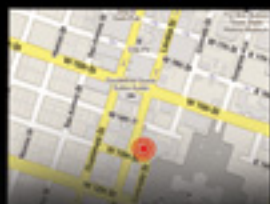

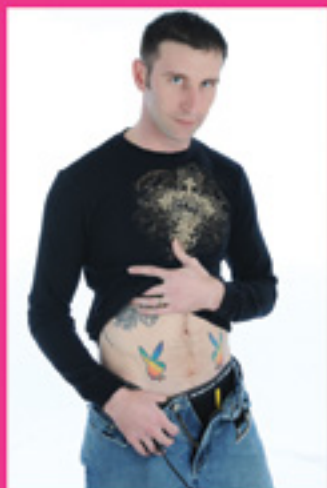
Friday April 23rd, Fiesta brings to you the Battle of Flowers Parade and

This week, I made an amazing discovery and its name is Blu-ray. That's right folks. I finally popped my HD cherry. It all started when my friend ordered the P!nk concert *Funhouse Tour - Live In Australia*. We had both seen the concert live in Houston and wanted to experience it again. We were both a twitter with delight when the disc arrived. I immediately rushed over to his place; which is equipped with several Blu-ray players, an amazing high definition television and blasting surround sound to piss off the neighbors.



Enough about that, let's get to the good stuff. The concert opens up in true P!nk style, complete with dark and twisted pranks, gothic clowns and the true rock and roll style that we've all grown to love. P!nk even manages to flip the bird to the audience no less than two times in the first twenty minutes of the show. Her costuming is a little off the wall, but hey—P!nk has never been the one to conform to standards. I will say, however, that I do love the wide range of costumes which ranged from fully sequined body suits to a casual jeans and undershirt look.

I did happen to notice that none of the songs from her first album *Can't Take Me Home* were included in the tour, but after remembering that her first album was mostly decided by her record label, I wasn't shocked. I was able to finally see the tour version of the song *Sober*, which she unfortunately had to cut in the U.S. tour due to injuries sustained on the

road. Even just watching it on Blu-ray, I instantly felt like I was there again. I was originally planning to open this week's column with a humorous yet conversation provoking editorial about the intersection of sports and sex, infidelity, the sense of self importance and belief of privilege by both national sports figures and those gay athletes we all know share those characteristics in our individual cities. However, something much more important happened this week that has raised a renewed focus on what is really important, and a deep reflection on the lives of loved ones.

On Wednesday, tennis legend Martina Navratilova revealed she had been diagnosed with breast cancer. If some young gay person is reading this and asks, "Who is Martina Navratilova?", please educate them about their GLBT history!!!

Navratilova is one of the most pioneering accomplished tennis players in history. She came out as a lesbian during her career while winning 59 Grand Slam Titles; including 18 in singles, 31 in doubles and 10 in mixed-doubles. She won her last mixed-doubles title in 2006 at the U.S. Open, a month shy of her 50th birthday. She retired in 1994 after having spent 331 weeks ranked as the world's Number 1 women's tennis player. She returned to professional tennis in 2000, before retiring again in 2007.

Martina, 53, was diagnosed with Grade 3 ductal carcinoma in situ, DCIS. This condition consists of a collection of cancerous cells in the milk ducts, but has not yet spread to other tissues. DCIS is less dangerous than invasive breast cancer, but left untreated can transform into a much more serious form of cancer. Almost 70,000 women are diagnosed each year with DCIS, however the prognosis of someone with DCIS is excellent with treatment.

She underwent a lumpectomy in March and will undergo six weeks of radiation therapy in May while she is in Paris, France to work as a television commentator for the 2010 French Open. Upon her diagnosis, Martina said, "I call this my personal 9/11 because I realized my life would never be the same."

Navratilova said, "At first I preferred not to talk about this publicly because I don't want people feeling sorry for me or to know really everything that's going on in my life. But I thought this was a great opportunity to encourage women to have that yearly checkup and get that mammogram. Don't put it off. I put mine off it turns out four years." Martina went on to say that she is physically fine, but struggles emotionally at times, particularly when discussing her diagnosis.

A U S T I N SPORTS

Who said football season was over? On Saturday, April 10th, the Austin Outlaws kicked off their tenth consecutive season with a win over the Houston Power. The Austin Outlaws are the only women's full tackle football team in Austin that are members of the Women's Football Alliance (WFA) which boast 41 teams nationwide.

The Outlaws are coming off a 2009 season in which they captured the Southwest Division title with a 7-1 record. This season they will face division rivals the Houston Power and the Lonestar Mustangs (Ft. Worth). Also on the schedule are the Oklahoma City Lightning and New Orleans Blaze along with the league's first international team, the Aguilas Regias of Mexico.

Surviving 10 years in women's football is not easy. Most teams are self-funded and require players to take on additional fundraising responsibilities in addition to practice and game time. "We are incredibly proud that we're still here. We've never folded, we've never had to restructure or change our name, we've always made it, and we have no intention of going anywhere." stated General Manager Lily Messina.

The Outlaws are chanting "Ten Years of Tuff!" as their battle cry this season - an appropriate slogan given the tough schedule the Outlaws will face in hopes of defending their division title. Of the 45-person roster, 28 players are returning for another season and average a total of 4.7 seasons of playing experience.

They will be playing all of their

home games this season at Westlake High School Chaparral Stadium. The next home game is Saturday, April 17th at noon against Aguilas Regias. Get more info on the Outlaws at their website austinoulaws.com.

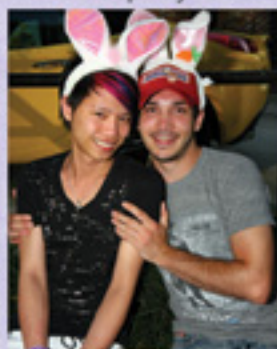
on and check out the rest of the party and I am so glad I did. Just check out the man candy and the tanned muscle

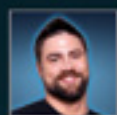

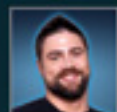
