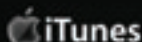
# GROOVELINES

Howdy disco citizens! It's time for your weekly dose of Groovelines – your source for what's hot and hip in the land of electronic dance music and beyond.



Over at iTunes, and hot for digital download, are the new mixes of *Sad Song* by electronic pop artist Blake Lewis. This second batch includes slammin' mixes from Jody Den Broeder & Chris Cox, David Tort, and Andy Caldwell. Check out my re-

cent interview with Blake from issue 03-16 at the TWIT website. Also diggin the grooves offered up on the remix single for *Hang On* by Plumb. Radio edits, extended mixes, and dubs are offered up from remixers Digital Dog, Dave Aude, Pete Hammond, and Bronieewe & Bose. Expect to hear this one a lot around the state. Killer record. *Hang On* is as good as, if not better than Plumb's previous monster hit, *In My Arms* from 2007. And if ya like that one be sure to check out Wynonna's sleeper hit *Sing* from earlier this year. Some of the same remixers as on Plumb's new one, with the addition of the Almighty Extended Mix, just to gay it up a little more.

There are some great new compilations out there worth checking out. The latest *Hed Kandi* features floor fillers from Freemasons, Booty Luv, Milk & Sugar, Hoxton Whores, Delerium, and Crystal Waters. If soulful house is your thing then you more than likely love *Large Music 4.0*. Highlights include songs by Roy Davis Jr, Mateo



& Matos, and Kerri Chandler. I have really been enjoying *A State of Trance Classics*, volume 4. This album features full length versions of 27 of the hottest trance anthems ever, for only \$12.99. Nalin & Kane, Matt Darey, Rank 1, Synergy, Armin Van Buuren, and Three Drives on Vinyl are just some of the artists featured on this excellent package, which is ideal for djs I might add.

Other noteworthy releases include *Bad Romance* by Lady Gaga, *This Must Be from Royksopp* – the Pete Herbert Mix, *LA Ravers* from Felix Da Housecat, *Muzikizum* by X-press 2, *Mars* from Fake Blood – the Style of Eye's Edit to Debit,



*Closer to the Sun* from Robbie Rivera, *Watcha Say* by Jason Derulo – the Johnny Vicious Remix, and the incredible full length album *Let the Love Flow* from Fuckpony. Great stuff. You'll find those floor fillers and more online at iTunes.

## Empress Emeritus 1 *Mona LittleMore*

7/7/42 - 10/10/2009

On Saturday, November 14, 2009 a Celebration of Life Memorial Service will be held at St. George's Episcopal Church located at 4301 N. IH 35, Austin, Texas 78722 (directions are below). The Service will begin at 1:00 PM with a reception to follow. During the Memorial Service, anyone wishing to say a few words; share a favorite story; recite a poem or Bible verse will be given the opportunity to do so. Everyone whose lives have been touched in some way by this remarkable person are invited to share in this commemoration of Mona's life.

Later that evening, the United Court of Austin will host a Memorial Show at Charlie's Austin. The show will begin at 8 PM and is open to all entertainers. This will be a special night to honor the life of Mona LittleMore who was a believer in the true meaning of the International Court System.

Her friend, Gene Brake (Founder, Emperor Emeritus, Absolute Emperor, Emperor VI of San Antonio) comments.

*Mona Littlemore had a heart bigger than Texas. In a nutshell, he was someone who looked for the best in folks and would support them all of the way. When Marissa and I started the court in San Antonio, he was there whenever we called him. He offered his help, guiding us in the ways of the Court and was our mentor in the early court years. He opened his home to us when we would travel to Houston and then later to Austin. He was a great cook and would cook for days getting ready for our visits. In a way, he was our court Mom.*

*I have many fond memories of our late night talks over a cocktail and morning talks over coffee. Those talks would often get heated as he didn't just agree with you, he would try to guide you in the right direction. He was passionate about helping people and passionate about the Court. He was and always will be one of the most influential people in my life due to his passion for others.*
