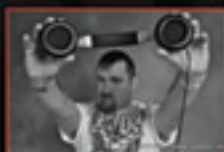

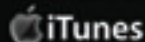


GROOVELINES

Over at iTunes, and hot for digital download, is the new one from Space Cowboy - Electro Pioneers. On Electro Pioneers, Space Cowboy has teamed up with 3 legendary electronic music artists that made a monumental impact on the world of synthesizer based music back in the early 80's. The music they created and released has influenced thousands of musicians the world over. Talking about Thomas Dolby, Howard Jones, and Vince Clarke.

Thomas Dolby gained international notoriety in the 80's when his song She Blinded Me With Science became a huge hit on the both mainstream radio and that new experimental channel - MTV. In 2008, Thomas Dolby toured with dj / producer BT and is still a vital part of the EDM scene. Howard Jones had several synth based pop hits, including New Song, Things Can Only Get Better, and What Is Love. Vince Clarke was the mastermind behind synth pop bands Depeche Mode, Yazoo, and Erasure. Clarke takes on Space Cowboy's hit Falling Down. Howard Jones remixed the song Devastated. Thomas Dolby



reinterpreted the Space Cowboy classic Egyptian Lover. All 3 tracks on Electro Pioneers are from Space Cowboy's full-length album Digital Rock Star, also available on iTunes.



American Idol runner-up and beat boxer, Blake Lewis, has just released the title-track single from his second album Heartbreak on Vinyl. The album went on sale in October 2009 with the first single, Sad Song being released in July. But now the season six American Idol star, whose unique style brought beat boxing and scat mainstream, will unveil the album's next single on January 19th. The single includes remixes from LA Riots, Chew Fu, and Gimbo Jones.



There is a very cute fan video for Heartbreak on Vinyl up on YouTube. The video doesn't feature Blake in a single frame. Instead, it works as an homage to 80's and 90's teen films. Can you pick out your favorites? Blake Lewis garnered celebrity status during his impressive run on Season Six of American Idol. He was the runner up only losing to now pop star Jordin Sparks. AUSTIN BABTIST WOMEN

It was late 2005 when I was first invited to a show featuring the Austin Babbit Women and I must say that when I heard the words aloud, I wasn't incredibly excited. Having never heard of this group of performers, I naturally assumed that it was simply a group of church ladies singing a few hymns. Boy was I wrong. For any of you out there that may not be familiar, the Austin Babbit Women (yes, that's Babbit with two b's) are a group of four hilarious gray haired drag queens that take comedy to new heights all in the name of charity.

It all started back in 1986, when four members of the Texas Gay Rodeo Association planned some surprise entertainment for the state meeting. Glen Hostetter, Tim Jackson, Philip Prock and Garry Holley made a trip to a local thrift store where they bought the tackiest dresses they could find and accessorized the outfits with pearls, grandma glasses and gloves. They topped it off with some old gray wigs and some Elsie Exquisite makeup and hit the stage with "Looking For a City" by the Happy Goodman Family and so the Austin Babbit Women were born.



Over the years the faces and names have changed but their goal of raising spirits and money for charity has continued on. Ima I hear you are single. Are you looking?

Honey, I never stopped! And I have the dirt on all of the others. Call me if you want to know.

For you other girls, is it difficult to have a husband and be a Babbit Woman?

OFeelYa: Absolutely. It's harder on them than it is on us. They have to put up with all of the glitter and traveling and they don't get the credit.

Tell me ladies, where do you get your outfits?

Ima: Betty's an eBay queen. She pays way too much.

Out of all your years of performing, are there any memories or shows that stand out?

Modine: One of the most memorable shows was when Ima joined the cast at the Hyatt for a fundraiser for the Texas AIDS Network. You see, Ima was on the board of the Texas AIDS Network and was helping plan the event. Two of the previous Babbtist Women had just quit the group and there was a show booked for the next week. Ima had never even met the Babbtist Women. She called and said she would come out in drag and do anything as long as the show would go on. And when she came out on stage for the first time, I looked down and saw that the anti-theft device was still hooked on her shoe. We couldn't get it off through the whole show.

What about any embarrassing moments?

OFeelYa: Every time we take the stage! I mean pick a moment. It's theater, stuff happens. Ima's hat, hair and dress have come completely off in almost every single location we have ever worked in. Modine has had her hair go blowing down the street. I've had clothes fall off on stage. It's live and you just have to keep going.

You have performed in parks, poolside, and other conditions that aren't ideal for drag. Is there anywhere you would NOT perform?

OFeelYa: I don't think necessarily that there are places we won't perform, but there are probably things we would not perform for. It's more along those lines. There are people we won't perform for. If there was a group that was denigrating to religion, women, men or anything else we would not perform for them. We also try to stay non political.

Sister Betty Bea, you are the newest member of the group. How did you become a member?

Well I can be a ham at times and I was an avid follower of the Babbtist Women. I always enjoyed them a lot. I was intrigued and impressed by the nature of being a part of a group that raised money for causes near and dear to us all. And I honestly felt a calling to join such a group so when the opportunity presented itself, I jumped on it. And I wouldn't change it for the world.

What does 2010 hold for the ABW?

Modine: Who knows? We have our four signature shows that we do every year, but it's the second week in January and we already have about ten requests for shows.

Ladies, thank you for your time. Are there any last words you would like to share with our readers?

Modine: It's always great to be bartending and have someone that I may not know all that well grab my hand and thank me for what we do because it helped them directly. I've always been kind of emotional and that always makes me tear up.

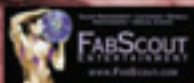
