Long time GLBT bar owner in Austin, Warren Dronebarger, sat in a brainstorming session with some of his pals, and found that one thing was evident. Austin's GLBT scene was not a complete puzzle. Warren has been involved in Austin's bar scene for a very long time and has always tried to provide something fun and new to the scene. Check out this list—Socials. The Edge, Boys Cellar, Dick Deja Disco, Club M & M, and now the 113 San Jacinto digs, now formerly know as CP. Mr. Dronebarger's list is extensive, and his involvement on, and behind the GLBT scene in Austin is well know, but the one piece of 'the puzzle' that I did not list is one other bar he owned. Over 15 years ago, and then some, Warren owned Sister's Edge, a Lesbian Bar.

With the help of their sister bar, Oilcan Harry's, and it's owner, Larry Davis. The plans have been set, and Warren has moved forward with his grand vision to help the community be represented in all aspects when it comes to the bar crowds. Warren graciously has decided to turn General Management over to the skill set of Margie, as she gives a warm welcome home to all the Ladies in Austin, and prepares to open the doors for the grand opening on Saturday, November 14, 2009, of Sister's Edge II at 113 San Jacinto. Austin will once again have a bar for the female set of the GLBT community. No longer will the "Real Girls" have to go to other male oriented gay bars in Austin to feel as if that is what they have to settle with. When I spoke with GM Margie of Sister's Edge II, who currently runs the



Mascara Gone Mad show at OCH, and asked her to give me some quotes for this story she was quick, decisive, and very sweetly stern with her comment. "It's about time. The last bar I remember was Nexxus, which was 15 years ago. I also don't like the phrase "Lesbian Bar", this is going to be a Ladies Bar. Please don't get this twisted though. We will always welcome the boys to come and play, but we are catering to what the ladies in the community are looking for."



In the grand scheme of things, once Sister's Edge II was decided on, Larry called up his booking agent for OCH and demanded the best Girl 4 Girl DJ in Texas be booked on the grand opening of Sister's Edge II, and every Saturday after. In to the light steps my long time friend, and 07'06' and 09's best female DJ in Houston, voted on by Out Smart Magazine, DJ Rocky B. After her booking I spoke briefly with Rocky on her feelings of coming to Austin and the absence of a "Lady's Bar". "I am honored, I have been waiting a long time to get the opportunity to step outside my hometown, and Austin has always been a place that I have wanted to spin, but with the male orientated bars their, my booking agent for Texas could never get me a gig. This is really historical for all the girls in Austin, and I am super stoked that I get to be apart of the female resurgence in Austin's' LGBT community. This is a chance for us all to pull together and have something we can call ours and support. I just want to say one more

thing for all the girls in Austin. Be ready to shake your ass. Leave your heels at home and bring your tennis." I know for a fact that when Rocky B brings "it", it doesn't matter what part of the community you fit into, she's going to make you move.

To top the master plan off, one of Austin's most recognizable Lesbian faces among bartenders, Brenda Leahy, had to be hired immediately. I wanted her to take a moment, and have her tell you what this means to her. "I think this is great. I'm excited personally. I hope that the boys don't feel that we are trying to exclude them. I love my guys and they are more than welcome. We just are going to have what makes us happy. You know how many times we, as lesbians, have had to settle with going to a male oriented gay bar and turn around with a guy in his underwear in our

face? Not fun for us. I feel that my presence at Sister's Edge II will be encouraging for the boys come and play"

A woman's touch is surely what has been lacking in Austin, and I for one, feel that this will become a sure fire hot spot for years to come! Until next time Gay Texas, be as fierce as you can!

What's the craziest job you have experienced? I once had sex with an A-List celebrity and a pregnant dominator in a dungeon. I was really caught offguard with that




If my keyboard could talk...: Actually, I like to think that my keyboard DOES talk, it communicates something of me to others... hopefully in a language in which they can relate.

Hi Jeremy! Thanks for taking time off your busy schedule to do this interview for TWT Magazine.

TWT - How did you get your start in Gay Porn?

still and have always felt unbelievably honored to have been asked to join the most prestigious stable of male performers amongst the Pom Universe. Chi Chi and Channel 1 Releasing have taken me in, and really let me be myself, and grow within the ranks to try and become the best that I can be for everyone to enjoy. They've taken care of me, taught me, and taken me to places I may have never been able to do on my own. I cannot thank them enough for everything, and look forward to where the future takes us as well.

TWT - You've done 9 films for Channel1 so far. How many more are planned with you? JB - Well, the simple and easy answer is: Contractually I'm in 5 more films with Channel 1 Releasing. But, I hope that there are plenty more than that as well.

TWT -You have worked for some other companies prior to signing with Channel1. What is different about Channel1Releasing from the others?

JB - I would say that the biggest difference is the Family feel to the company. I loved working with NextDoor Studios and JetSet Men. I do still work with Jake Cruise as well. Those companies are great, and so friendly. I still talk quite regularly with everyone from those companies. and I feel that we have a great relationship with one another all around. The camaradene amongst everyone in each of the studios is very tight, close and friendly, which I love. But with Channel 1, we also quite regularly hang out outside of work functions, and travel together all over. Chi Chi is quite very much so like our Mother, and takes care of us as we are her kids.
