


Howdy disco citizens! It's time for your weekly dose of Groovelines - your source for what's hot and hip in the land of electronic dance music and beyond.





DJ and Producer Scotty K 's music career began about ten years ago in New York City. He spent much of his free time outside of his network television career establishing himself as one of the hot up and coming DJs around, spinning at some of the city's hottest bars and nightclubs, such as Blu, Spike and Twirt. This buzz carried him to South America in 1999, where he wowed Latin crowds with his musical talents at Tiffany's and Eros, two of the hottest nightclubs in Caracas, Venezuela. In addition to these talented artists, Scotty K. has worked with and shared the DJ booth with some of the industries best DJs, including Hex Hector, Tony Moran, Manny Lehman, Barry Hamis, Chris Cox, Eddie X., Jason Randolph, Brett Henrichsen, Max Rodriguez, Alex Lauterstein, Mac Quayle and Mark Tarbox, Scotty K. was nominated for a Sh WeHo Award Sh> in the category of "Outstanding DJ Of The Year" in 2003, 2004 and 2005 with superstar DJs Manny Lehman and Kimberly S., ranking him one of the top eight DJs in Ds Angeles. Scotty K. was honored as the 2004 Honorary DJ of the Year" by the West Hollywood community and by the 2004 WeHo Awards Committee.

In Fall 2003, Scotty K. was hired by The Ellen Degeneres Show and made television history as daytime television's first "DJ", in lieu of a band and bandleader. Scotty K. helped successfully launch the show by adding his vast musical Knowledge and credibility to the show and contributed to making it a rating hit. Since then, he has moved orward and upward producing dance & electronic music for major record labels such as Warner Bros. Records, Sony Music Entertainment, MCA/Universal Music, JIVE Records as well as working on dance remixes of tracks by artists such as Madonna, Mary J. Blige, Christina Aguilera, Kelly Rowland, Idina Mezel, LeAnn Rimes, Kimberley Locke and good friend, Debby Holiday.




God-des & She have always been unique — a female hip-hop/soul duo whose sound varies as widely as their subject matter. With their third album, appropriately titled Three, God-Des (the rapper) and She (the singer) now embark on a journey to cross over from substantial underground success to the mainstream. While the duo may have initially been star struck in working with Hardgroove, the legendary producer was impressed as well. They are easily as good as the best that hip-hop has to offer," Hardgroove says of the duo, "and far more interesting.

Bred in the Midwest, God-Des & She have played to packed venues all over the world, from Lacrosse, Wisconsin, to Stockholm, Sweden. Ever since they appeared on Showtime's The L. Word four years ago, performing their infamous single "Lick It," the pair haven't had a moment's rest, selling over 30,000 albums, and holding down the #1 song spot on MTV LOGO with their song "Love You Better."
