# From Unemployment to... fun - employment!

When The Pointer's Sister sang about wanting a man with a slow hand, were they referring to you? If you've been told you give great rub, your touch may be worth charging for. Turning your talents into currency isn't that difficult, but to make it a sustainable business requires a bit more consideration. Here's the 411 on making it as a masseur.

**Know Why You Are Doing It.** Your reasons don't have to be noble. It could be that you're unemployed, want a change in careers, or just some more spending money. Not everyone is trying to subsidize a PhD with the profits, but whatever the reasons, know what they are because these reasons will get you up in the morning, keep you motivated, get you to grow your business. It's self-defeating if at the end of the day, you wonder why oh why you are doing something you ultimately don't want to do.

**Know What You Are Going to Do.** What kind of bodywork will you provide? Does what you want to offer require certification or a license? You need to decide what kind of services you will offer: erotic massage? Reiki healing? Your own mixed bag of therapeutic massage techniques? You may need more initial investment if you decide more training is necessary before you begin your practice. Likewise, you must decide where or how you'll practice. For yourself? At a spa? Make decisions so you have a plan.

**Sell It.** Since now you know what you're selling, go and sell it. Advertising is key, and gay media or classified websites like [Manworks.com](http://Manworks.com) that specialize in body workers can be the lifeline of your business, exposing you to thousands of people from the Internet. Getting the most of what you can from [Manworks.com](http://Manworks.com) and other media require doing your part too. After a year as a skilled "amateur," perhaps getting certified in a certain technique is the next step for growing your business. Maybe you've finished funding school and now you have decided to save up for a grand holiday. Or perhaps you have been taking on too many clients and you want to spend more time with your friends. Checking in on where you are at and where you are going to is a good practice for happiness. After all, massage shouldn't be a pain.

**Why did you decide to launch a career in bodywork?**  
*I try to have a healthy lifestyle and I have always been interested by the benefits of massage as a way to release the tensions and to feel good with my body. I decided to share this interest with others by launching a career as a massage therapist.*

**Are there any techniques that you specialize in?**  
*I specialize in Swedish and Deep Tissue massage. However, I am also trained in Esalen and Shiatsu.*

**Does it bother you when people equate masseurs with escorts?**  
*People who equate masseurs with escorts are people who do not know much about massage or well being.*

**What's the difference between an escort and a masseur who gives erotic massages?**

*In many cultures, especially in Southeast Asia, sensuality is part of a massage. Nudity and body contact are felt differently than in Western cultures. A masseur's primary goal is to provide a massage. That should answer the question.*

**Do you work in the nude?**

*A massage is a two way process. The masseur is giving energy to someone who is receiving the energy. In that process being in an equal state, both without the cloth barrier, is an important thing.*

**What advice would you give to men who are considering a career as an erotic masseur?**

*Anybody interested in a career as a massage therapist should be truthful and honest about his interest in massage.*

**Are there any misconceptions about the business that you'd like to clear up now?**

*As in any business, if you are good about what you do and if you care about your customers then you'll be successful.*

**Is the money as good as everyone thinks it is?**

*The money is good but people should realize that giving a massage is physically demanding. It requires a healthy lifestyle and a genuine interest in others since you are giving a lot of energy.*

**Make your pitch to potential clients: What do you offer clients that no other masseur can offer?**

*I am genuine. I give energy because that's what I enjoy. That's the only important thing that potential customers should consider.*



## Vincent ([www.manworks.com/VinCostesMassage](http://www.manworks.com/VinCostesMassage))

**Why did you decide to launch a career in bodywork?**

*I got my very first massage four years ago in a spa. That was the best experience ever and I still go there every week and always use the same masseur. I learned a lot from his technique and decided to become a masseur myself.*

**What techniques do you specialize in?**

*Deep Tissue.*

**Does it bother you when people equate masseurs with escorts?**

*Not really. The reality is that many masseurs are or were escorts, and many of them don't really know what they are doing when giving a massage.*

**What's the difference between an escort and a masseur who gives erotic massages?**

*The client can tell the difference right away. He will feel it within ten seconds, for sure.*

**Do you work in the nude?**

*I work in the nude or not, my clients decide.*

**What advice would you give to men who are considering a career as an erotic masseur?**

*Get certified first. You must know what you are doing. Then if you are good, the mouth to mouth will bring many good clients. The clientele for massage is totally different from the clientele from escorting. If you are a real good masseur, you can get VIPs, and you will make much more money than if doing escorting. You will also meet amazing people. I did and still do.*

**Are there any misconceptions about the business that you'd like to clear up now?**

*We (escorts and masseurs) have a heart, are sensitive, and deserve respect just like everybody else. Sometimes we get nasty emails or phone calls, and that's not cool.*

**Is the money as good as everyone thinks it is?**

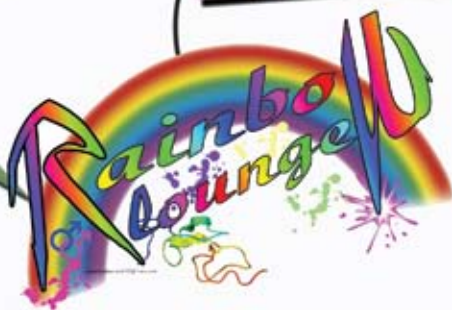

**The cover is bo-licious!**

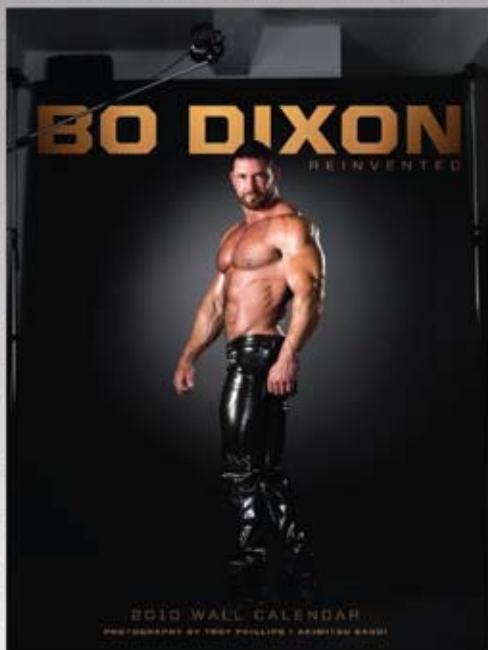

# Homage to the Circuit A Farewell to The Brick

Since 1992, The Brick has been home to many good times in Dallas. On August 2, it will bid its patrons farewell with a final Reunion Dance before it closes its doors forever at its current location. The strip along Maple Avenue is undergoing urban development and it is one of the latest casualties. The Brick's owner and manager are shopping for a new location - and vow to move the club - but anticipate it being closed for at least two months.



During its 17-year run, The Brick was indisputably the home bar to the circuit crowd. It was the only bar of its caliber in Dallas, on par with the best of them in NY and LA - edgy and different. In the early days of circuit, it collaborated and cross-marketed with the Black, White and Red parties. It brought in name entertainment, was part of the Texas tour for porn stars back in the day - and dancers for Cher and Madonna partied there when those tours brought them to Big D. Over the years, everyone who was anyone partied there during after hours, and Saturdays saw 1,000 people through the doors before the night was over. During its heyday, shuttle buses ran between the Cedar Springs Strip and The Brick.

Alas, the circuit scene is much maligned as a snobby culture of drugs, sex and twenty-somethings with perfect bodies. Leave your preconceptions at the door. Yes, undoubtedly there are those components and, like the gay community, there are many facets. Attendees are as diverse as the gay community, and all-encompassing these days. Sex, drugs and steroid gym bunnies are not the staples anymore. In fact, you'll find men in their 20s, 30's, 40's and 50's pretty equally represented - as well as some women in the mix.



The roots to the circuit events can be traced back to the days of tea dances, when guys would congregate to be around other gay guys in a safe sanctuary of camaraderie with the common thread being the love of music and dance. As AIDS decimated circles of friends, those remaining found some comfort in celebrating life, even a spiritual connection, through dance and music. Drugs and alcohol helped with pain and added pleasure.

Over time, the drugs got harder and the music became much darker, reflecting the change with "pots and pans" sounds. Meth-amphetamines took their toll on the community and ruined lives; circuit events peaked and declined with some correlation. When the economy started to take a turn for the worse in last 18 months and grow bleak, the music, surprisingly, did the opposite. Today, happy music with positive vocals dominates the scene, as people seek an escape and look for inspiration and hope, reflecting a new start for dance events.

Unlike today's new gay generation watching reruns of "Will and Grace" and having gay/straight alliances in high school, many



people in the circuit crowd grew up with Anita Bryant's homophobic condemnations and the only gay person they saw on TV was Billy Crystal's Jodie Dallas character on "Soap". Seeing two men kiss on "Dynasty" was as shocking as it was groundbreaking. Today, many of the younger generation have options other than living in a gay ghetto. They can socialize openly in mixed bars without fear of being persecuted or beaten. Overall, things are much, much better nowadays. But as the recent incident at The Rainbow Lounge reminds us, things are far from perfect.

For many years before the more progressive times we now enjoy, the circuit provided a safe haven to be oneself and be around one's own kind. Today's gays may not need a circuit environment, but as renowned Dallas DJ Paul Kraft notes, once they experience it for the love of music and dance, they are often hooked. It isn't about hooking up, it's about experiencing the musical journey the DJ creates for them to enjoy from beginning to end.

Until The Brick reemerges, diehard circuit patrons need not fret. Dallas is going to host an awesome lineup during Pride on September 19-20. Billboard multi #1 hit dance diva Erika Jayne will perform live with DJ Escape at Excuses (Club One). Circuit legend Lydia Prim will spin after-hours at LIFT Lounge. Ending the weekend festivities will be a tea dance with DJ David Knapp at Myst Lounge.

DJ Paul Kraft also spins twice a month at Club Dallas with positive music, uplifting beats and inspiring vocal messages. Clearing out the main room, filling it with sound and lighting equipment and fog machines, one would hardly recognize the facility the night he spins. Of course, guys have more options of what they wear or don't wear, but most bring swim suits, trunks or shorts and save the towels for later, if at all. Get there early as there is a waiting line to get in by 6 am.



The Purple Foundation hosts Dallas' annual circuit party every spring called, aptly, The Purple Party. Like the circuit scene, The Purple Party was headed for a downturn when four years ago new leadership revived it. Unlike some parties, the Purple Party continues to grow. Today under the auspice of Blake Baker and the entire board, it has been revived and is acknowledged as a class act and circuit event destination. In fact, JustCircuit.com named it the "Circuit Party of the Year" and "Best Non-Profit" in 2008. It's easy to see the benefits of such an event when they bring in visitors to Dallas who patronize the bars, restaurants and other establishments during their stay - which is a boon for the whole community. For you future planners, the next Purple Party will be held April 30-May 2, 2010 as it celebrates its 10th anniversary. Stay tuned, as they are finalizing their DJ lineup which, they promise, will be a good mix of new and

old.

Over the years, clubs have come and gone but only a few comprise Dallas' circuit scene today - namely The Brick, Excuses (AKA Club One), Club Dallas, Purgatory and LIFT Lounge - but none has had the history, tradition and stamina of The Brick and is still here to talk about it. The circuit scene may have declined in recent years, but it has undoubtedly provided many more years of joy to its patrons.

Whether for a nostalgic evening or a first time circuit experience, you can enjoy The Brick one last time as it hosts "Reunion" on August 2nd from 5pm to midnight and features DJ Blaine Soileau, DJ Paul Kraft and DJ Mark Brack. The 10 spot cover at the door benefits AIDS Services of Dallas, which provides housing services for those impacted by HIV/AIDS. Remember, come for the love of music and dance, leave your pre-conceptions at the door, and enjoy the ride DJ Paul Kraft and friends are going to take you on. As the song says "Take your problems to the dance floor, dance them out and they'll be no more." C'mon, get happy!

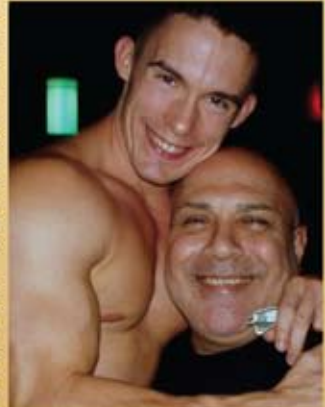
potent potable pourer wasn't enough, the folks at OCH also decided to introduce us to a new owner, as well
