

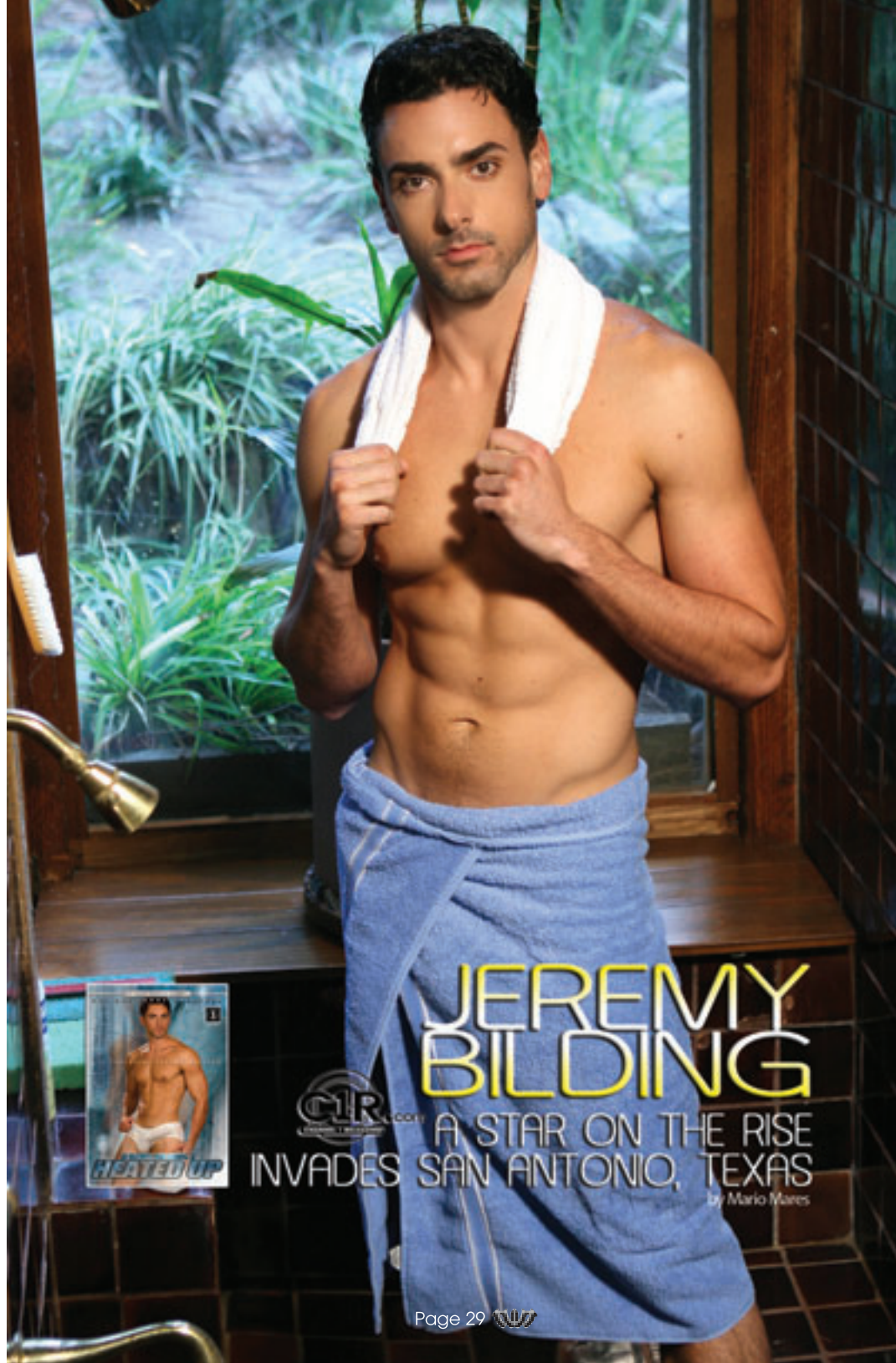

Hi Jeremy! Thanks for taking time off your busy schedule to do this interview for TWT Magazine.

**TWT - How did you get your start in Gay Porn?**

JB - *The short story, I had always wanted to get into porn. So, a few years ago, after I started making some changes in my life's plan, I decided to start looking at getting into the industry. I had contacted an ad on Craigslist looking for guys wanting to break in, and started talking with the Scout about possibilities. I'm not going to lie, between the Kidney Stone that had hospitalized me that morning, and the high from just finishing one of the hottest scenes I'd ever done, I didn't even know what to say. I seriously am still and have always felt unbelievably honored to have been asked to join the most prestigious stable of male performers amongst the Porn Universe. Chi Chi and Channel 1 Releasing have taken me in, and really let me be myself, and grow within the ranks to try and become the best that I can be for everyone to enjoy. They've taken care of me, taught me, and taken me to places I may have never been able to do on my own. I cannot thank them enough for everything, and look forward to where the future takes us as well.*

**TWT - You've done 9 films for Channel1 so far. How many more are planned with you?**

JB - *Well, the simple and easy answer is: Contractually I'm in 5 more films with Channel 1 Releasing. But, I hope that there are plenty more than that as well.*

**TWT - You have worked for some other companies prior to signing with Channel1. What is different about Channel1Releasing from the others?**

JB - *I would say that the biggest difference is the Family feel to the company. I loved working with NextDoor Studios and JetSet Men. I do still work with Jake Cruise as well. Those companies are great, and so friendly. I still talk quite regularly with everyone from those companies,*
