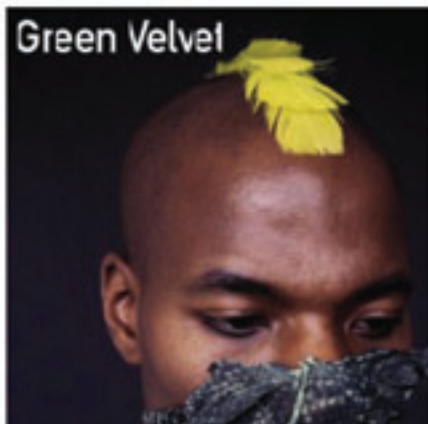

Takes On Texas Tour

Interview by Brett Vander

TWT had the pleasure to catch up with Miss Coco Peru (aka Clinton Leupp) who will be on a four city tour January 14th-17th with appearances in Austin, Dallas, Houston and San Antonio respectively. For those of you living without cable, satellite or rabbit ears out on the plains, Miss Coco Peru has appeared in Arrested Development, Will & Grace, Girls Will Be Girls and To Wong Foo Thanks For Everything, Julie Newmar. However, you may remember her best for the on-screen advice she gave a very nervous Christian Campbell in the men's room in Trick, when she told him "IT BURNS!"

TWT: I hear you are a virgin to Texas and this is your first tour in the Lone Star State. How do you feel about that and what took you so long to get here?!

COCO: I'm so excited to be coming to Texas. It is a huge state and apparently there are a lot of gay folks there because over the years I have gotten so many emails from people asking me to come there, so I'm thrilled to be able to finally say, "I'm coming to Texas y'all!" I'm also looking forward to some authentic Tex-Mex! Food and boys.

Your tour is aptly titled "Miss Coco Peru Takes on Texas". Are you arriving with any preconceived notions about what Texas and Texans are like that you would like dispelled or confirmed? What is your "take on Texas"? By the way, we might surprise you in a good way.

One of my earliest impressions of Texas occurred years ago. It was the first time I had a connecting flight in Dallas and I stepped off the plane and smelled fried food and saw a lot of big hair and I thought, "Oh, I need to come back and visit this place." Yet, it has never happened! My only experience of Texas has been in the airports! Like I said, it's a big state and my impression is that everything in it is big. Please don't disappoint!

What would you like people to know about your upcoming shows in Texas?

It's always been difficult to describe my act. I guess you can call me a Drag Queen/Monolo-

gist/World Savior. Well, maybe not the World Savior part, but it's important to have goals. I like to think that with my show I create a safe environment where I can do what I do best: change lives. I guess that does make me a Drag Queen/Monologist/World Savior! See? If you just set goals you eventually reach them. I just reached mine in a matter of a few sentences!

It's also been said that Coco Peru is a drag show you can take your mother to and I completely agree. Having said that, I'm not sure if it's because people want to share the gift of Coco with their mothers or if it's their way of saying, "Mom, you may not be happy with my being gay, but look... it could've been a lot worse... a lot worse!"

I read Bea Arthur was your idol growing up and that you actually became friends later in life. What do you think your dear departed friend Bea Arthur would enjoy most about your "Take on Texas Tour" if she were here?

As a child I was obsessed with Bea, she was my icon, so it was exciting for me to be a friend of hers! She was a hilarious woman and I am grateful for the 10 or so years of friendship that I had with her. Bea loved gay people and we were a big part of her life. She loved witty, funny people and, as we all know, we have a large concentration of those in our community, but Bea also felt a deep bond with anyone that was treated unfairly. She couldn't stand for any kind of injustice and I think she admired our ability to survive and to laugh in the face of our challenges. So I am sure Bea would be happy that I am touring Texas and spreading the word of Coco!

How would you describe your humor?

Dark, yet divine.

Being a bicoastal, big city gal from NYC and living in LA, any sage words of wisdom or strategies on how we might legalize marriage here in the U.S.?

Guns!

On a related note, which causes or issues are close to your heart that you feel passionately about and act on to make a difference?

I am very passionate about raising money for AIDS organizations as well programs that help gay youth. I am involved with the Los Angeles Gay and Lesbian Center and what I find most satisfying is seeing the homeless gay teens getting the support they unfortunately could not get from their families. Having a supportive family that not only embraces my being gay but totally celebrates "Coco", I can't imagine what these teens are going through. Knowing that the money I raised is helping them to keep them off the streets and create a future for themselves is something I feel so lucky to be a part of.

Is there an interesting story behind your name that you can share?

Years ago, before I did drag, my first boyfriend was a Peruvian guy and I traveled to Peru with him where I met a drag queen named Coco. She was quite famous and I was sort of fascinated that, whereas being gay was a huge taboo in Peru, she had crossed over into the mainstream and had people's respect. I was very inspired that she was celebrated in such a Catholic and macho society. It was then that I realized that there was power in drag. So, later when I decided to do drag myself and I started to write my first show I called myself Coco, sort of as a working name until I could come up with something else, but the name grew on me and then I stuck the Peru on it in honor of both the Coco that had inspired me as well as the country that I had been inspired in. Was that interesting? Personally, I'm feeling a little sleepy!

What's in the pipeline for Coco's future?

I recently filmed a pilot for a reality show so we'll see if that goes anywhere. I also plan on writing a new show and of course I have my new LOGO special that I filmed with Varla Jean Merman and Jackie Beat that will begin airing in January. If people want to know where I am going to be they can check out my calendar and also add their email to my list at my website www.cocoperu.com!

What's a dream of yours that has yet to happen?

I'd like to win Lotto... and not just a few hundred thousand, I want to win big. I'm thinking 164 million. I just like the sound of that number and I'm not going to settle for anything less! Again, it's important to have goals! I think a drag queen with my passion and 164 million can get gay marriage passed in this country and get my own goddamn TV show!

Any last words for your Texas TWT fans?

I'm available for lunch.

Thank you for coming to Texas! We hope you have a great time in all the cities you are entertaining and that your take on Texas is positive and you come back!

Miss Coco Peru will be performing in Austin on January 14th at the Emerald City; in Dallas on January 15th at the Rose Room at S4; in Houston on January 16th at the Frenticore Theatre; and last but not least in San Antonio on January 17th at the Josephine Theatre.

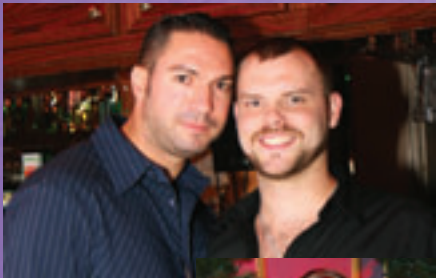

Yeah, that's what we were looking for. Instead we find Oscar manning the store and trying to dress us in a leather harness and more.



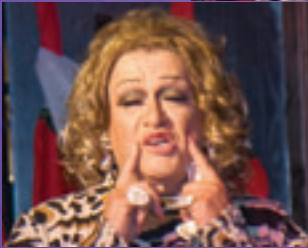
