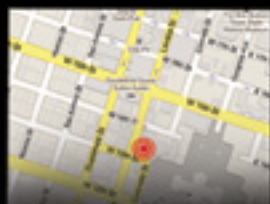

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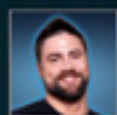
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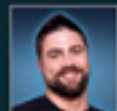

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DON'T ASK DON'T TELL

Amid the turmoil of the Iraq war and the scandal at Walter Reed, the last thing it seems that the nation is concerned with is the debate over gays in the military. Yet that's just what the focus should be, if we really want to win this war.

With an estimated 65,000 members of America's Armed Forces being from the GLBT community and many more potential members, the time is now to end this discrimination. Before the implementation of Don't Ask, Don't Tell (DADT) in 1993, the President was the only government official who had the power to either allow or forbid gays and lesbians to serve in the military. But once President Bill Clinton came in pledging to lift the ban, the opposition of his chairman of the Joint Chiefs, Colin Powell, and the hapless efforts by his first defense secretary, the late Les Aspin, ignited a firestorm on Capitol Hill. As the DADT compromise was hammered out, Congress took the extraordinary step of removing the policy from the President's hands and writing it into law.

Ever since the heated 1993 debate over the issue, senior military officers have tended to keep their opposition to gays in uniform under wraps simply because it shows them as being out of step with much of the nation. Not only that, but expelling gays from the military when the Pentagon is desperately trying to hold on to every soldier, sailor, airman and marine doesn't seem to many people to make a lot of sense. And with a 2005 study by the Government Accountability Office showed that about 10,000 service personnel have been discharged since the policy took effect, including 54 Arabic specialists, as proof to their growing concern, it's not exactly difficult to understand.

Another reason why the military hasn't typically spoken out loudly on the topic is because they basically won the debate. Under the policy, gays may only serve if they keep their sexual orientation private and do not engage in homosexual activity. Commanders also are barred from asking about their orientation. And in recent developments, the Pentagon has announced that it is relaxing its enforcement of DADT. Under the new advisement, no investigations regarding sexual orientation will be opened against members of the military based on anonymous complaints and all investigations must be reviewed by officials with the equivalent of a one-star general or admiral. This might seem like a huge victory to some, but it just isn't enough.

Also in his very first State of the Union Address, President Barack Obama called for the end of Don't Ask, Don't Tell. Although he did not guarantee that the repeal will be finalized in 2010, he did say that he, Congress and the military will work together to "finally repeal the law that denies gay Americans the right to serve the country they love because of who they are." This quote sparked Connecticut Senator Joseph Lieberman to introduce a bill into the Senate calling for the end of this 17 year old piece of legislation.

Lieberman's bill was quickly met with objections from the Republican Party, headed up by South Carolina Representative Joe Wilson, the ranking Republican on the House Armed Services Subcommittee on

Lieberman's bill was quickly met with objections from the Republican Party, headed up by South Carolina Representative Joe Wilson, the ranking Republican on the House Armed Services Subcommittee on Military Personnel. Wilson concluded that since 1999 only 8,300 members of the Armed Forces had been expelled due to DADT. Citing that this broke down to less than 800 people a year, Wilson termed this "not a significant loss from an

overall" Defense Department "manpower perspective."

Countless Americans, both civilian and military, are ready to see DADT ended. Secretary of State Hillary Clinton, who was first lady when Congress wrote DADT into law, wants it repealed. Retired Army general John Shalikashvili, who served as chairman after Powell, also wants it removed from the books. But far more important is the view from the ranks. A recent poll by the Military Times newspapers showed that only 30 percent of respondents think openly gay people should be allowed to serve, compared to 59 percent who are opposed. Until those numbers are reversed, "Don't ask, Don't tell" won't change.

THE LIGHTS WENT OUT IN GEORGIA

Ms. Carter, best remembered as the tough as nails Julia Sugarbaker on the late 80's/early 90's sitcom *Designing Women*, passed away at the age of 70 from complications of endometrial cancer. The role of Ms. Sugarbaker—an iron fist in a velvet glove—pioneered the role of the strong, outspoken female character and left an everlasting and importantly progressive impression on TV.

Upon hearing of Carter's passing, I couldn't help but sit down at my trusted computer and YouTube some of my favorite moments from her career defining role. I mean, who can forget when Julia Sugarbaker sets Marjorie Leigh Winnick, the current reigning Miss Georgia World, straight about the "night the lights went out in Georgia." And who could forget when Julia "mooned Atlanta" during her fashion show debut.

Julia Sugarbaker may have been the most noted character that Dixie portrayed, but it was far from her only one. Carter graced television audiences in many different series including *Out of the Blue*, *On Our Own*, *Diff'rent Strokes* and *Filthy*

Rich. Her last role gracing the small screen was a seven show stint in 2007 on *Desperate Housewives*, playing Bree Van de Kamp's scheming mother-in-law Gloria Hodge. It seems very fitting that this role earned her an Emmy nomination for Outstanding Guest Actress in a Comedy Series.

SPEAKING FREELY

Recently, I had the pleasure of attending the annual Human Rights Campaign Gala held at the Hyatt Regency in Austin, Texas. The theme of the night was "Speak the Truth," and one of the guest speakers was retired Marine Staff Sergeant Eric F. Alva. Staff Sgt. Alva was the first officer injured during the ground war in Iraq. Triggering a landmine on March 21, 2003 caused the end of Alva's military career and the beginning of another crusade in his life.

You see, Alva had been carrying a secret during his years in the Marines. He is an openly gay man. Alva's only option to join the military and serve the country he loves was to suppress his sexuality and serve under the country's "Don't Ask, Don't Tell" policy. Well now that he is retired from the service, Alva is determined to do whatever he can in order to help repeal this antiquated piece of legislation.

After his moving speech at the gala, I was able to sit down with him and ask him a few questions:

What made you decide to enlist in the Armed Forces in the first place?

My middle name is "Fidelis" so you can probably guess I grew up in a military family. My father served in Vietnam, my grandfather in World War II. I guess you could say that service was in my blood. I joined the military because I wanted to serve; I joined the Marines because I wanted a challenge. I was 19 years old. I was patriotic and idealistic.

What caused you to make the decision to come out to your fellow Marines?

I was cautious about whom I divulged my secret to -- I felt I had to be. Then one evening, out with some guys from our unit, I let my guard down. One of the guys commented on some women in the bar. When my response was less than enthusiastic he asked me, jokingly, if I was gay. "As a matter of fact, I am," I responded. He swore to keep my secret, but I suppose he thought it was just too good a piece of gossip to pass up. He was wrong. No one he told cared. The response from everyone was the same as it had been from the friends in whom I'd confided: "so what?" I was still Eric, still one of them, still a Marine; I was still trusted.

How has life changed since you have come back from Iraq?

That landmine may have put an end to my military career that day, but it didn't put an end to my secret. That would come years later, when I realized that I had fought and nearly died to secure rights for others that I myself was not free to enjoy. I had proudly served a country that was not proud of me. More importantly, my experience disproved all the arguments against open service by gays and lesbians -- I knew I had to share my story.

What is your message to any GLBT community member considering enlisting in the Armed Forces?

As a former Marine and patriotic American, I am deeply disturbed that "Don't Ask, Don't Tell" is discouraging young patriots from joining the Military at a time when our country needs their service. Since leaving the military, the opportunities I've had to speak with Americans across the country, both gay and straight, have showed time and again that the American people support open service by gay, lesbian and bisexual troops.

As a former member of the Marines, can you explain your stance on "Don't Ask, Don't Tell."

My experiences serving in the military demonstrate that "Don't Ask, Don't Tell" is a solution looking for a problem. Those who support (DADT) claim that they do so in the interest of unit cohesion. Well, as a former Marine, I can tell you what it takes to build unit cohesion: trust. It takes trust in your fellow unit members to have your back and do their job. And I can also tell you that "Don't Ask, Don't Tell" does nothing but undercut that trust, and with it our nation's security. "Don't Ask, Don't Tell" imposes secrecy and undermines unit cohesion, ousting gays and lesbians at the expense of the military readiness of the United States. Allowing gay, lesbian and bisexual service members to serve openly will only improve unit cohesion and in turn our military.

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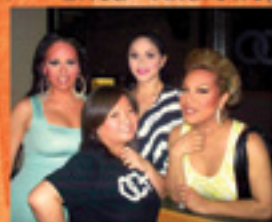

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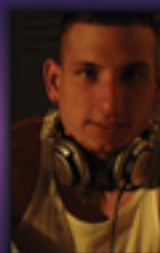
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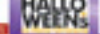
