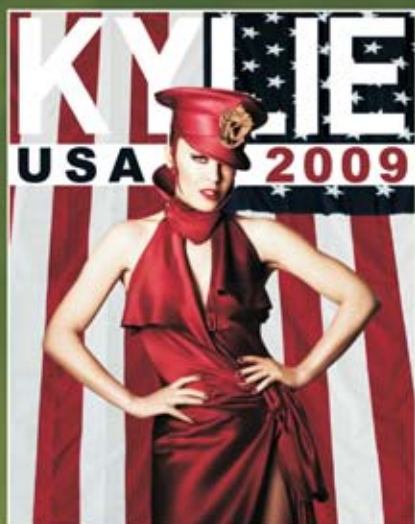

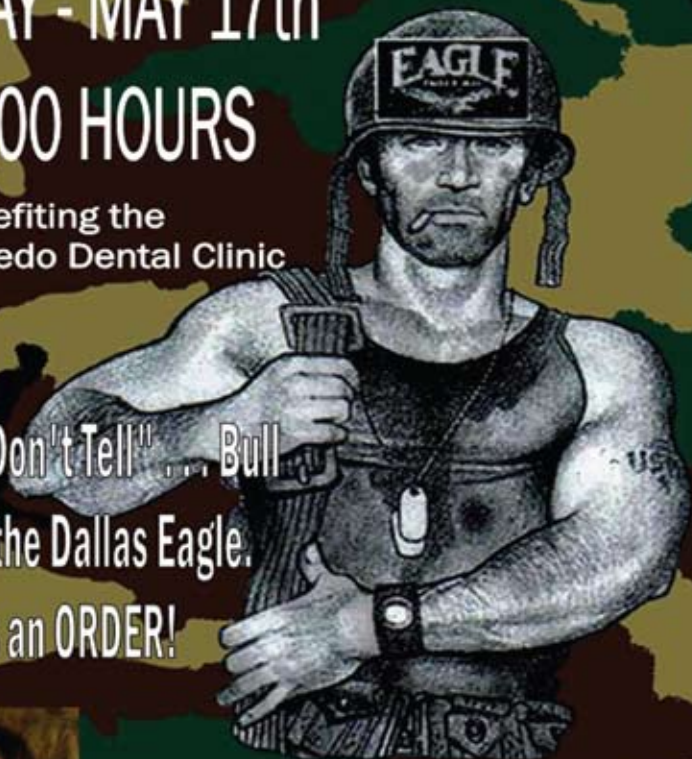

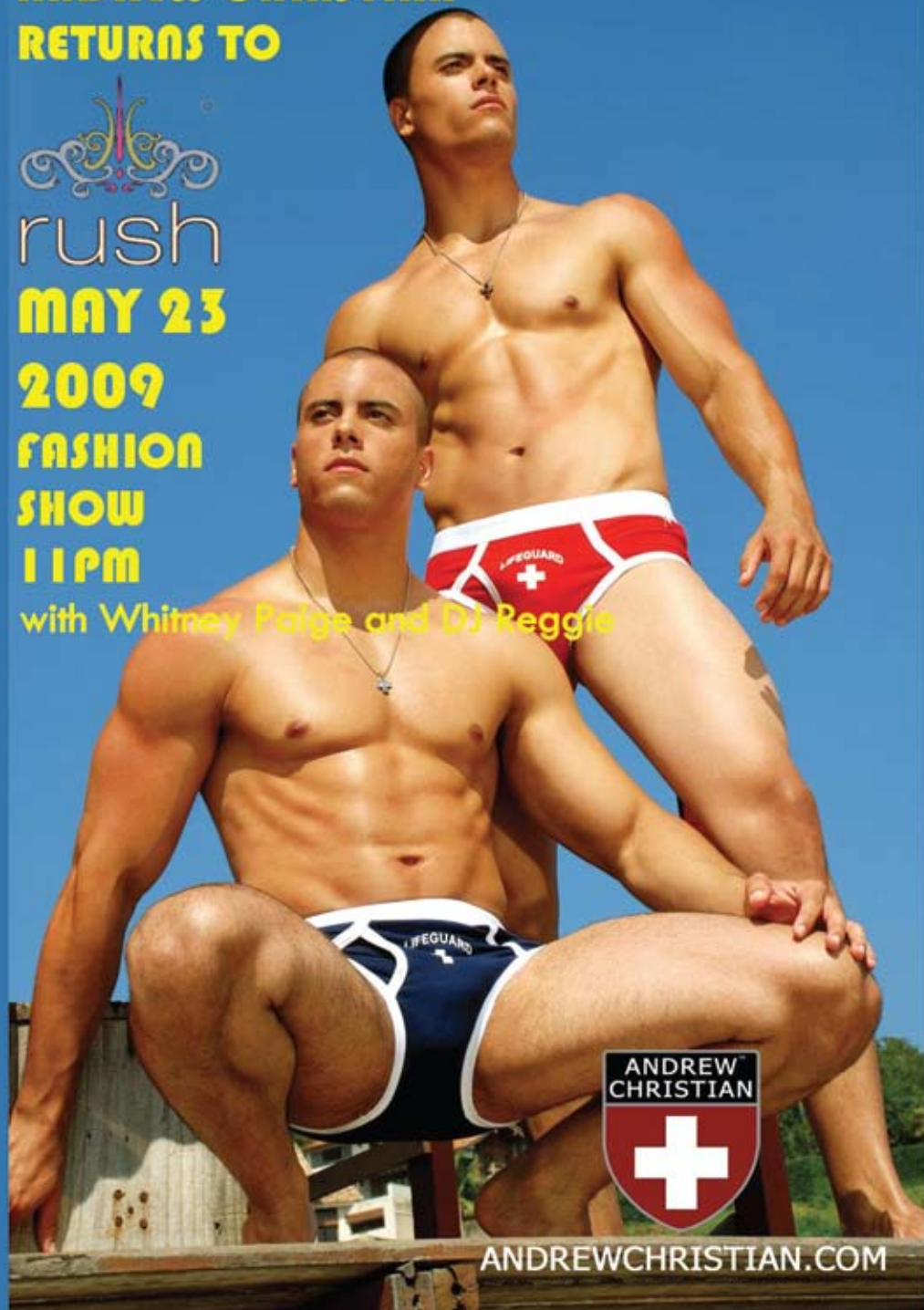

# Face, Face, Face

Bebe Zahara Benet speaks...

Bebe Zahara Benet. The next word that may want to come out of your mouth after saying a name like that is probably "CAM-EROON" - and why wouldn't it be after RuPaul branded this year's winner of RuPaul's Drag Race with this bold moniker? As TWT sat down with Bebe, we asked her about her take on this nick name, in addition to her thoughts about life, drag and memories of her homeland. So buckle up and start your engines, while TWT takes you into the mind of Bebe Zahara Benet.

We started out the interview with some of your basic questions like: "How old were you when you put that first dress on?" "What is your boy name?" "How old were you when you left Cameroon?" "What was your first drag gig?" You know, the usual...

Her responses were well thought out and as elegant as the accent she speaks in. "My boy name is Marshall Kudi and I was 10 years old when I put on my first dress. It was just playing around with my siblings back then. I actually had my first full drag experience while I was doing modeling for an African-French designer in France and they were short some female models. I was chosen to fill in. That would be my first time in full drag. I, after a while, moved to Minnesota when I was 20 years old, where I had some family. I then did not start drag right away. It wasn't till I went to a pride event with a friend at a club in Minnesota called the 90's and was drawn into it from there."

Entranced by her silver tongue we snapped out for a minute before we could inquire about her dealings with the Grand Diva herself, RuPaul, how she got on RuPaul's Drag Race, how she chose her name, and the rumors of a 500 question psychological evaluation given to the contestants at the beginning of production, but the precursor question to all this was "Describe RuPaul in three words."

The ebony enchantress began weaving a spell on us as she answered our first question with three precise and resounding words, "professional, grounded, and dedicated." Then there was silence. She then started elegantly responding to our other questions. "There is no special story about how I chose my name. I wanted it to reflect who I was. It has a little of America, Africa, and France all wrapped up in it - Bebe Zahara Benet...it just had all the qualities I wanted in my name. Working with Ru was a great experience; I did not even want to do the show when



they were accepting auditions for casting. I did not want it to be something that turned us into laughing stocks. I had gone with a friend to the club where it all began, the 90's, and RuPaul and ChiChi LaRue were there promoting the show and tracked me down and asked me to submit a package, and through that I was chosen to be on the show, not through the online voting. I try to stay in touch with RuPaul, but most of the time I miss her call or vice versa." Emphatically, she further stated that "YES, there was a test administered, but I did not mind because some people are truly crazy."

With a giggle and a chuckle we shot the breeze over a lot of day to day stuff about her busy schedule, her car, the demand for bookings and so on. So, we took it to a lighter note, and asked her a series of light-hearted questions, like what her favorite Absolut vodka flavor is, what we would be eating if we were in her village back in Cameroon, what the official language is in Cameroon, how she felt about the masses shouting to her "Camerooon" and, if she was pitted up against RuPaul to lip synch for her life, who would sashay away and who would shante and stay.

She explained with a smile on her face, "It used to bug me a little when I thought I was being referred to as my country, Cameroon, but it really was more Camerooon, and I understand more now that it is about the connection that people feel to me rather than some kind of mocking nickname - it has become very enjoyable. Now, if we were back in Cameroon, first off the only nameable language you would be able to relate to is the mix of French and English, there are over 450 tribes and dialects and only a few are known to just one person. At supper you would not even be able to understand what I have ordered for us but it would be basically grilled fish and fried plantains, the sweet ones, not the green ones. I would be ready to lip synch for my life up against RuPaul. You know when you have a caged animal, and the brave hunter comes for it? That is when it is the most dangerous, and the lioness in me would have no choice but to go for the kill, so of course I would shante and stay - and she would sashay away. Then I would turn to the nearest bartender where I would enjoy Absolut raspberry vodka with a hint of lime on the rocks"

This interview with Bebe Zahara Benet was truly an honor and so much was conveyed through our conversation that we simply don't have enough pages in this book to completely describe just how warm and down-to-earth this wonderful person, and drag super star - as so deemed by RuPaul herself - really is.



Bebe is currently touring all over the States, both through her own booking efforts, as well as being the star of Absolut Vodka's Real Fruite tour - a tour that will invade Texas with all its fruity debauchedness beginning next Thursday. First stop is Woody's in Dallas on May 21st, then the tour tips on down to Austin and the famed 4th Street venue Oilcan Harry's on May 22nd before sliding over to Houston to set the 800 block of Pacific Street afire at the one and only South Beach.

Bebe is also working on a relief foundation for both here in the States and in Cameroon that will help in fight against HIV/AIDS, so stay on the lookout for the Zahara Foundation to be doing good things in the near future.
