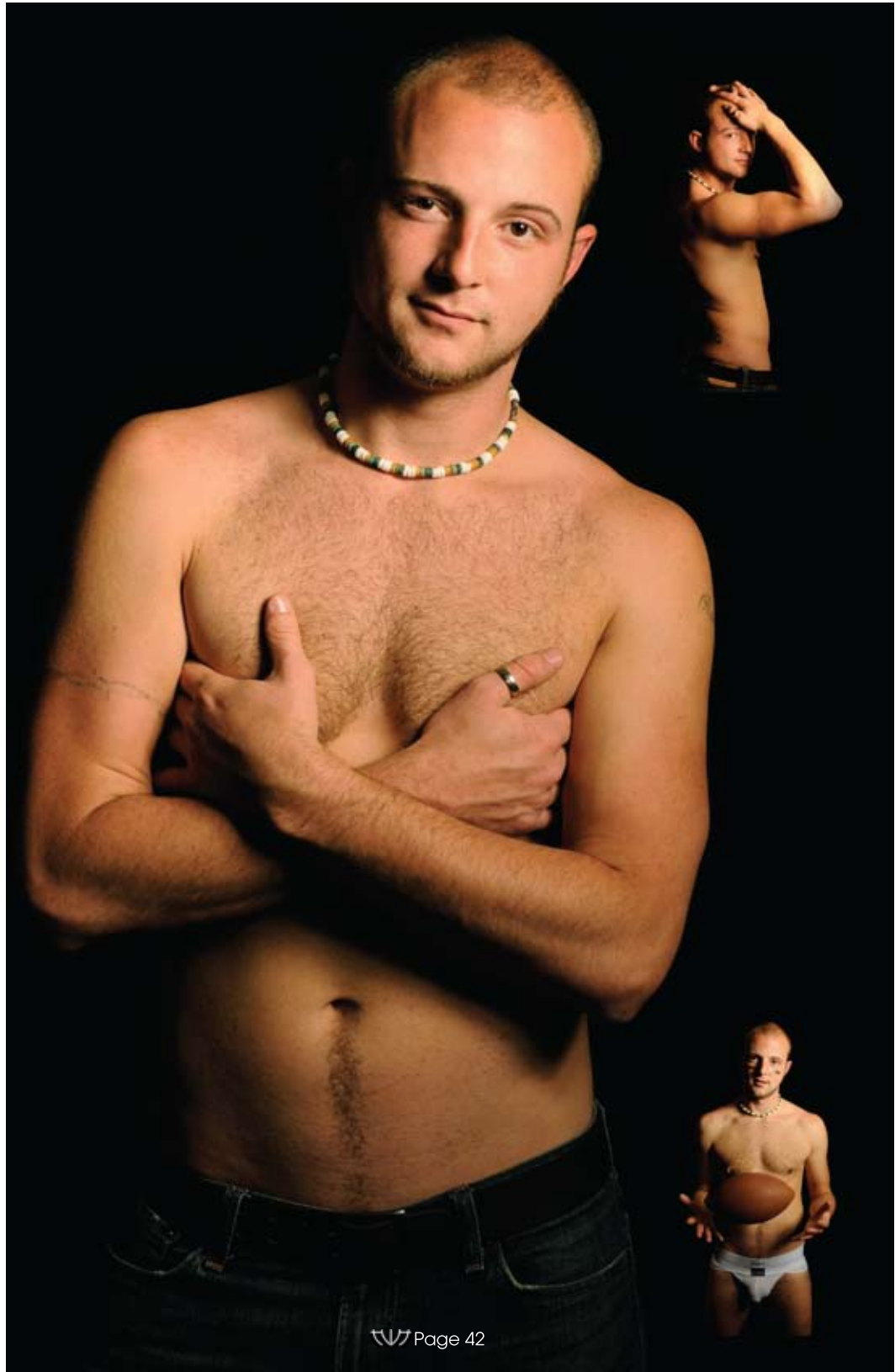
