After improving and adapting his act to incorporate the incomparable Lady Gaga, Derrick is ready to revisit all of his fans. After getting wind that Derrick will be performing in both Houston and Austin again this week, I sat down with him and caught up on what was happening in his life.

So what's new in the world of Derrick Barry?

I am also excited to start recording my own music this spring. I'll be working with producers on a pop album inspired by musical theatre and dance.

Do you keep up with RP Drag Race? Is there anyone you are specifically rooting for?

I love the show! I met all the girls from last season at RuPaul's Drag Race Art Show and I have worked with a few this past year. I am not going to pick

a favorite because chances are I will work with a few girls from this season as well.

Who are your influences for your craft?

Obviously Britney Spears and Lady Gaga influence me with their creativity and talent. They are so different, yet appeal to very similar markets. I am also extremely influenced by musical theatre. I most recently performed "Roxie" from Chicago and will be performing "Part of Your World" from The Little Mermaid at Krave for my Musical Theatre Tribute, every first Sunday of the month.

Are there any other drag performance artists that you have worked with or would like to work with in the future?

I have worked with drag queens and celebrity female impersonators all over the country. Each are unique and individual. The first female impersonator I met was Chad Michaels. He is phenomenal and an absolute pleasure to work with. Chad had a helping hand in arranging my audition for An Evening at La Cage in Las Vegas. I love my entire cast at Divas Las Vegas. They are all the best in the business and I draw inspiration from them in many ways. Another favorite performer I would love to work with again is Erica Andrews. She is one of the most beautiful people I have ever seen. It would be an honor to work with RuPaul. It's like Oprah and Tyra had a baby.

Do you have any words for those who would like to follow in your footsteps?

I really believe in "The Secret" and The Law of Attraction. As a child, I always dreamed of living in big cities and seeing my name in lights. Now, I live in a city filled with lights and am proud to be part of Las Vegas entertainment history.

Any last words for our readers?

I finally have 2 personal autographs from Britney Spears and Lady Gaga. I met Gaga and took a photo with her after her Las Vegas Monster Ball. I apologized to her for lip-syncing to her music, she said, "It's okay, because if you didn't, you drag queens would put us out of business." I will remember that quote forever.

OK, well, Lambert already was a queen, wasn't he? But Mike added that extra glitter to make him shine.

In all of his previous work, Mike Ruiz has been behind-the-lens. Will there ever be another RuPaul?

RuPaul was the first queen. She broke so much ground for all others that I'm not sure any queen will ever reach that level of notoriety, but you never know. I'd love to see a drag queen win an Oscar!

Have you ever done drag?

Are you kidding, again? My brother does hair and make-up in San Diego. He used to dress me in the full regalia every time I'd visit and then he would take pictures! I have an album full of drag photos of me.

How did you become an expert on drag queens?

It's what I do for a living. I dress people up with outrageous hair, make-up and wardrobe and then I photograph them.

Do you purposely surround yourself with glamour?

It's my drug. It is how I make all of my delusional fantasies come to life. The coolest thing is that I get paid to do it.

Do you regard your muscles as a form of drag?

I never thought of it that way but I guess it is a kind of drag. It's all part of my self expression, just like my wardrobe. So that would make it drag, wouldn't it?

What lies beneath that body of steel?

(Laughs) I'm a little kid having fun while trying to be a decent human being along the way.

Are you and RuPaul friends off-camera?

Close friends! We hang out whenever our schedules permit. RuPaul is such a beautiful, warm and loving human being.

Any fun personal RuPaul stories you wanna share?

One of my favorite stories is when RuPaul brought me to Jumbo's Clown Room, a female strip club in Los Angeles. We were howling like two giddy school girls at the edge of the stage watching the strippers perform.

Your American fans might be surprised to learn you also host the Canadian version of America's Next Top Model.

My good friend, Jay Manuel, is the executive producer of the show. He brought me on board. I love it. We have so much fun judging the girls.

Who are the bigger divas? The ladies of RuPaul's Drag Race or Canada's Next Top Model?

Oh, the queens from RuPaul's Drag Race are by far the biggest divas around!

What's next for you?

I have so much stuff in the works: a TV show in development, a million shoots and music video projects, plus I'm co-writing music. But my biggest project and the one I'm having the most fun with these days is mentoring kids. I'm traveling to high schools and colleges and encouraging kids to follow their dreams. I followed mine and I'm having the time of my life.

THIS WEEK IN SPORTS

3-2-1...BOOM!!! That was the sound people heard around the nation as their brackets went BUST at some point during this upset riddled NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament. The first 2 weekends of March Madness was truly that, MADNESS!!! The "David's" of the basketball world took out their fair share of "Goliath's." Georgetown was sent home by Ohio U., Murray State beat Vanderbilt while Cornell took out both Temple and Wisconsin. Number 1 Seeds also fell as Northern Iowa beat the Kansas Jayhawks, Kentucky lost to West Virginia and Syracuse lost to Butler - who then also took out number 2 seed Kansas State to make it to the Final Four.

Texas schools did not fair all that well during the first two rounds of the Tournament. North Texas, Sam Houston State, Houston and University of Texas all said goodbye with losses in their first game. The Texas A&M Aggies beat Utah State, but lost in overtime to Purdue in their second game. That leaves the Baylor Bears as the lone Texas school remaining in the tournament. The Bears were very lucky to be playing the Sweet Sixteen and Elite Eight rounds close to home in Houston as they beat "Cinderella" St. Mary's but lost a heartbreaker to Duke. The Final Four is set as Duke plays West Virginia and Michigan State plays Butler with the winners meeting for the Championship on Monday April 5th in Indianapolis.

In the NCAA Women's Tournament, the favored UConn women won their first two games by 56 and 54 points. The Texas Longhorns and Lamar Cardinals lost in their first round games played in Austin. The Texas A&M Aggies won their first game, but fell to Gonzaga by one point in the second round. The Baylor Bears pulled the upset of the tournament, so far, by beating the traditional powerhouse and Number 1 Seed Tennessee Lady Volunteers in the Sweet Sixteen round. They will have played Duke by the time you read this and we will know whether the Lady Bears made it to the Final Four in San Antonio.

One of the best stories out of the Women's Tournament is about head coach Sherri Murrell of Portland State University. Sherri is the former coach of Washington State, but resigned. When she took the job at Portland State, she altered her coaching style and decided she'd be open about her sexuality, proudly placing a picture of herself, partner and twins in the media guide. Sherri remains the only out Division I women's basketball head coach, saying the honesty is easier on her partner, boosters, and players. Way to go Sherri!!! Portland State lost to Texas A&M in their first round game.

A U S T I N SPORTS

In Austin, some gay teams do not seem to get much attention because the sport being played may not be on many people's radars. Luckily for those of us who are "in the know" and like it rough and tough, we have the Austin Lonestars Rugby Football Club to look to.

The Lonestars Rugby Football Club was formed by a group of gay, bisexual, questioning and straight men in 2003 to compete in the Texas Rugby Union and USA Rugby. The last few years have been up and down for the team. Player turnover, coaching changes, and funding have been issues the team has diligently worked to overcome. They have dedicated themselves this year to expanding the appreciation of rugby and opening their team to those other rugby-inclined men in our community, giving them a chance to learn the game.



The Lonestars are working hard to get to the bi-annual gay rugby tournament and compete for the Bingham Cup, named in honor of the gay rugby player Mark Bingham that was killed in the Pennsylvania plane crash of September 11th. 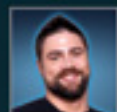

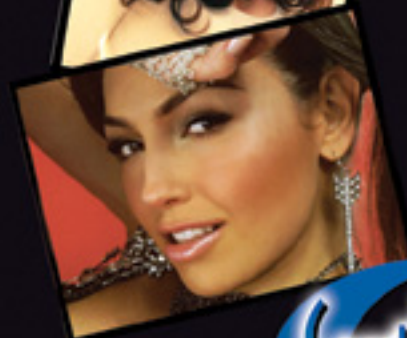
