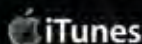


GROOVELINES

Blake Lewis
The Chris Allen Interview



Anyone who tuned into season six of *American Idol* knew to expect the unexpected of Blake Lewis. The Washington native, who admitted he hadn't watched a single episode before auditioning in Seattle, arrived in Hollywood without a hint of a plan, other than to be himself. Yet through talent, instinct, creativity and unapologetic brashness, Blake managed to make it all the way to the finale as the first runner-up to Jordin Sparks, each week showcasing a different side to his endlessly eclectic musical identity.

His live show incorporates technology with organics. Loop pedals, a laptop, and turntables take center stage with live musicians. He's not just the life of the party, Blake Lewis is the party. And what a voice. His style is all his own. Killer range. He has the sassiness of Simon Le Bon with the maturity and control of Frank Sinatra. Performance wise? The late Michael Jackson has nothing on this guy. Blake makes it up as he goes. There is nothing left to chance. He is sharp yet well rehearsed. He reads the crowd like a dj. Oh yeah, Blake does that too. Beyond the beat boxing, there is a clever clever man capable of many awesome things. Things that will make your day. For real.

Blake's amazing new album, *Heartbreak On Vinyl*, comes out on Tuesday, October 6th in America. It is an album of well written, well produced, sophisticated electronic pop. Great hooks. Festive beats. Blake worked with several different producers on this album like Dave Aude, BaptisteKouame, & Rodney "Darkchild" Jerkins. *Heartbreak's* first single, *Sad Song*, was released in August and it's music video a few weeks later in September. All the tracks on *Heartbreak On Vinyl* kick total ass but some stand out more than others. From the first moment I heard *Rapture Of Love* I knew there was something different about this track. That first note. It says a lot. But what follows for the next nearly 5 minutes is truly astounding. *Rapture* is not quite a ballad, but more of a sensual slow sexy grind. Questioning, yet still affirming. Curious with wisdom. And when those synths kick in, damn. You'll know when you hear it. It's magical. Overall, the song is perfect.



it takes you on a journey both lyrically and musically. A top-notch piece of work. What makes this song different from the rest of Heartbreak On Vinyl's songs is that this masterpiece was both written and produced by Blake Lewis. It is in my opinion, the best song on the entire album. It moved me. I felt it.

Blake Lewis took time out of his super busy schedule of press interviews and rehearsals for a quick chat. Here's how it went down.

CA: How would you describe your style musically to someone who has never heard it before?

BL: Man, that's the toughest question ever. (laughs) In my music it's, ya know I guess I would say synth pop because I write pop music and there's synths in it. It's tough because my whole life everyone has tried to put me in a box and label me as something. My scapegoat is just saying pop music. Can't quite describe it. With this record it's definitely ya know indie pop, dance. But it's tough. I don't think there's a bad context for music. If it's a good song and has a great melody it gonna still be a great song and melody whether it's metal, country, hip hop, folk, or dance.

CA: When it comes to your singing, what vocalists have influenced you the most?

BL: Michael Jackson, definitely. Big influence on me, wanting to be a performer and a singer. I would have to say, the Police – Sting. Bono. Prince. Definitely Simon, Simon Le Bon of Duran Duran. Dave Gahan of Depeche Mode. Ella Fitzgerald. Harry Connick Jr. I mean the list is endless. I constantly am listening to music. I'm constantly inspired. But growing up in the early days, in the 80s, I would definitely say those were my top.

CA: So thus far, excluding your Idol experiences, what has been your most memorable live gig? That one that was like a dream come true.

BL: Oh wow. I've had many of those actually. Before Idol and after. Before Idol I did this show where turntablist Qbert and I kinda battled in front of like 4,000 people. And that was amazing cause, I mean as a beat boxer and a fan of hip hop and turntablism, he's ya know a god. It was really cool doing something with him. I think it was the confidence boost I needed, to play a show with someone of his notoriety. He's so inspiring. He's an amazing dj. He was one of the grandmaster champions. I was kinda in the underground scene here in Seattle and doing all these raves. I got to open for BT, Crystal Method, Paul Van Dyk, DJ Dan, Sasha & Digweed. Dance music is my favorite music. Growing up I was just obsessed with electronic music and I still am. Getting to play with all these people. It was a fun time for me being that close. Those were always big moments. I'd say I have big moments on stage all the time. Prior to American Idol and after.

CA: What kind of gadgets do you incorporate into your live show to trigger loops and stuff?

BL: I have tons actually. I am reformatting my show right now and going digital. Just got a new pedal in the mail yesterday. I'm going MIDI into my computer so I can control my control my computer from my feet. Basically, it's gonna be the same kinda thing, just digital now so I don't have to keep breaking all these pedals that I have. I use a Kaos Pad by Korg. I use that to sample the audience. I just wanna make it as interactive as I can. (pauses, smiling) Yeah, I love toys. I wish I had more.

CA: Are you Mac or PC?

BL: Definitely Mac.

CA: What is your software of choice when it comes to producing?

BL: I really love Logic, for their synths and their sound design in that program. And Ableton. For what I do that's the best.

CA: What instruments do you play?

BL: The main ones ya know. Piano. Guitar. Drums. Sometimes the kazoo. Cause it's fun.

CA: A lot of the pics from your live shows show turntables and a laptop center stage. Do you dj, like beat mix and stuff, and if so do you use software like Serato or Final Scratch?

BL: I've djud since 99. I was always been pretty good at it. I have a really great music collection. Right now I use Serato or regular vinyl. Mix the 2. Or cds. It depends. I like playing electro. I'm kinda changing it up right now actually. I'm in this stage right now where I'm kinda getting back into trance and some progressive stuff. And there's always love for the breakbeat. Switching it up now depending on what area I am playing in whether it's LA or New York. There's different vibes for different cities.



CA: Speaking of trance, how did you get involved with the collaboration you released with Darude?

BL: I met Darudemmm 5 years ago, 6 years ago at this club Element where I was working. He's the nicest dude ever. I met him 3 or 4 times, ya know beatboxing and stuff. At the club I wasn't doing much singing, unless I had my loop pedals that night. I was just like the hype guy. I was the Flavor Flav of Seattle. Hyping up people at raves. So I met him then and my friend put us together after a show. We connected. I wrote Selfless with him. We produced half of it at my house. And then he went back to Finland and finished the track there. It was for Dance For Life, a nonprofit organization.

CA: What does Dance For Life benefit?

BL: They benefit finding a cure for AIDS.

CA: You did some work on BT's upcoming new album right?

BL: Yeah, we did this really great song. It's very, well all my music has this 80's nostalgic feeling to it and this one definitely does too. I can't wait to hear it. I haven't heard it yet. (laughing) I keep yelling at him, send me that track.

CA: The title track, Heartbreak On Vinyl. What was the inspiration for that? It is a very reminiscent sounding song.

BL: Well, thank you. It's about the record stores closing down. Just a sentimental song. Kind of has a very nostalgic feeling. I walked through Union Square and I used to always stop there when I am in New York. I love New York. All my friends live around there. I usually go to the Virgin store. I walked in there this time and it was going out of business. We were sad cause it was kinda like a destination for me every time I'm in New York. Being in Seattle we have tons of indie records stores. I was just walking around and started thinking about ideas for a song and that was that ya know. Kind of a melancholy feeling about being an audiophile and stuff. I just has this amazing visual, like the music video was already done when I started writing the song ya know.



CA: What's your favorite track on the album?

BL: That's tough. They're all my favorite tracks. Binary Love is one of my favorite beats and melodies that I came up with for the record. Heartbreak on Vinyl is ya know, sentimental to me. I'm really proud of that song. I think it's one of my favorite pop songs I've ever written. There's a song called Our Rapture Of Love, which I'm really proud of. I produced it and wrote it.

CA: In closing and on a more serious note, the day DJ AM died of a drug overdose your Twitter post read, "DJ AM...SO sad...LOTS of depressed people out there! DRUGS INTENSIFY the pain ;(so sad and so unnecessary ;(" What is your feeling regarding drugs in the electronic dance scene?

BL: Man that's so tough because it's such an individual thing. I was born luckily with not an addictive bone in my body. But I've dealt with so much addiction in my life. Friends. Growing up with that in the family and what not. It's tough. It's really sad when someone gets addicted to something. That they feel that they need something, mentally. I think inner demons have to do with that. My friend was addicted to heroin, doing speedballs, OxyContin. There's a lot of drugs that go around in the dance world. Some people can handle it and some people don't know when to stop..

CA: Well thanks so much for your time Blake. Great talking to ya. Have a killer day.

BL: You do the same. Peace.

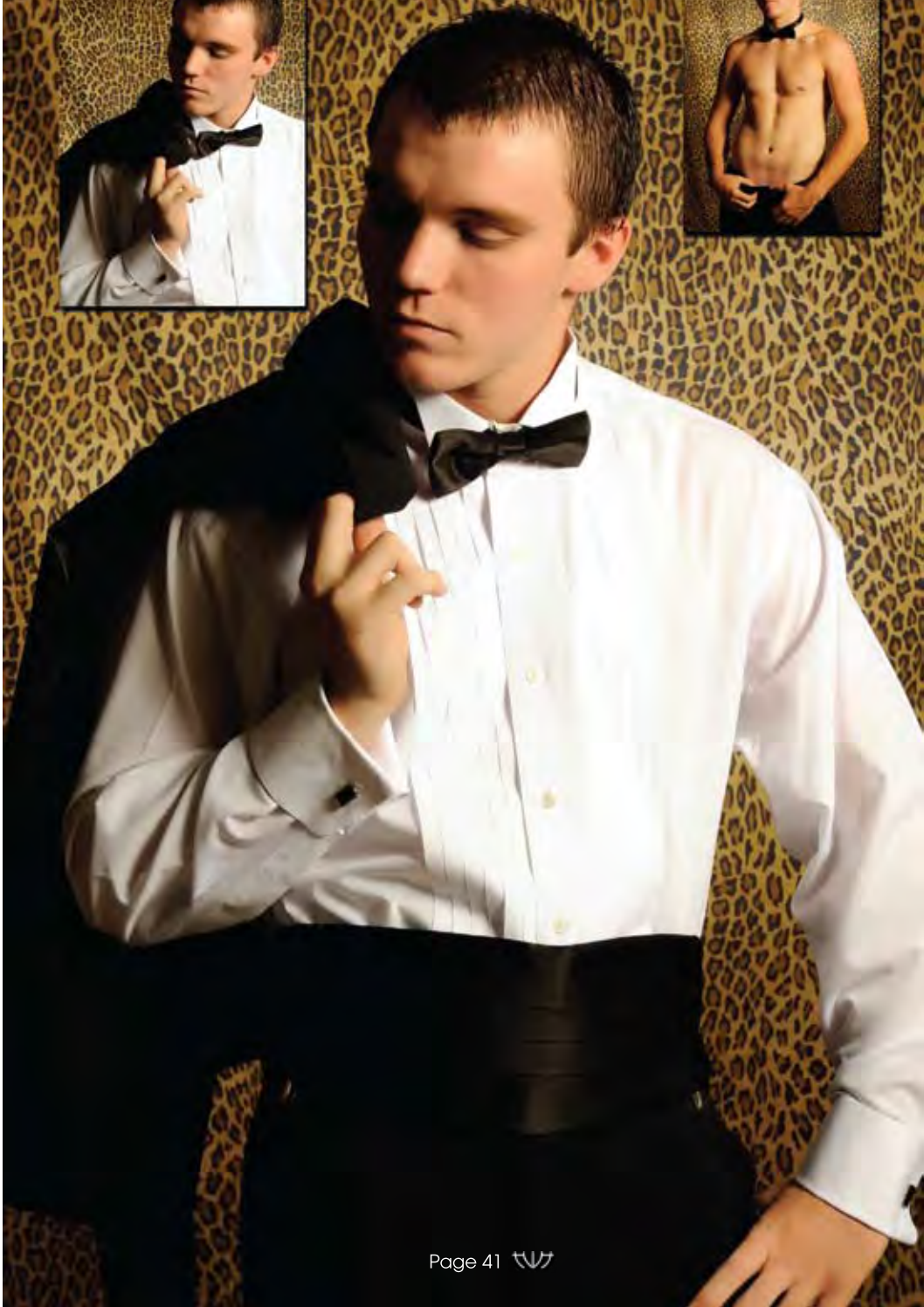


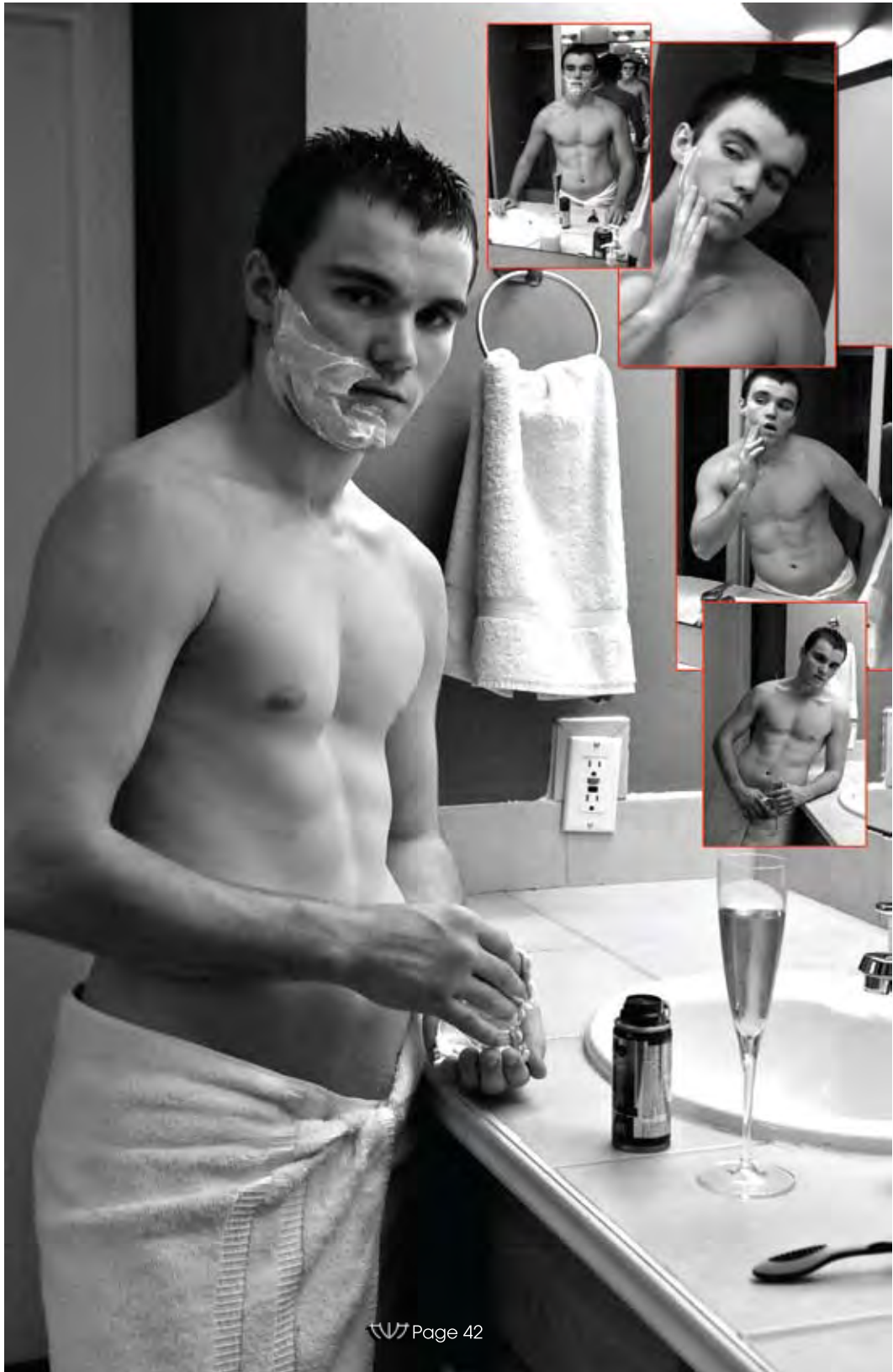
