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# EROTIC HELP

OCTOPUS CLUB OF AUSTIN  
REACHES OUT WITH ART

About 20 years ago when HIV and AIDS were hitting the community and taking people to financial despair in a matter of weeks, everyone was looking for a way to help those in immediate need. A group of concerned friends came together to form the Octopus Club. The goal in mind: raise money in any way possible in order to help.

The Octopus Club is a grassroots, volunteer fundraising arm of the AIDS Services of Austin dedicated to raising awareness and funds for the Paul Kirby Emergency Fund through annual events and parties. The Paul Kirby Emergency Fund provides emergency financial assistance to those living with HIV and AIDS in Central Texas. These funds are distributed to individuals for basic living needs through AIDS Services of Austin on a case-by-case basis.

The Octopus Club is unique in that they are made up of 100% volunteers, so every dollar raised at an Octopus Club event or party goes directly to the Paul Kirby Emergency Fund. The generous contributions of

both hosts and corporate sponsors are the financial backbone for each party and event. With their support over the last 18 years, the Octopus Club's annual events and parties have raised \$1,003,374.63 for the Paul Kirby Fund.

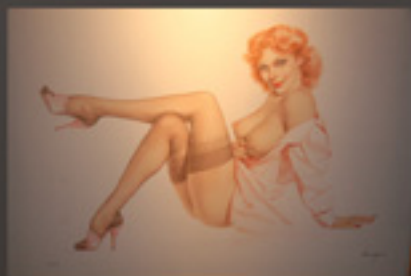
One of the original members of Octopus Club, Chuck Watson, developed the idea of an erotic art auction as a way to raise money for the cause. Originally set up in small studios and vacant offices, people came together, celebrated life and bought the art. And so ArtErotica was launched. The movement was slow in the beginning, raising around \$1,500 a year. While many of the original founders are still closely associated with this particular event, Chuck Watson is still considered the "father" of ArtErotica. Today, ArtErotica is one of the most successful charity events of the year for the Paul Kirby Emergency Fund, raising tens of thousands of dollars per year.



Though the location and size of the party may have changed, the spirit is still the same. Party goers from around the city converge upon the venue each year in order to revel in the naughty spirit of fun. Erotic tarot readings, a decadent dessert display and even nude model sketching have been activities featured in past events. Attendees even dress the party in anything from tassels and tights, to black tie ensembles.

This year hundreds of pieces of art, including paintings, photos and sculptures ranging from mildly sensual to fully erotic, donated by local artists will be auctioned off in order to raise money for this wonderful cause. Attendees can not only purchase this art, but enjoy cocktails, mingle and participate in the erotic festivities of the evening.

This year, the event will be held Saturday, April 17, from 8:30pm until midnight at Pine Street Station, located at 1101 East Fifth Street. Tickets for the event are \$50 presale and remaining tickets will be available at the door for \$65. 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# RIDING FOR A DIFFERENCE

Every year, thousands of people gather in Austin for the most successful fundraiser in Central Texas that benefits people affected by the AIDS virus. Just last year, participants in the Hill Country Ride for AIDS raised over \$650,000 (a new record for the group); bringing the total of money raised over the past decade to 3.5 million dollars.

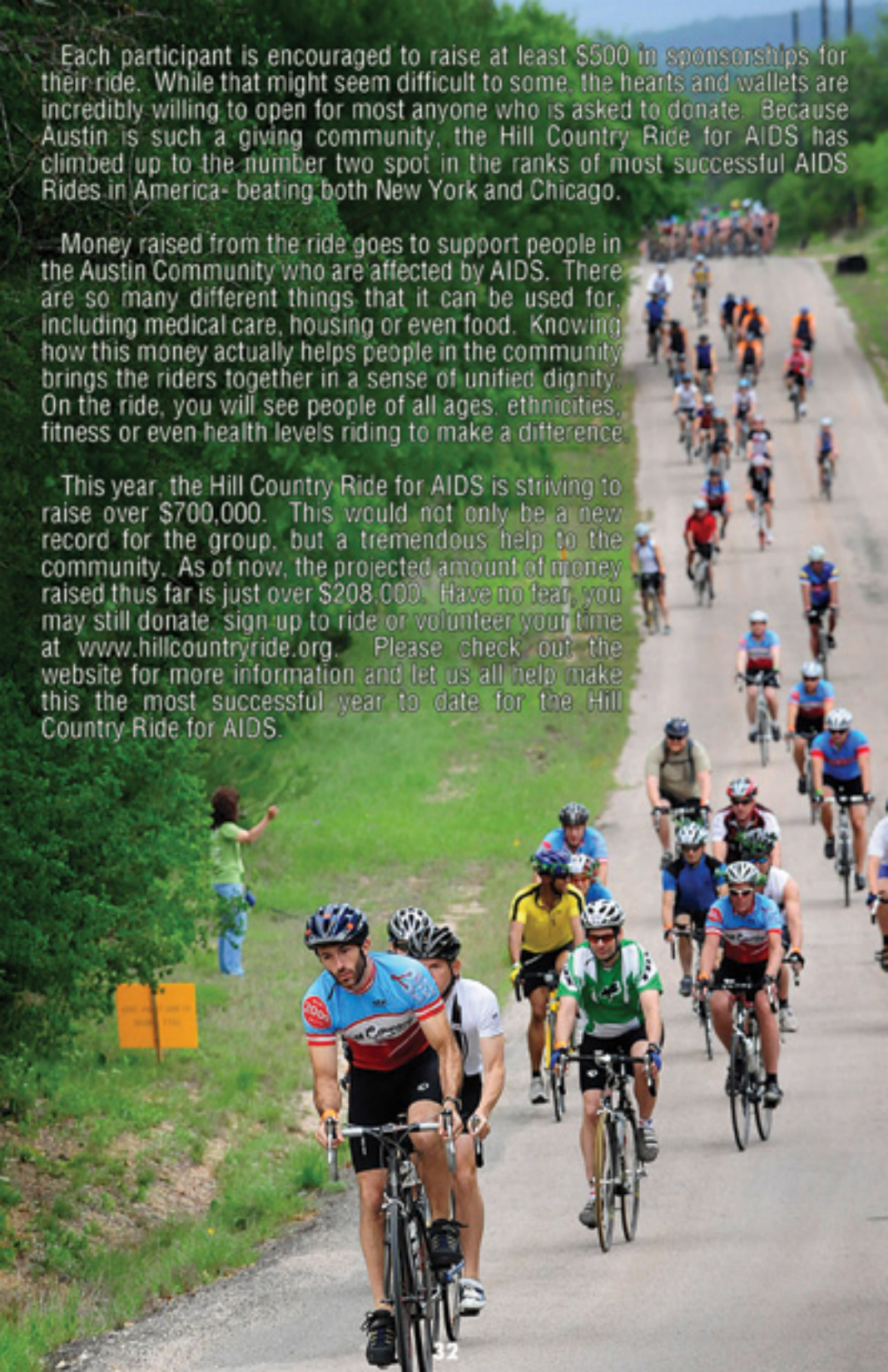
The event takes place over two days, with registration, a group pasta dinner and opening ceremonies on Friday, April 23. The actual ride begins Saturday, April 24 at 6am and closing ceremonies will be finished by 7pm. The ride itself is broken up into different sections, ranging anywhere from ten to one hundred miles. Most people who are beginners on the ride sign up for the smaller routes thinking that they won't be able to make it, but the spirit of the cause keeps them pedaling farther than they could ever imagine.



Each participant is encouraged to raise at least \$500 in sponsorships for their ride. While that might seem difficult to some, the hearts and wallets are incredibly willing to open for most anyone who is asked to donate. Because Austin is such a giving community, the Hill Country Ride for AIDS has climbed up to the number two spot in the ranks of most successful AIDS Rides in America- beating both New York and Chicago.

Money raised from the ride goes to support people in the Austin Community who are affected by AIDS. There are so many different things that it can be used for, including medical care, housing or even food. Knowing how this money actually helps people in the community brings the riders together in a sense of unified dignity. On the ride, you will see people of all ages, ethnicities, fitness or even health levels riding to make a difference

This year, the Hill Country Ride for AIDS is striving to raise over \$700,000. This would not only be a new record for the group, but a tremendous help to the community. As of now, the projected amount of money raised thus far is just over \$208,000. **Yousef**, hoping that at least one of them would flirt back. But alas, the boys moved on before I could seal the deal. Maybe next time fellas!

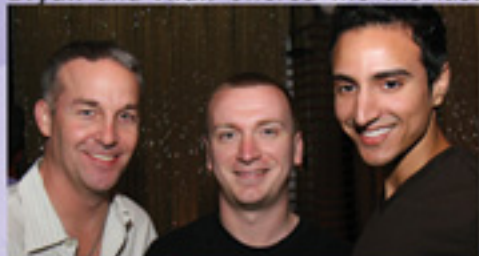

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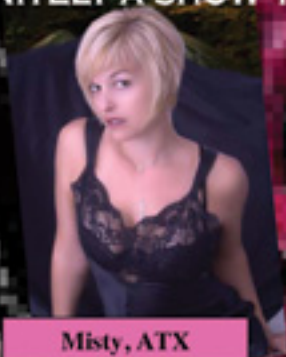
