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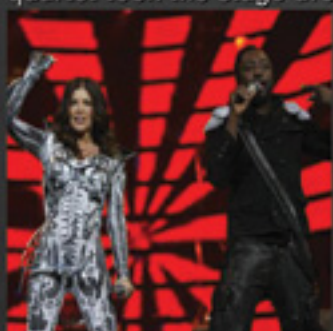


GROOVELINES

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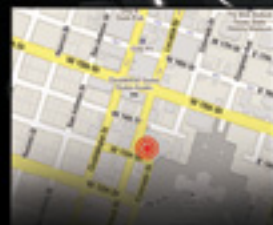

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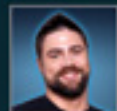


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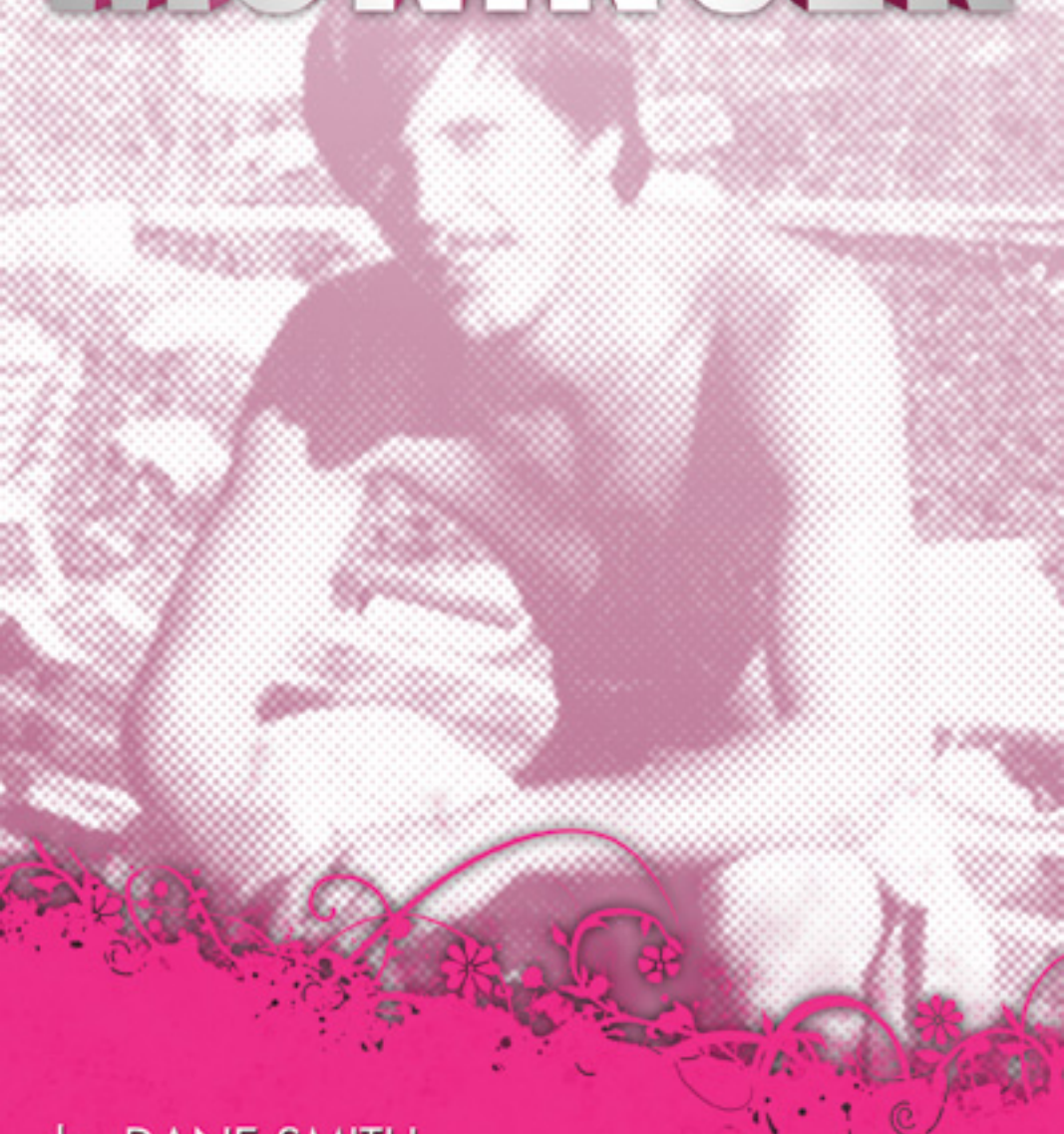
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EDWARD MONINGER

was known for his love of life and generous spirit. Ed spent most of his life completing his goal of not only cultivating a successful career, but continuously giving back to the gay community. It has been said that if someone was in need of anything, Ed was there.

Ed opened up a small bar on Richmond Avenue and decided to call it EJ's after the first letter of both his and his partner, Jeff's first names. What started as a small pub type atmosphere soon took off and Ed moved the location of the bar to the heart of Houston's gay district, Westheimer Road, in the 1990s. From that point on, there was just no turning back for Ed. He continued to develop his bar into the success it is today.

Even though Ed may have been an incredible businessman and he may have cultivated a lucrative business, he made sure that EJ's never lost the small bar feeling. Ed always wanted to be true to his roots and remember where he came from. EJ's quickly became the home bar of many charities and organizations including the Sovereign Court of Houston. Ed's

door always seemed to be open for just about anything, including anyone who needed a place to hold a fundraiser, memorial service or tribute for a friend or loved one.

More than just a home to charities and organizations, EJ's was home to Ed himself. In fact, he was considered a fixture at the bar. A good friend of Ed's, Charles Armstrong said that "No one love EJ's more than Ed himself." Those who frequent the bar could all agree that Ed was usually the first one there and the last to leave. He also has been described as a simple man. Not in the sense that he wasn't deep or complicated, but in the sense that if you knew Ed for ten minutes, then you truly did know Ed Moninger. He was very much a what-you-see-is-what-you-get kind of person.

Some say that Ed was even generous to a fault. Long time employee and good friend of Ed, Christian Devries said, "No matter what was going on in your life, as long as you were trying, Ed would always stick by you. Even if you were messing up all the time, as long as you were trying he didn't care." As a way of always giving back to the community, Ed always made sure that Thanksgiving Dinner was served every year at EJ's for anyone who needed a place to go or something to eat; even though at times it even fell on his birthday.

Ed was also known as a mentor to the community. A former employee of EJ's, Tony Vaccaro, shared with me that when he left to open up his own bar, Ed was always friendly, caring and supportive whenever he had questions. He also wanted me to know that Ed taught him a lot about not only business, but life and friendship as well. Many people say that Ed Moninger was one of the best people that they have ever known.

While Ed's life may have been too short, it was an absolute success. Ed in many ways had a more successful life than many people who live more than twenty or thirty years longer than he did. He not only ran a successful business for many years, he found everything he wanted in life. He spent over 30 years with the love of his life, had his dream job and was loved by everyone that knew him. Ed definitely was richer in spirit than most people could dream about.

On behalf of the staff of This Week in Texas Magazine, our condolences go out to the friends and family of the beloved Edward Moninger. He will not only be missed, but celebrated by those he left behind. The community lost a great man, but the memories of great times and close friendships live on in our hearts and minds.

Bunnies on the Bayou

It was a sunny Easter Sunday back in 1979, when a few friends decided to change the course of history. A small get together was organized in a Clay Street apartment and thus “Bunnies on the Bayou” was born. Word spread like wild fire over the next year and by Easter 1980 the event had grown into an invitation only event. On Sunday, April 4, 2010, “Bunnies on the Bayou” (BOTB) is celebrating its 31st anniversary at the Wortham Center Fish Plaza and Sesquicentennial Park located at 500 Texas Avenue. BOTB is a Houston area 501(c)(3) organization dedicated to the raising and distributing money for various charitable, educational and cultural programs. Any of the beneficiaries of this event must seek to improve the quality of life for individuals in the community and promote education and awareness of individual human rights.

What started as a simple house party with an “admission” of a simple bag of canned goods, has transformed into one of the largest outdoor cocktail fundraisers in the State of Texas. Each year BOTB attracts anywhere from 1500 to 2000 attendees for a Sunday afternoon amongst friends. Attendees are required to be over the age of 21 and a minimum donation of \$30 is requested. VIP tickets as well as sponsorship programs are available starting at \$125 at www.bunniesonthebayou.org.

Thanks to both corporate and individual sponsors, Bunnies on the Bayou has been able to donate between \$35,000 to \$45,000 per year to different Houston charities, totaling more than \$528,000 over the past ten years. This year BOTB will be raising funds for twelve different programs as their beneficiaries:

AIDS Foundation Houston –Camp Hope, Bayou City Performing Arts, Bering Omega, Center for AIDS,

Colt 45's, ICOH, Lazarus House, Lesbian Health Initiative, Montrose Counseling Center, Osito Foundation, Pet Patrol and PFLAG.

Over the years, Bunnies on the Bayou has expanded to even more than just an Easter Sunday cocktail fundraiser. This year BOTB added a Basket Raffle complete with a bar bash, a silent auction at the annual VIP Event and a Grand Opening Celebration with P*Jai's Fashions. Also on April 27, M2M Fashions is pairing up with BOTB to host a fashion show and raffle from 7-10pm with a clothing drive for the AIDS Foundation of Houston at DUO from 2-5. The Host of Bunnies committee even brought back the ever popular Snow Bunnies party on January 17, 2010. If that isn't enough, you will want to stay tuned for the first ever Bunnies in Heat party coming later this summer.

Bunnies on the Bayou would once again like to thank its sponsors, without whom this would not be possible. shenanigans and the like. Green beer and drinks were plentiful and the luck of the Irish was felt throughout the bar. I know that I sure am lucky.



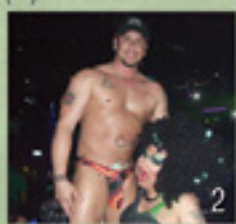
Tom introduced me to the brand new bar back **Brad** and I think I'm in love. He flashed that sexy smile and I got a little weak in my knees. See you soon Brad!
