Over at iTunes, and hot for digital download, is the latest from the bitch we all love to hate—Madonna! Her new track is called *Celebration*. I am really loving this song. *Celebration* was co-

produced by

Madonna and Paul Oakenfold. There is also a Benny Benassi mix out there that totally kicks ass. *Celebration* is one of 2 new bonus tracks on her upcoming 2 disc greatest hits compilation, *Celebration*, due out September 29th. The other new song is called *Revolver* and features guest vocals from L'il Wayne. This will be Madonna's final and 21st album with Warner Brothers. 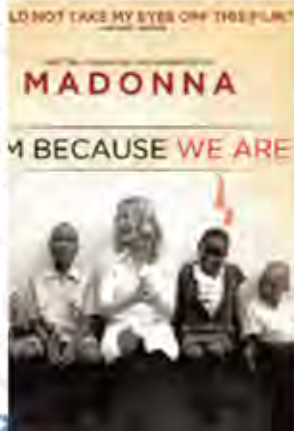
Madonna and Nathan Rissman's documentary, *I Am Because We Are*, will also get a DVD release by September 22. In other Madonna news, 2 new books will be released as part of the *English Roses* series this fall. According to Madonna.com, "first is book #11, *American Dreams*, to be released on October 15th. The book is already available for pre-order from Amazon. The 12th and last book of the series, *Catch The Bouquet*, will be in stores on December 24th." Audio books will be up on iTunes shortly after, most likely. You may or may not know that Madonna, a multi-Grammy award

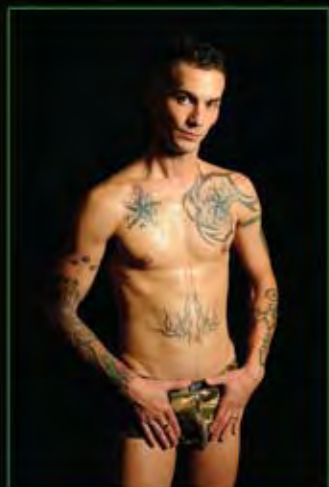
