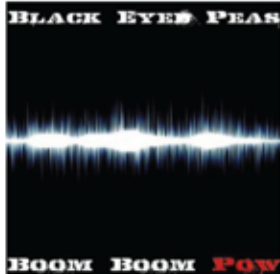

Further exploration leads to a gaggle of galleries that runs way into the quintuple digits; a slew of site reviews in the triple digits that provide insight and opinion about virtually every gay porn site in existence; over 9,000 featured flicks that, though not full-length, provide more than enough footage to get the job done; a forum with literally millions of posts about topics ranging from celebrity news and gossip and an amateur showcase to current events and Daddies, Bears and Chasers (oh, my!); the JUB Blog, as penned by JD and Seth, that features exclusive interviews with gay-



lebrities of every ilk, as well as videos, commentary and gossip about everything gay; Live Cams, so you can pretend that you're having an intimate date with that day's chosen hawtie; an online edition of their print magazine that has pages to turn and everything; and, Men4SexNow, which provides free access to members in over 500 cities worldwide so you can do it, do it hard, do it fast and do it now.

In fact, the next gathering takes place in San Antonio over Memorial Day weekend (September 23-25,) so if you see a bunch of hot and horny men by the Drury Plaza Hotel on the Riverwalk you'll know exactly who they are.

MR. TEXAS LEATHER



The tapestry that is the GLBT community is comprised of many and myriad smaller communities, including a frolic of female impersonators and a legion of leathermen and women – all of whom, as a collection, enrich and enhance the community as a whole. Leather is, and always has been, a prominent feature of our collective experience, and many of the most vocal and significant members of our community have embraced the leather lifestyle.

One such individual is this year's Mr. Texas Leather, Jeffrey Payne. Handsome and hirsute, brilliant and brazen and polished and professional, Jeffrey is a shining example of what's good and true in Texas' gay community. Jeffrey took some time to visit with us as he prepares to represent the Lone Star state at the International Leather competition in Chicago this weekend. We think you'll enjoy learning more about him as much as we did!



What titles do you hold and when did you win them?

Last December I was chosen as Mr. Dallas Eagle and then in February, I was chosen Mr. Texas Leather.

Did it surprise you to win both of these contests?

Surprise, yes. But more importantly, I was honored. Anyone on stage, on either one of those evenings, could have won. And I can't take full credit for the wins. Yes, I was the one on stage; however, what most people don't realize is the support I had going into these contests. I have great mentors in the community that have taken every step of this journey with me.

What have you done since winning the title of Mr. Texas?

In the few months since that time, I've judged a leather contest up in Tulsa. Great community up there, by the way. I emceed a contest, which I enjoyed immensely. As in the past, I've participated in many charity and fundraiser events, which I've always held near and dear to my heart.

Let's backtrack a bit. How did you first get involved with leather?

Sex.

Sex?

Leather's hot! Believe me; I don't have to give a dissertation in order to answer that question. Of course, leather means more to me now, but you asked what got me involved with leather initially and the answer is sex.

So leather means more to you now. What do you hope to accomplish during your title year?

Heightened Awareness. Awareness of our rich leather history. Awareness of the charities and fundraisers that our community supports with an indescribable passion. Also, awareness of the events and programs that are sponsored by our community. And when I say "heightened awareness", I mean to those persons within our leather community, and also to those persons outside of our leather community.

That is very interesting. How do you propose to reach out and recruit those persons outside of leather community?

I'm not recruiting; I want to get that straight. When I say I want to heighten the awareness of those persons outside of the leather community, I am speaking more to the fact that, for example, I have friends and acquaintances that are not part of the leather community but they respect me enough that they participate alongside people within the leather community in ways they have not done so before. They do this by participating in charity events and fundraisers, or supporting other functions. It is broadening their horizons and opening their eyes to the fact that the leather community is a very giving, upstanding group of people. It's a way of bringing two worlds together for what I hope is greater understanding and greater cooperation.

You are headed to Chicago over Memorial Weekend to vie for the International Mister Leather title. Tell me about that.

Yes. IML is celebrating 31 years this year, and men from all over the globe descend upon Chicago to compete for the title. It's attended by men and women from all walks of life with different levels of involvement within the community. It is an international title, and quite frankly, with it comes great responsibility. The goal or purpose of IML, in my mind, is to represent the international leather community in a positive and clear manner. You are that liaison between the different sub-cultures that exist within the leather community and also between the leather community as a whole and the non-leather community.

How does someone prepare for that role?

Life prepares you for it. Most importantly, IML has to be a leatherman. They, also, have to be an effective communicator. And when I say that, I mean they have to be someone that is able to listen, process the information and then speak. It has to be someone that has the ability and the life experiences in associating with a diverse group of people and knows how to parlay that into this role. They also need to be excellent at time management, because this person is definitely pulled in a million directions. Someone that can articulate a vision. Someone that will stay true to themselves and their word and also be reliable and seen as an asset to the community. And it is important that they be able to create a balance between their home life and their title responsibilities. And a sense of humor is always good, too.



Is that you?

Most definitely. I wouldn't be running if I didn't believe I had these qualities to bring to the table.

You brought up balancing home life and title responsibilities. How is your home life?

Awesome. My husband, David, is my biggest fan and supporter. He is behind this journey 150%. You know, before I ran for Mr. Dallas Eagle, we had many long discussions about it, knowing it would lead to Mr. Texas Leather and subsequently, IML. David and I knew that it would take both of us supporting the journey in order to make it successful and for both of us to come out of the title years stronger than when we went into it. We spoke with many former titleholders and their partners and gathered as much information as we could possibly gather in order to make an informed decision. It was a joint decision for us, as any major life decisions would be.

Tell us a few things about yourself.

I absolutely love my life. Don't get me wrong, there are moments that I wish wouldn't happen, but those moments never outshine the positive things in my life. My husband, my puppies, my career, my family, my friends and my involvement in the community – all great things.

You mentioned your career. You're a Human Resources Manager. How is work handling your title?

They are fine with it. Many of my employees came to previous contests, and some are even flying to Chicago to support me at IML. I report directly to the Vice President of our company and she is very supportive of my journey. They have all stepped up to the plate and supported the charities that I work with and I've never encountered any issue, nor do I ever expect to encounter one.

Do you have the support of the leather community and would you say they like you?

Well, I don't worry much about whether or not people like me. Sally Fields, I'm not. I worry more about do they respect me. But I am keenly aware that I have to earn the respect of the community in every endeavor that I take, so I work very hard to earn that respect. I don't take anything for granted. Being a titleholder does not give me automatic respect, or for that matter, automatic support. I still have to earn it. I may get the benefit of the doubt in the beginning because of the title; however, it is my responsibility to earn each and every person's respect and support. And it's something you have to continually work at. Just like with anything else in life. But to answer your question, yes, the community supports me and I'm sure they like me, too.

One last question. What's something you can share with us that very few people know about?

(Laughing) Oh, God. Let's see. I have a huge weakness for Oreo cookies and a large glass of whole milk. I eat a few of them every night before going to bed.

Do you dunk the cookies in the milk?

Is there any other way to eat them?

With over 200+ remixes to his credit, his discography runs the gamut of international music superstardom and he's crafted remixes for everyone from the Prodigy to Madonna and recently The Killers and Beyonce (all #1 Billboard Dance Records.) Be on the lookout for his latest touch on the works of AC/DC and the DOORS.

The natural progression of any spiritual journey takes you to a higher plane, DJ/ Producer/Remixer and Writer Mark Picchiotti pilots that plane.

Both went to #1 on the US and UK Dance Charts. A force to be reckoned with, Mark has contributed many classic hits to the club world over the last 19 years.

And if all of that's not enough to impress the most jaded circuit party denizen, Mark

single-handedly brought the Gospel House genre to a new level and redefined it with his vanguard act, The Absolute. BBC Radio 1's Pete Tong, a big Picchiotti supporter, repeatedly chose the first two Absolute singles as his coveted "Essential Tune". Not surprisingly, those singles went on to reach #1 on virtually every industry chart!

Mark's productions and remixes have been supported by most every big name DJ in the business. Carl Cox, Deep Dish, Danny Tenaglia, Seb Fontaine, Roger Sanchez and many others are Picchiotti fans.

Until cloning is perfected Mark is selective about devoting time to his many loves, though DJing is, and always will be, his first. It is the engine that drives his multi-faceted, ever-expanding career.



Now, Texans can get an earful of Picchiotti's passion during the Real Fruit tour. After a stop at Woody's in Dallas last night, Mark mixes the melodies at Oilcan Harry's in Austin tonight before closing out the tour at South Beach in Houston tomorrow night, Saturday May 23.
