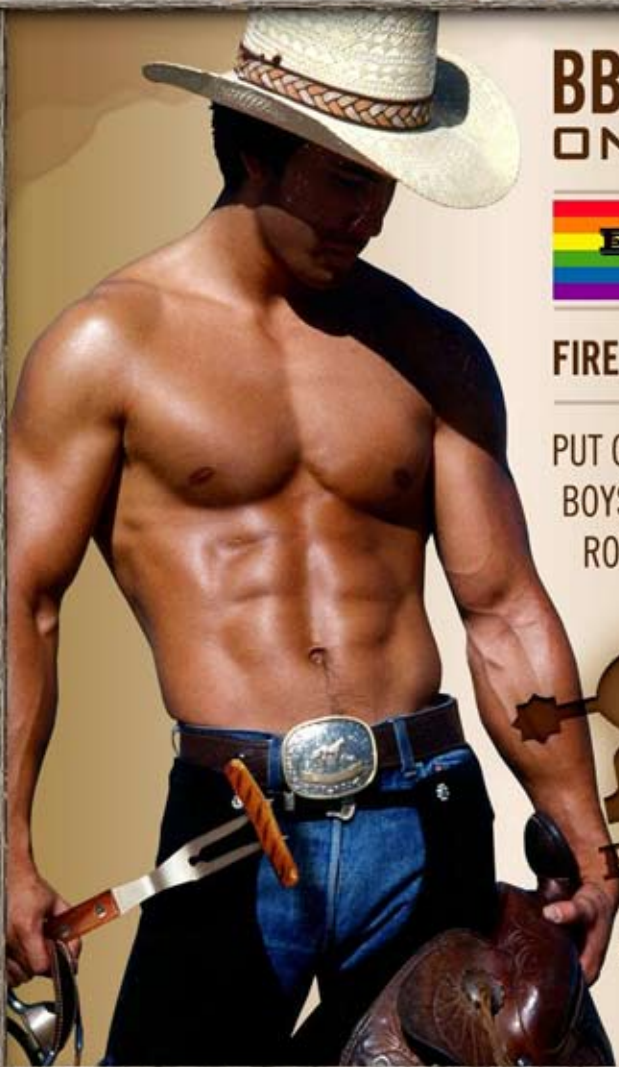

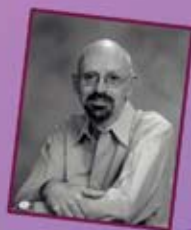

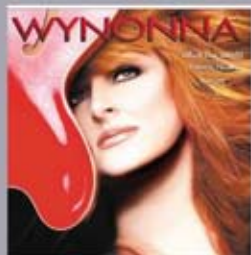
## GROOVELINES

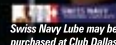

# BASKIT! SCORE!

Baskit, the original hip and comfortable men's underwear company, is back this summer with a cheeky new look.

Before Eric Schwerts bought the company earlier last year, he spent seven years working between the USA and the UK on classified government assignments focused on the international drug trade, human slave trafficking, and airport security. Today, in his new role as Head Baskit Maker, Schwerts' mission is to secure the family jewels.

He has already made a few changes: upgraded the brief's construction, improved the waistbands, re-styled the pouch and introduced higher qualities of cotton.

Schwerts has been working 24 hour days to keep up with the demand, but we caught up with him to discuss his '09 swim collection.

**How did you go from secret agent to Baskit weaver?**

*I guess I just knew it was time to do something different. My previous career, while very interesting, was also still just a job and after five countries in 13 years I was ready to settle down a bit.*

**Who is the Baskit man?**

*That's a question I get all the time and to be honest, there is no good answer for it. I will hear about it no matter what I say. If I say it's the fashion conscious gay guys, I'll have a never ending in-box of notes from straight guys telling me to stop assuming only gay men are fashionable. If I say straight guys or athletic guys - our Action Cool line is popular with athletic types - I'll get an equally unmanageable number of notes from gay guys telling me not to forget where I came from.*

**You can't win, can you?**

*I can't, so I am just going to say that a hot, smart, self-assured, wildly successful man buys Baskit. At the end of the day, I want Baskit to offer underwear that is appealing. I want something in our line that will*

cause a guy to dig through his underwear drawer to find because he knows he'll not only look good but also be comfortable wearing it. No pinching, no wedge, no embarrassment.

#### **Does Baskit show off the basket?**

Well, this is men's underwear and swimwear, not the lady's control-top girdle section. The point is to accentuate the positive, not pack it away. We work with the design team to bring that into the style and fit of the garment but we strive to make sure it's also comfortable. We want our guys to put on our brand and not only like what they see but also like how it feels.

#### **Baskit used to have little pockets for condoms. What happened to those?**

Our first collections in 2001 had the condom pocket. We kept including that in one style each season for our loyal customers until two years ago, when another brand with a huge marketing budget, but not a lot of their own creativity, copied the concept. They say that imitation is the best form of flattery but we were afraid our new customers would think we were the imitator so we dropped it. We keep getting a lot of requests for it to come back so you might see it again before too long.

#### **How has Baskit grown in the last eight years?**

Baskit was one of the first brands to bring real color into the men's market. We've built on that with every season adding new colors, patterns and styles to the brand while focusing on maintaining our quality. Like a good bottle of wine, I like to think we're getting better with age.

#### **How does today's basket compare with the original?**

Last year we introduced our 'SnugFit' seamless collection to the market. We can't claim to be the first to do so, as European men have been wearing seamless for years now, but we are definitely one of the first to offer it in the US. That collection did really well, and we've increased the colors and styles for Fall '09. This year really focused on the environmental aspects of making underwear, so we started using organic cottons and earth friendly dyes in our Pure Lines.

#### **Is Baskit a gimmick-y brand?**

We've built this business and a loyal following using high quality fabrics and elastics and we consistently couple that with fashion forward designs in everything we do. We're pretty much "what you see is what you get." I think the fact that you don't see us jumping on the typical underwear bandwagons is proof of that. We're not out there touting the trends in the market. "Here...buy this bamboo underwear. It's 98% cotton 1% Lycra and 1% bamboo so we can legally call it 'bamboo' without being sued for bamboozling you."

#### **What sets Baskit apart from your competitors?**

Our quality, hands down. I will put our gear up against any other brand out there.

#### **What are some of the highlights of the new collection?**

This is our second season of swimwear. We're back with our bikini and box-cut bikinis. These are offered in our Retro and Radical stripe designs and we've continued the Lucky Number series with our 9's. We've also added a stylized board short that we call a 'short board.' These are probably my favorite this year. They're perfect for both beach and street.

#### **What was the inspiration behind the summer collection?**

This year's collection is all about lines and blocks of color. The Retro Stripe pattern was something I saw on a beach in Sri Lanka a few years ago and it always stuck in my head. The Radical Stripes with their increasingly wide color blocks from top to bottom...well, during the design sessions for the swim collection I was writing down words that reminded me of summer and I wrote the words, "Bomb Pop." I am not even sure they make them anymore but Bomb Pops were popicles the ice cream man used to sell out of his truck when I was a kid. They were red, white and blue. So I just used some colors I liked for this summer's collection and went for the same effect.



#### **Why did you choose MTV Real World's Scott Herman to be the face and body of Baskit?**

Have you seen Scott Herman? It wasn't a hard choice really.

#### **How did you get him for the campaign?**

We met Scott before the Real World aired and, while we knew he was going to be a

participant, we had no idea or expectation of what that might bring later on. We decided to bring him into the campaign because he's just so easy to work with and really enjoys what he does.

#### **Where did you shoot the campaign?**

On New York's Fire Island Pines. It was a cold and rainy weekend and we spent more time waiting for the sun than we did shooting. Scott was a trooper. He stood out in the cold and he made sure everyone was having a good time. Trust me, that mentality is not the norm when you deal with models.

#### **How did you choose the material for the suits?**

All the swim brief and box cuts are made from a nylon blend. I like working with this particular blend for swim because it's heavy so it looks really bold and it wears well. It doesn't pill or lose its color or shape when you wash it. The Short-Boards are made from 100% polyester. I wanted a fabric that was light (but allow for some styling) and would dry quickly so you could go into the water and then throw on a shirt and some shoes and walk into a bar or restaurant without having to change.

#### **What's the biggest mistake men make in their choice of swimwear?**

Buying the same style year after year without thinking about it. It's ok to try something different. Something with more color, more style or more revealing.

#### **What is your most popular suit?**

The Lucky 9 bikinis seem to be the hottest in terms of sales.

#### **That begs the question, who should not wear a bikini?**

Oh that's simple. You should absolutely not be wearing a bikini on a beach if you're not going to be comfortable in your own skin doing so. I know you were hoping for another answer but we support guys wearing whatever they're going to be most comfortable in. We can only hope that they have a good friend or two around to keep their fashion decisions in check!

#### **Why have most men resisted the bikini square cut?**

We've just been socialized to believe that only a certain type of man wears a bikini and we don't want to be "that guy." So most American guys want more coverage. The really funny thing is that if you look back at what men were wearing on the beach in the 1950's you will see a lot of Square Cuts.

#### **Are bikini square cuts more popular in Europe?**

Europeans have always been more fearless and expressive when it comes to fashion and especially beachwear. Bikini cuts have always been the norm so the 'bikini stigma' that we have in the US isn't that pervasive there. I hate to say it but I think it's going to take a reality TV show to get American men on the fast track to bikini cuts. "Bikini Survivor" the reality show where 10 average US men are forced to spend 8 weeks on European beaches wearing a bikini.

#### **I would watch that!**

The show would be cancelled after the first week when the producers and the viewing public realized there is NO DRAMA associated with wearing a bikini on the beach. There is however a lot of comedy!

#### **What are you working on now?**

We're focused on Fall '10 right now. I can't tell you a whole lot. Some secrets are a good thing, but we're working on a bit of underwear, some swim and some active wear.

#### **Are you trying out any new fibers?**

We're always looking at new fibers and blends for use in everything we make. There are a lot of great blends out there that could be used to create swimwear but I find that a lot of them fail on some of the basic swim principles: durability,

pilling, color loss, workability and of course, price. There is a fabric that I really want to use to make our Box Cuts out of but it would make the finished product cost about \$70 a suit. That's not us.

#### **What's the best thing about being head Baskit-weaver?**

You mean aside from looking at half-naked men on a frequent basis? I think the thing I like the most is when people ask, "So what do you do?" When I tell people I make men's underwear I get a mix of reactions but it always livens things up a bit.

#### **Worst?**

The worst part of the job is looking at half-naked med on a frequent basis. You just don't get completely naked men in this business.

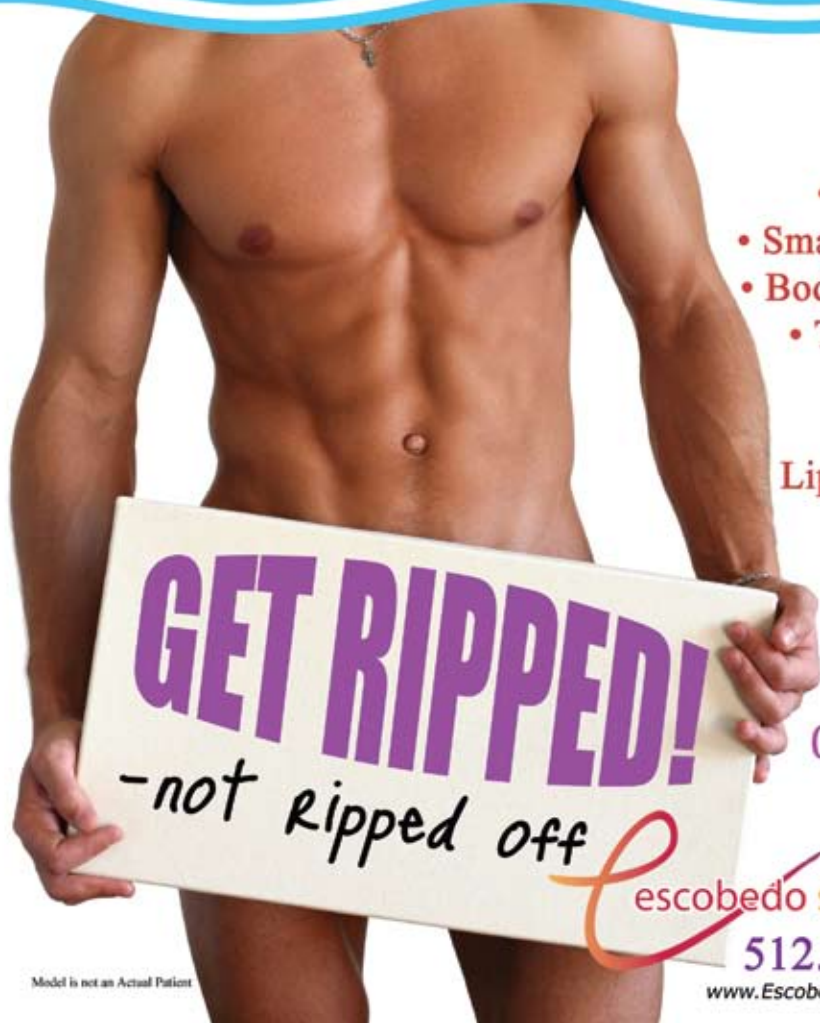

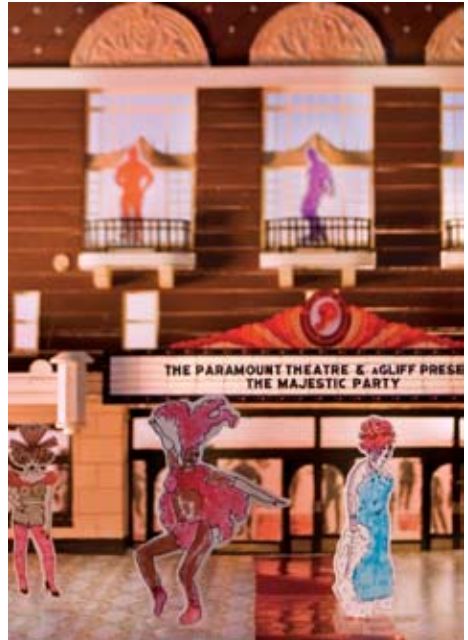
