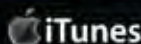


GROOVELINES

Howdy disco citizens! It's time for your weekly dose of Groovelines – your source for what's hot and hip in the land of electronic dance music and beyond.



Over at iTunes, and hot for digital download, is Madonna's final album with Warner Brothers – *Celebration*. *Celebration* is a greatest hits compilation covering the first 20 plus years of her career thus far. The deluxe video version contains 38 songs total with 3 newbies – *Celebration*, *Revolver*, and *It's So Cool* – and it also has 30 music videos. Most of her biggest hits are there, though several are missing. There are no videos from my favorite album, *American Life*, though the James Bond theme song *Die Another Day* is included as an audio file. You may recall there was some drama surrounding the album's title track and its video. *Human Nature* and *Fever* are also m.i.a. Now those are a couple of brilliant music videos. The new tracks are cool. *Celebration* was released as a single some time ago and is currently in play

on dancefloors throughout the state. *Revolver* adds itself to the growing list of songs featuring Lil Wayne. *It's So Cool* could turn out to be my favorite new Madonna song before it's all said and done. The good news here is that the 3 new tracks are available to purchase individually. They are surprisingly not "album only." This album is also available as a hard copy cd and or dvd. Other noteworthy releases this week include the new album *Scar* from Basement Jaxx, *Baby Can You Feel Me* by Danny Tenaglia and Teena Marie – the epic DT's 21st Century Ballroom Mix, *Yo Drums* by Pete Herbert, *I Get Lifted 2009* from Barbara Tucker – the Bob Sinclair remix, *Entanglement* by Josh Gabriel, *Future Disco volume 2, Global Underground 2010*, the full length album *Bass Generation* from Bass Hunter, *I Love Techno 2009* – mixed by Crookers, and *Do What U Like* from Bad Boy Bill featuring Alyssa Palmer – a tie between the Dave Aude remix and the Tony Arzadon remix. 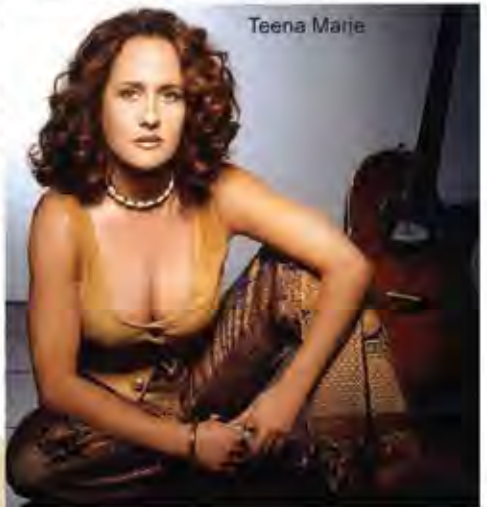

OctoTea Dance XIV

A Great Party – A GREATER CAUSE!

What happens when you combine Austin's most exciting dance party with it's most prestigious venue? An OctoTea Dance, of course! On Oct. 11, 2009 from 3pm to 9pm, the Octopus Club of Austin will present it's 14th Octo Tea Dance at The Long Center for the Performing Arts. Since 1989, The Octopus Club has been raising funds for AIDS Services of Austin's Paul Kirby Emergency Fund.

The philosophy of the club's founder, Lew Aldridge is one key to the success of our projects – that an all volunteer organization can raise funds to benefit an excellent cause and have loads of fun in the process. A second key to the event's success is the knowledge that 100% of the proceeds from tickets and auction sales go directly to benefit people with AIDS who find themselves in need. Last year's event raised over \$88,000 for the Kirby Fund!

The Paul Kirby Emergency Fund was established to honor the life and work of Kirby, an ASA volunteer who died of AIDS complications. When there is a lag time between someone with HIV/AIDS applying for and receiving benefits, or when they have depleted all other resources, the Kirby Fund steps up to purchase life-giving AIDS drugs, help with rent, eyeglasses, and other much needed assistance. The AIDS Crisis is far from over, and at any given time, there are around 6, 000 of our friends, family and neighbors in Central Texas diagnosed with HIV/AIDS. Those who are in need depend on the Kirby Fund, and most of the fund's resources are supplied by Octopus Club events. By 2007, the club's contribution had topped a million dollars.

Of the four events held each year, the OctoTea Dance is by far the largest and the most exciting. After spending a dozen or so years at The Oasis on Lake Travis, in 2008 the event moved downtown to The Long Center. Organizers feel that the new venue contributed to smashing all previous records in terms of attendance and in raising over \$88,000. This year, even with a tricky economy, OT 14 has sailed past all prior records for advance ticket sales.

This year's attractions include: internationally known DJ Roland Belmares and Austin's own DJ Seth Cooper, spinning tunes on the City Terrace. There will be plenty of dancing, topless boys, but other things will be happening too. The highly popular new feature from OT13 – the Jazz Lounge with The Kris Kimura combo in The Kodosky Lounge will provide a restful spot overlooking the terrace, to break out and listen to some great local music.

There is a regular explosion in other features this year, like:

- Silent Auction with high end art, and numerous unique one-of-a-kind items
- Experience Auction based on "The Five Senses" – anything can happen with that!
- Grand Prize Raffle – 2 nights in Las Vegas + voucher for 2 nights in a hotel + Two Tickets to see Bette Midler!
- Traditional OctoTea Fajita Buffet – Back by popular demand!
- Complimentary specialty mixed drinks (3) wine and beer
- Door Prize

The event is so widely attended from year to year that often, people re new old acquaintances and even set up mini-reunions with other regular attendees. Some folks even say they've met "Mr. Right" there!

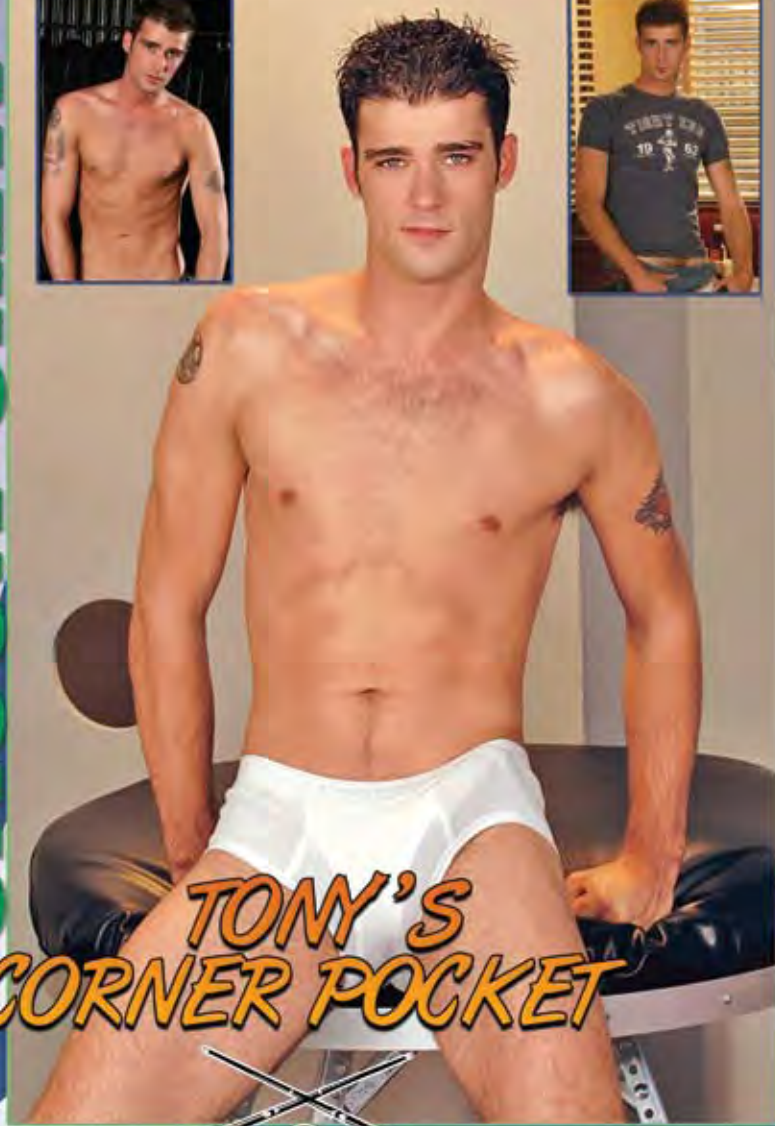
