The legendary BT returns with his new single *Rose Of Jericho*. The original version of this long awaited newbie from BT is off the hook, as are the remixes from Robbie Rivera, Adam K & Soha, and Sultan & Ned Shepard. The new Deadmau5 single Slip get a bad ass makeover from Sebastian Leger. Deadmau5 will be playing at The



House Of Blues in Dallas on November 6th and in Houston on November 8th. Tickets are on sale now. I caught Deadmau5 in Austin during SXSW at Sky Lounge a few years back. Great show. Pitbull's smash hit I Know You Want Me (Calle Ocho) has been remixed by Alex Guadino and Jason Rooney. This one was posted quite recently and will only cost ya a buck. Also diggin Tokyo Pollution from Tommie Sunshine. Nice low bpm acidy groove track. Tokyo Pollution is from the 2007 full length Tommie Sunshine release Ultra.Rock. Remixed. A great compilation of remixes of alternative

tracks from bands like Fall Out Boy, The Gossip, Peaches, The Faint, Good Charlotte, VHS vs Beta, Hellogoodbye, Panic At The Disco, and more – 24 tracks in all. A totally killer release! One of my favorite releases over the last couple of weeks on iTunes is the killer new house track from Yves Larock & Steve Edwards – Listen To The Voice Inside. Larock returns to our dance floors once again with yet another inspirational and uplifting single quite reminiscent of his previous hit Rise Up. He's like the Bob Marley of house music. All that and more at iTunes.

Another really inspiring track that has been reworked for the dance floor is the new single from Kristine W – Be Alright. Top notch work on this one from The Perry Twins, Tom Stephan, Hex Hector, Joe Corrano, and more. You can pick that one up over at Masterbeat.com, where you can also buy Kristine W's fabulous new full length album, The Power Of Music. Check

out my recent interview with our diva at the TWT website. Other releases I quite fancy at Masterbeat include I Gotta Feeling by the Black Eyed Peas – the David Guetta remix, Petron Tequila by the Paradisco Girls – the Dave Aude Mix, If You Seek Amy by Brintney Spears – the Crookerz mix, and the full length album from LMFAO – Party Time. Jason Dottley: *Happily for approaching six years, one legally.*

Del Shores: *Marriage is about loving someone so much you want to be with them and nobody else.*

Did you get a lot of great gifts?

JD: *Of course.*

I would've sent a little something, but I didn't know where you were registered. So, what's it like to wake up with a gorgeous man every morning? I mean, I'd be happy waking up next to Jason's adorable little Bill Sherman shirt and a stray sock or two...but, to either one of you, be still my rapidly-beating heart! And how is your little family addition, Ty Guapo Dottley?

JD: *We love each other, that's why we can work and live together nearly 24/7. And Mr. Ty Guapo is fabulous. Even the paparazzi shoot him. He has a bit of an ego. I like it.*

Now, the inevitable question: What the hell happened with Sordid Lives: The Series? We absolutely adored it, partially because my great aunt Lucinda would be a stunt double for Sissy Hickey if she'd put her teeth in and stopped ratting her hair. Oh, and because I always hope there'll be a gratuitous underwear shot of Jason...

DS: ONCE UPON A TIME FILMS owes me and the cast 100's of thousands of dollars. They own the show. Hard to try and resolve something when you're owed money. LOGO wasn't supportive, didn't try to save the show, so now we are trying to figure other ways to get it back. It's sad. And wrong!

JD: It's a long story and I've decided not to talk about it anymore in the press. The story is out there enough. And worry not, I'll send you gratuitous underwear shots, no need for a second season for those :)

So lately - in addition to filming Sissies - you've been touring a new play with your marvy mate dubbed "Hit Show." I see what gets the crowds going at my New York parties and on the dance floors at the mega-clubs I’ve been playing around the world lately and I wanted to harness that energy in an album.”



Generation Next is a relentless 14-track compilation that pulls listeners in from the first beat to the last.

"*Generation Next* embodies everything great about Junior Vasquez," says Silver Label's Victor Lee, the producer who encouraged Junior back into the studio. "We're always looking for the new sounds and cutting-edge producers. With *Generation Next*, you get both—delivered by one of the best DJs in the business."

Featuring two new Vasquez studio stormers (the groovy progressive jam "I Love Music" and the brash, gospel-infused vocals of songstress Maxi J. on the big-room blaster "Insecurities"), *Generation Next* adds a bold exclamation point to the litany of legendary tracks the DJ has produced over the course of his decades in the business.
