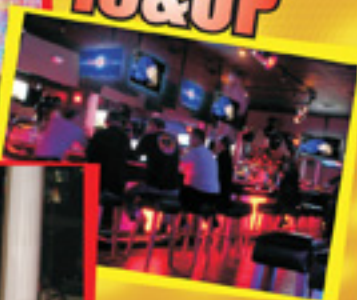

# GROOVELINES

Howdy disco citizens! It's time for your weekly dose of Groovelines – your source for what's hot and hip in the land of electronic dance music and beyond.

Over at iTunes, and hot for digital download, is the new full-length album from UK pop sensation **Little Boots** titled *Hands*. Little Boots – better known to her family as Victoria Hesketh – was without a doubt one of the most talked about new UK pop stars of 2009. She was named one of NME's Best New Artists of the year, won a BRIT's critics' choice award and stateside Little Boots has been described as a "synth pop gem" by the NY Post and an "artists to watch" by Rolling Stone magazine. All this praise ain't for nothing, trust. Girl has it going on. The new disc, *Hands*, is a highly entertaining album of synth driven songs that takes you on a



journey to the 80's and back. The current single *Remedy* is in play on XM and the dancefloors the world over. Other highlights on *Hands* include the songs *Click*, *Earthquake*, *Stuck on Repeat*, *No Brakes*, and *Symmetry* - featuring the legendary British singer **Philip Oakey**. Philip Oakey was once the lead singer for the pioneering all synth group known as **The Human League** – a band originally launched in the late 70's that went on to major pop success in the mid 80's with their hits *Don't You Want Me* and *Fascination*. The great Little Boots worked with some other major players on *Hands* as well including Greg Kurstin (**Kylie Minogue**, **Lily Allen**) and Joe Goddard (**Hot Chip**). This bad ass disc of ear candy is available as a download at iTunes or on limited edition vinyl at [store.elektra.com/collections/little-boot-s-us-webstore](http://store.elektra.com/collections/little-boot-s-us-webstore). Little Boots is currently touring with a coveted slot at Coachella on the list. Learn more about Little Boots online at [littlebootsmusic.net](http://littlebootsmusic.net).

Another fantastic synth based album, but more on the chill side, is the 1992 classic from Grant Showbiz and James F.T.Hood, better known as **Moodswings**, titled *Moodfood*. This masterpiece is best known for the Jon and Vangelis based track *Spiritual High* – a 15 minute 3 part auroral journey that features the beautiful vocal talents of **Pretenders** lead **Chrissie Hynde** singing *State Of Independence* and spotlights the late **Dr. Martin Luther King's** inspiring *I Have A Dream* speech. Wow. This song is nothing short of a modern masterpiece. *Moodfood* also includes the song *Skinthieves* - used as the theme for the tv show *America's Most Wanted* featuring an awesome guitar solo from **Jeff Beck**. *Moodfood* from Moodswings is ambient and chill at its finest. Enjoy.

Sooo, I probably don't need to tell you that iTunes has the new music video from **Lady GaGa** and **Beyoncé** for their dancefloor packing hit *Telephone* for only \$2, do I? Luv that video. So colorful, and cool. Dig the homage to **Madonna** and **Quentin Tarantino**. Gotta say, Lady GaGa has never looked better when dancing in a jail cell in a crime scene



tape bikini. **Beyoncé** looks fierce in that wig. Damn this vid is ridiculous and hot. 2 words: **PUSSY WAGON!** [roflmfao](http://roflmfao.com), iTunes also has all the remixes you'll need of this new classic dance hit.



Also diggin' the good vibes and kick ass grooves being offered up from iTunes from the full length *Plastic Beach* from **Gorillaz**, *Rocket* by **Goldfrapp** – the Tiesto mix, *Common Ground* from **Dave Audé & Tall Paul** – the Richard Morel mix, and the bouncy *Always Wanted You Close* from **Kill Light**. 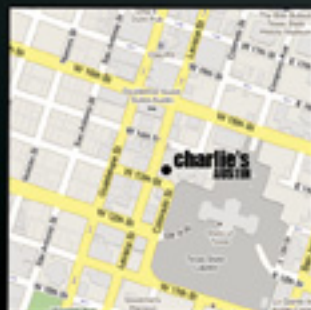

TWIT caught up with Howard Okon, the owner of The Brick bar and Joe's. Last we reported, The Brick was closing its Maple Avenue venue and promised to reopen in the near future at a then undecided location. Fast forward to November 16, 2009 and The Brick quietly opened as a bar with permits in the works for it to be an afterhours dancehall. On March 27th, The Brick will have its grand reopening as an afterhours dance club for 18 and over.

So why the delay in opening The Brick in a new locale? First they had to find a location. Luckily Okon was approached by the owner of the new location and his reputation as a decent business owner preceded him. The new location is in a Wycliff Avenue strip mall along with neighbors Oishii, Sal's, Subway and Dickey's. Just a few blocks from their old location, Okon liked the proximity to their old stomping ground just around the corner. An agreement was quickly reached and the bar was finished sooner than planned but getting the permits took longer than expected. His liquor license was transferable since he was just changing locations so that was not an obstacle, but he had to obtain a Special Use Permit from the City of Dallas to operate within 1,000 feet of a residential area. Then he needed a dancehall permit. Last came the after hours permit. No easy task since the last time an afterhours Special Use Permit was granted was about three years ago.

Obtaining permits can be a bureaucratic, political, pull-your-hair-out experience even with a good reputation, exemplary history and advocates in City Hall. Every permit

had a hearing process. Every permit had to be obtained in a specific order. Having a good reputation and getting his ducks in a row was just part of the process. City council members are all pro-business however, not necessarily pro-bar business. Often City Council members don't want to appear pro-alcohol or pro-bar business to their constituents so it was imperative to stress the benefits the club would bring to the neighborhood and their commitment to being a good neighbor and addition to the community. When all was said and done, it took three special city permits, \$30,000 in lawyers and fees, endless politicking and many months to open his club back up in a new venue. And that is with a good reputation and 15 years in the bar business!



Dallas touts itself as a conference and entertainment destination. Okon's experience is less than smooth sailing and open doors for business. Okon says the City of Dallas is actively reducing the number of bars and clubs in Dallas which runs contrary to what they are promoting. Of course, Okon took the higher road to obtain permits in the first place and do everything by the book. Other establishments, he notes without any specifics, have not or are skirting the law by operating as restaurants or allowing dancing without a dancehall permit. They risk the City shutting them down but he admits the laws aren't enforced consistently. As a savvy business owner, Okon didn't want to worry about those possibilities and took the higher Brick road to play by the rules so he could sleep at night.

So what's the new Brick like? Physically, The Brick and Joe's are next to each other, joined at the hip, sharing a common stage wall boasting a retractable door. There is an embedded dance floor lighting system reminiscent of Merlin (if you don't remember Merlin, it's past your bedtime, go home). Text screens dot the walls and over-bar spaces which have been very popular along with a low-res, Vegas-like, wall-length screen that gives a big stadium feel when they display messages, logos and video. The main electronic entertainment comes from their own in-house channel playing slideshows



and videos. And let's not forget the smoking patio. Of course, it's the people that really make the space special -- Jazsmyne, Camille, Mickey, Ginda, Tyler, Danny, Joao and other familiar faces you may recognize and friendly patrons.

The Brick opens at 4pm with Tyler hosting the bar weekdays. It's open to 18 and over with no cover before 10pm. During the week, there is a variety of things going on including live bands, go-go boys, female impersonator shows, karaoke with Little Chalupa...and food on Tuesdays around 6pm! (We can't live on olives and maraschino cherries alone). Check their schedule for current events. You may also run into gay employee groups being hosted for afterhour drinks. Friday nights are designated Hip Hop evenings and Saturdays have triple DJs, each spinning their own set 8-10pm, 10-12midnight and 12midnight till 4am and geared for the new generation.

Welcome back to the Gayborhood!  
See you on March 27th.

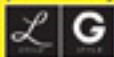
