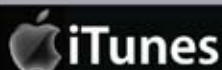

Following that tradition there is a stunningly simple and eloquent Candlelight

All the versions of "Las de la Intuicion" are available in English or Spanish, as radio edits or full-length mixes, and priced at \$3.99 per EP or \$ .99 per song.

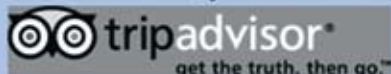

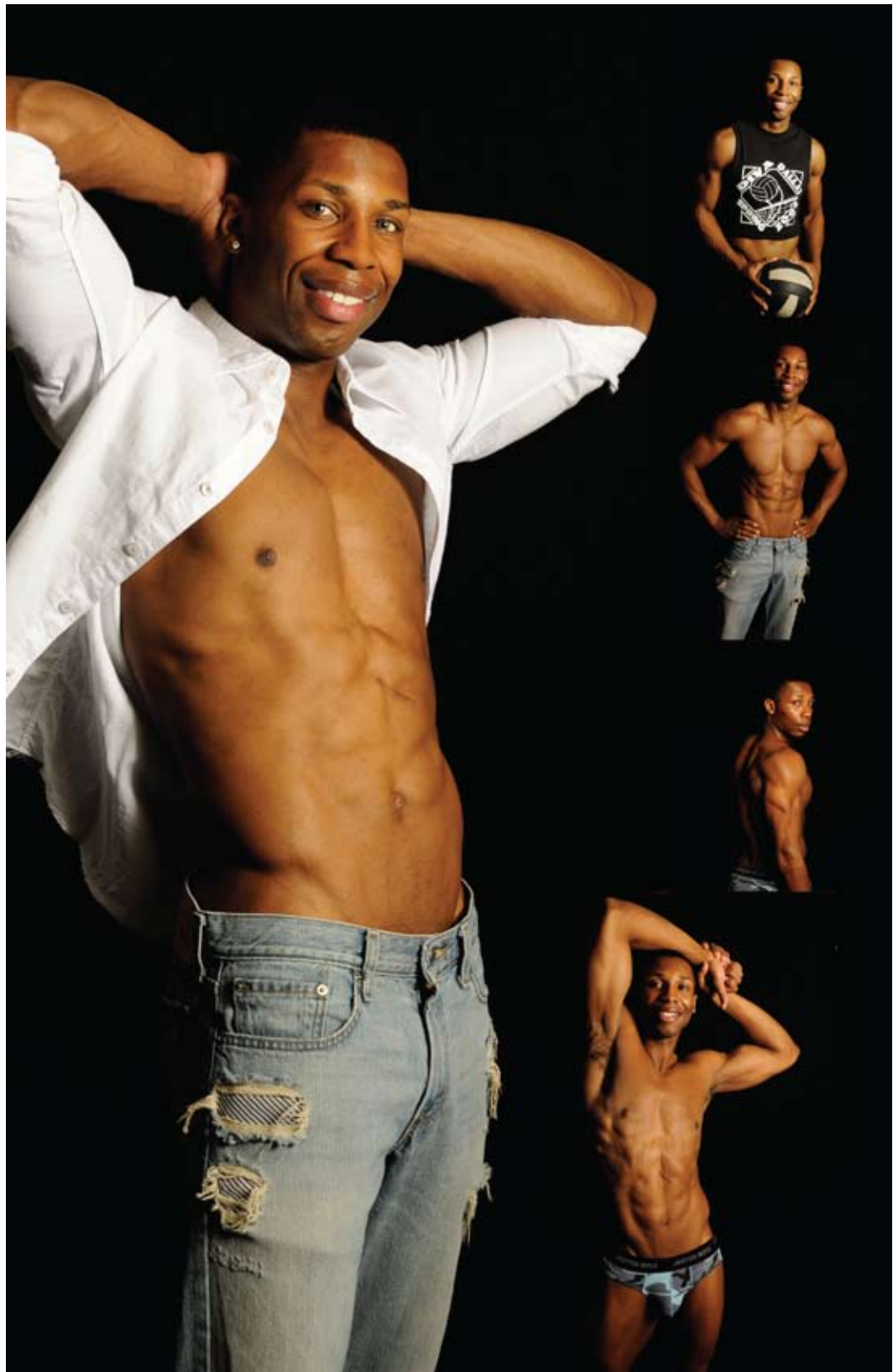
